

Leaders in Training are responsible for assisting our Recreation Leaders in summer programs. Leaders in Training assist in leading games, arts and crafts, sports, music, and other fun activities for approximately 30 – 100 children. In addition, there are several special outings and staff bonding events scheduled throughout the summer. There are a limited number of Leader in Training positions available. All applicants will be given an interview. Chosen candidates for the program will be assessed a \$115 program fee to cover activity costs.

The Leader in Training Program runs Mondays through Fridays. For Camp Kids and Camp Oak Wood, two sessions are utilized each day, a morning session (8am-12:30pm) and an afternoon session (12:30- 5pm). Leaders in Trainings are chosen to attend one session only per day. CHALOF hours are approximately 8am-1pm. In addition, a 1-hour training session will be held for Leaders in Trainings each week. Leaders in Trainings must commit to attending no less than 75% of the camp. If attendance falls below this, participants will be removed from the program and fees will not be refunded.




