

This long bug comes to see Kat.


He likes sitting here.



This bug is red.


She has dots on her wings.

This bug is going up, up, up and away.


Where is she going?

He is looking for things to munch on.


Kat looks at him.

Kat sees a rainbow!


She is getting wet!

Digraph Fun

- Digraphs with ng can be in the middle and end of a word.
- Here are some words with ng digraphs: finger, king, and lung.
- With digraphs, there are fewer sounds than letters. For example, bang has four letters but only three sounds /b/ /a/ /ng/. The ng is the digraph.

High-Frequency Words

Decodable Words can be sounded out based on the letter-sound relationships.

High-Frequency Words are the most commonly used words. Your reader will begin to recognize them.
