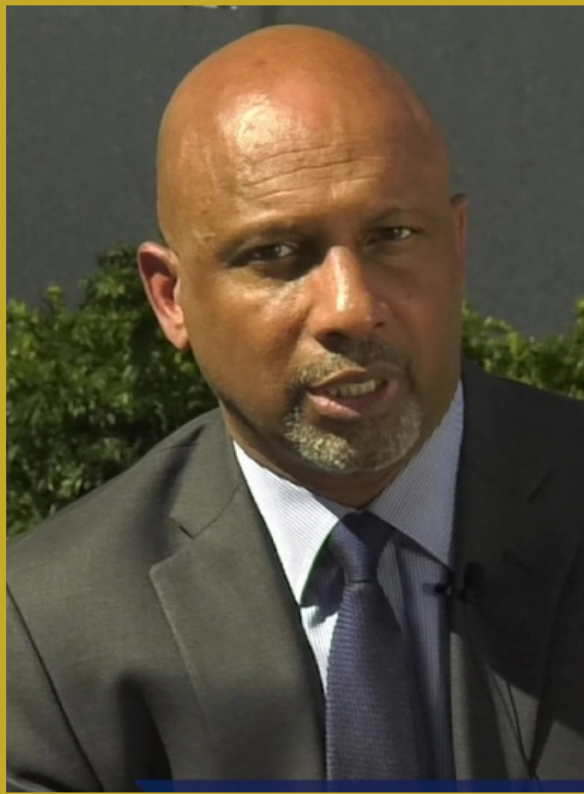

About Senior Councilwoman Goosby



Sr. Councilwoman Dorothy L. Goosby was elected to the Town of Hempstead Board back in 1999. Sr. Councilwoman Goosby made history as the first Black woman on the Town Board and one of the first democrats to be elected since 1905. Sr. Councilwoman Goosby has always been a fighter and is unafraid to call out inequity. In 1988, she along with the Center for Constitutional Rights filed a class action lawsuit against the Town of Hempstead for their discriminatory at large voting system, which affected the minority community. Finally in 1997, a federal judge agreed that this at large voting system was discriminatory and violated the Voting Rights Act.

Councilwoman Goosby holds the honor of being the first Councilperson to be elected in six consecutive campaigns, and has served as a Senior Councilwoman since 2016. Her impressive work has not gone unnoticed; Goosby's political action has been documented in the New York Times, Newsday and other noteworthy publications over the years. She even had the honor of receiving a Presidential Volunteerism pin.

Sr. Councilwoman Goosby played a key role in bringing the Uniondale Community Land Trust (U-CLT) to fruition. The 2012 Uniondale Vision Plan supported the initial proposal of a land trust, detailing the plans to address housing and affordability in the area. This land trust aimed to respond to the home foreclosure crisis in Uniondale by rehabilitating homes and keeping both home and business costs affordable. The Greater Uniondale Area Action Coalition (GUAAC) worked alongside U-CLT to help create a long-term community development strategy that would revitalize housing, further encourage resident participation and stabilize the local economy.

Sr. Councilwoman Goosby met with U-CLT when it was ready to acquire its first property. She arranged a meeting with Town commissioners to allow us to explain the CLT concept and find ways to better negotiate the Town's requirements and restrictions. Sr. Councilwoman Goosby agreed with community members and organizers that achieving these goals for Uniondale would have to be a shared responsibility. This vision plan and these initial meetings helped set amazing initiatives into motion for changing Uniondale for the better.
