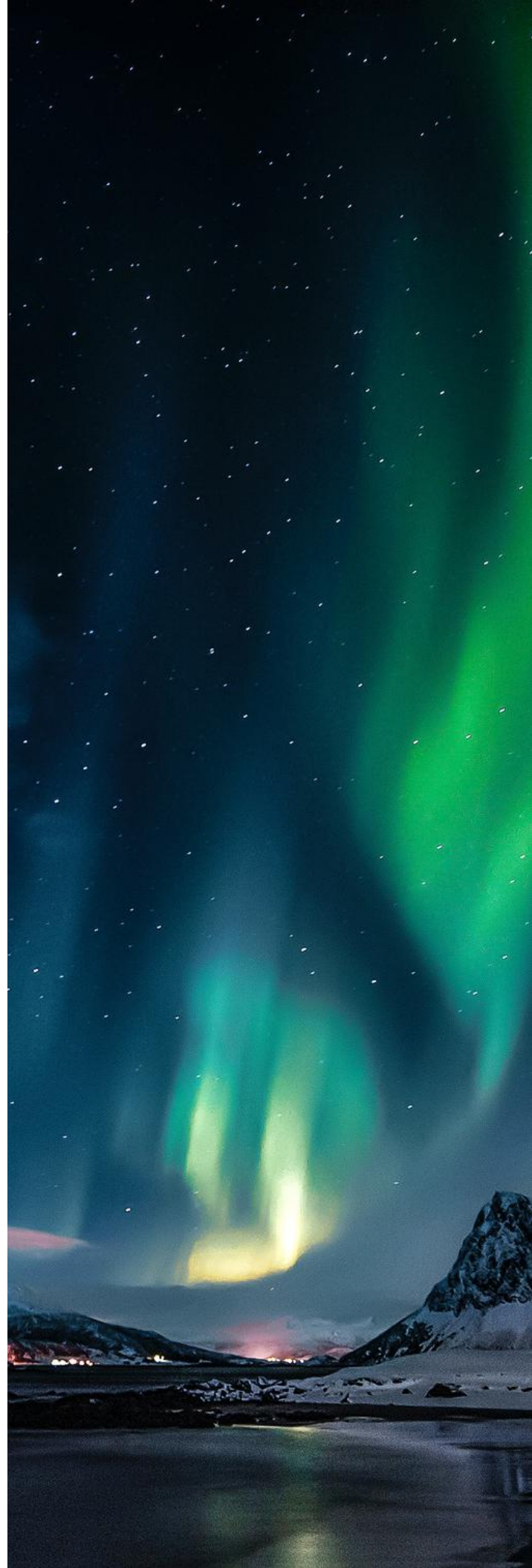

ITINERARY

NORTHBOUND VOYAGE



Embark on an unforgettable seven-day journey along Norway's stunning coastline, from the charming city of Bergen to the Arctic frontier town of Kirkenes. Along the way, you'll explore iconic cities, sail through breathtaking fjords, and cross the Arctic Circle.



DAY 1

Bergen

Welcome Aboard in Bergen



Your voyage begins in Bergen, a city rich in history and a gateway to Norway's stunning fjords. Before boarding, take time to explore Bergen's famous attractions, such as the UNESCO-listed Bryggen wharfs, the bustling fish market, and the Fløibanen funicular for panoramic views of the city and surrounding mountains.

As you depart from Bergen, your ship follows the old Viking route along the Hjeltefjord. Settle into your cabin and enjoy the first of many delicious meals made from fresh coastal produce. Onboard, you'll meet the Coastal Experience Team, who will guide you through the activities, lectures, and excursions available during your voyage.

DAY 2 Ålesund

Iconic Architecture and Fantastic Fjords

Today begins with stunning views of the Nordfjord as you sail toward Ålesund, known for its beautiful Art Nouveau architecture. Spend time exploring this charming town, where you can visit the Atlanterhavsparken aquarium or stroll through streets lined with colorful buildings, rebuilt after the great fire of 1904.

In the summer months, your ship sails into the UNESCO-listed Geirangerfjord, surrounded by towering cliffs and cascading waterfalls like the famous Seven Sisters. If you're traveling in spring or fall, the itinerary takes you through the serene Hjørundfjord, hidden deep within the Sunnmøre Alps. The day ends in Molde, where you can enjoy views of the 222 mountain peaks of the Molde Panorama.



DAY 3 City of Kings and Palaces

Trondheim



Arrive in Trondheim, a city founded by Viking King Olav Tryggvason in 997 A.D. and home to Norway's most sacred site, Nidaros Cathedral. Explore the city's rich history by visiting the cathedral, strolling across the Old Town Bridge, and exploring the colorful Bakklandet district with its wooden houses and cozy cafés.

You'll have three hours to explore the city's highlights or join an optional excursion. After your time in Trondheim, the ship continues its journey, sailing past the striking Kjeungskjær Lighthouse and the rocky reefs of Norway's coast before reaching the charming town of Rørvik.

DAY 4

Bodø

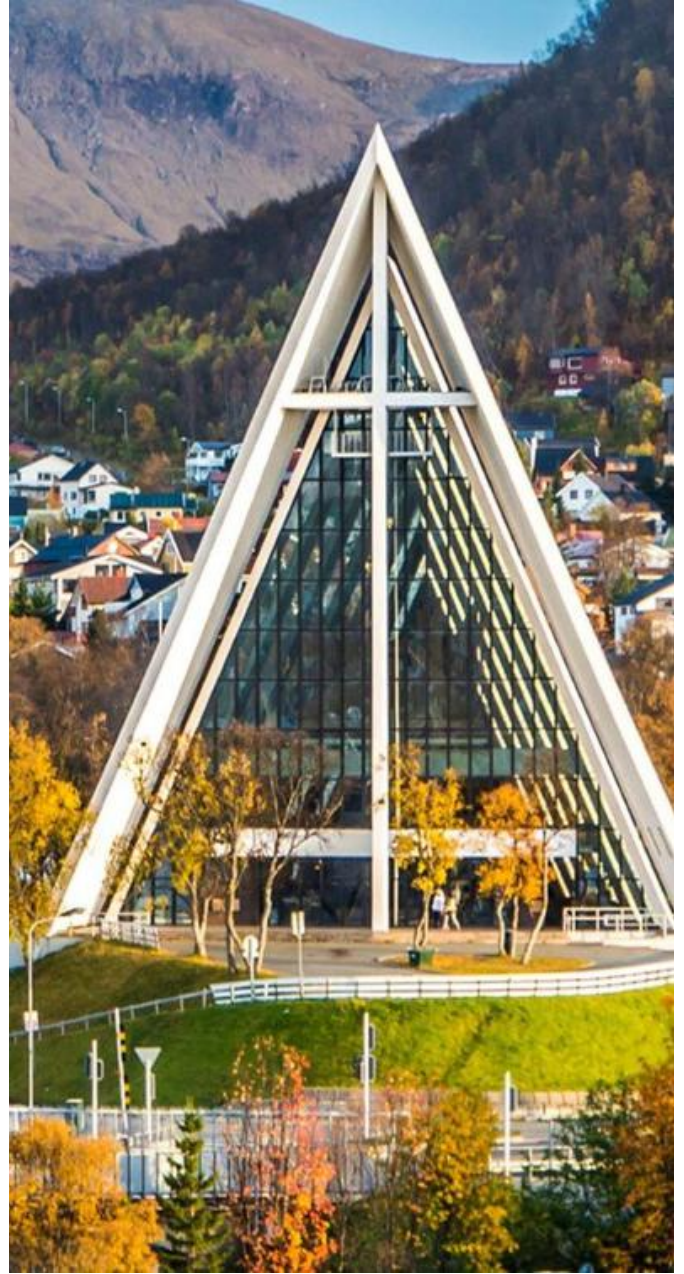
Into the Arctic

Early in the morning, the ship crosses the Arctic Circle, an important milestone on your journey north. This moment is celebrated with a traditional cod liver oil tasting—a unique Norwegian experience that marks the beginning of your Arctic adventure. Crossing into the Arctic region also increases your chances of seeing the Northern Lights in winter or enjoying 24-hour daylight under the Midnight Sun in summer.

A mid-morning stop in Bodø, Northern Norway's second-largest city, gives you the chance to explore the vibrant street art or join an optional excursion to Saltstraumen. This natural phenomenon is the world's most powerful tidal current and a must-see for those interested in forces of nature. Bodø is also surrounded by impressive mountain peaks, offering scenic views as you stroll through the town.

As the journey continues, the ship sails into the dramatic Lofoten Archipelago. Known for its rugged beauty, Lofoten features towering cliffs that rise straight out of the sea, creating a striking landscape. The afternoon is your opportunity to take in the views of the Lofoten Wall, a natural barrier of steep mountains, before arriving in Svolvær, the main town of the islands.

In Svolvær, you'll be greeted by rows of traditional fisherman's huts, known as rorbuer, perched on stilts along the harbor. This charming town is the heart of Lofoten, and its picturesque setting makes it a perfect place to explore. Whether wandering through the harbor or simply taking in the incredible mountain backdrop, Svolvær is a highlight of the Lofoten Islands.



DAY 5 Capital of the Arctic

Tromsø

Arrive in Tromsø, the "Gateway to the Arctic," where you'll have four hours to explore this vibrant city. Visit the iconic Arctic Cathedral, famous for its striking architecture and beautiful stained-glass windows, or stop by Polaria, an Arctic-themed aquarium and research center. Stroll through the city center, where you can visit the historic Mack Brewery, one of the northernmost breweries in the world, or enjoy a coffee at a cozy café.

After leaving Tromsø, the ship sails north, passing the majestic Lyngen Alps, known for their sharp peaks rising from the sea. Keep an eye out for seabirds and the Midnight Sun in summer or the Northern Lights in winter as the journey continues.

DAY 6

Honningsvåg

Norway's Northern Frontier

Arrive early in Hammerfest, one of the northernmost towns in the world, where you can explore its polar history or visit the UNESCO-listed Meridian Column. In the summer, keep an eye out for herds of reindeer that migrate across the island of Kvaløya, adding a unique touch to this Arctic stop.

Later in the day, reach Honningsvåg, the gateway to the North Cape, Europe's northernmost point. Join an optional excursion to the iconic North Cape globe monument, where you can enjoy panoramic views of the Arctic Ocean. This area is also home to the indigenous Sámi people, and you might spot reindeer grazing on the open tundra.



DAY 7

Kirkenes

Norway's Eastern Edge

Ship arrives in Kirkenes, located near the Russian border and farther east than St. Petersburg. Kirkenes marks the turning point of your journey, where the ship begins its southbound voyage. You can explore the town's WWII history, visit the Russian border, or even enjoy a thrilling dog-sledding adventure in winter.

As the ship heads south, you'll revisit some of the ports you passed at night, now in daylight. Don't miss Vardøhus Fortress in Vardø, Norway's easternmost town, offering a glimpse into the region's history and culture.
