



2021 ISCD HIGHLIGHTS

The ISCD had a number of wins throughout the year. Here are some of the highlights:



VACCINATION EFFORTS

The ISCD vaccinated more than 1,400 athletes, staff, volunteers, and their families in January. More than 100 vaccines per hour were administered over a 12-hour period.

2020 TOKYO PARALYMPICS

In August, five ISCD athletes proudly represented Israel by competing in the 2020 Tokyo Paralympics.

Israel's U22 Wheelchair Basketball team finished 3rd at the European Wheelchair Basketball Championships.

JIMMY CAPLAN AQUATICS CENTER

Reparing the ISCD's semi-Olympic and hydrotherapy pools are a top priority in 2022. AFISCD plans to raise \$2.75 million to renovate and rename both pools.



BE'ER SHEVA PROGRAM

After a break due to the pandemic, the Negev program that mainly serves children from the Bedouin communities, is back up and running.



EXPO CENTER CONSTRUCTION

Construction on ISCD's new Expo Center began in early 2022. This 250 person permanent tent expands our ability to better serve the community.



BASKETBALL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Our new Wheelchair Basketball High-Performance Pilot Program is underway. The selected group of 12 players receive extra court time, coaching, services and equipment.



TABLE TENNIS FACILITY RENOVATIONS

Using the funds raised in 2021, renovations for the ISCD's table tennis facilities will be completed in 2022.



EXPANSION OF SOCIAL SERVICES

The ISCD was recognized by Israel's Ministry of Health as an essential service for the children and adults with disabilities for whom they serve. This year we will continue expanding on the services already provided.
