

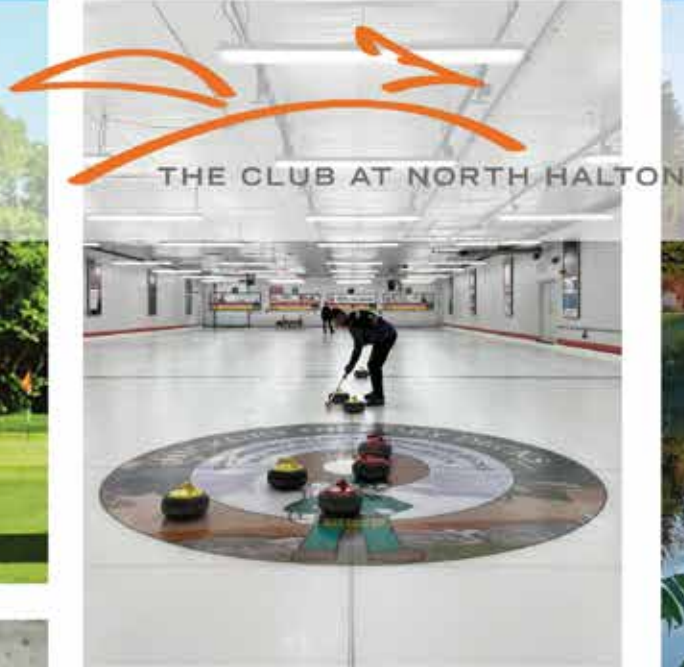

# Kristina Tesser Derksen

Member of Parliament for

I extend my heartfelt gratitude to the Halton Hills community for choosing me to be your voice in Ottawa. It is an honour to serve as your new Member of Parliament for Milton East-Halton Hills South at a time of transformational change and nation-building in Canada.

Soon after the election, my team and I got to work securing a community office, located at 232 Guelph Street at the corner of Mountainview in Georgetown. Since then, we have welcomed many of you to the office to share your concerns, assist you with government services, or just to say hello.

Our government also moved quickly to deliver on commitments that matter to Canadians. We delivered a middle-class tax cut, eliminated HST on new homes over \$1 million, and expanded our dental care program to ensure more families can access this critical health service.

For local businesses, I know the impacts from U.S. tariffs have been top of mind. To support workers and businesses, we have launched a comprehensive \$5 billion Strategic Response Fund. Funding is available to help sectors grow stronger, more resilient, and less dependent on the U.S. Additional supports include EI expansions for workers, relief and financial support to meet immediate needs like payroll, and assistance for expansion into new markets. To learn more, contact our office for details.

Ensuring Canadians feel safe in their homes and communities remains a top priority for me. I recently met with MPP Zee Hamid, the Associate Solicitor General

for Auto Theft and Bail Reform, and my government colleague MP Adam van Koeeverden, Secretary of State for Sport, to discuss our cross-governmental efforts at combatting crime. I updated MPP Hamid on the federal government's upcoming bail reform legislation which will introduce harsher penalties for violent repeat offenders, strengthen sentencing for serious violent crimes, and toughens the criminal code, making bail laws stricter for violent and organized crime, sexual offences, home invasions, auto theft and human trafficking, especially for repeat offenders. Our legislation is comprehensive and reflects extensive consultations and research to ensure it is robust and resilient. I have also met with our local police service twice since the election and spoken to individuals and groups in our community to make sure our concerns are addressed.

The 2025 budget, just released on November 4th, provides a clear picture of our nation's fiscal priorities. The budget distinguishes day-to-day spending from long-term investments, helping prioritise projects that deliver lasting benefits for Canadians. Starting with Budget 2025, the government will also move to a Fall budget cycle with a Spring economic and fiscal update. This brings budget alignment with the municipal budget cycle and business year-ends.

The year ahead promises to be a time of bold investment, innovation, and renewal across Canada. My non-partisan office is always ready to serve you in person, or by email and phone. I look forward to continuing our work together to build a stronger, safer, and more prosperous community. ♦

# FROM THE HONOURABLE *Michael Chong*

Member of Parliament for Wellington–Halton Hills North



**A**fter the April 28th election, the Liberals formed a government led by Prime Minister Carney. At the start of Canada's 45th Parliament since Confederation, Conservatives indicated, as His Majesty's Official Opposition, that we would carefully examine the bills the Carney government presented. We said that we would support bills that are in the national interest and oppose any bills that we concluded would not be in the interest of Canada or Canadians. We are upholding that commitment.

In June, we voted in favour of the Liberal government's Bill C-5, also known as The One Canadian Economy Act, because it would allow the government to fast-track major projects, such as mines, oil and gas developments, and pipelines. We are also supportive of parts of another government bill in the House of Commons, Bill C-12, a strong-borders bill, because it will restrict the ability to claim asylum and tighten Canada's immigration laws.

In this parliament our goals will be to hold the Liberal government accountable for a number of promises yet to be delivered. Prime Minister Carney promised to turn Canada into "an energy superpower," and promised to build "the strongest economy in the G7". Canada's economy continues to underperform compared to our peers. The economy shrunk 1.6 per cent annualized in the second quarter, one of the weakest performances in the G7, and Canada's projected growth amongst selected OECD countries remains dead last.

Ontario continues to shed thousands of auto sector jobs as the US tariffs bite, including the recent announcement by Stellantis that they would be moving 3,000 jobs from the Jeep plant in Brampton to Illinois. In Oshawa, General Motors recently announced plans to eliminate 750 assembly jobs for the Chevy Silverado and move some of that production to their assembly plant in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

We will push the Liberals to eliminate interprovincial trade barriers as the estimated potential benefit to the Canadian economy, as high as \$200 billion, will help to offset some of the effects of US tariffs.

In short, Mr. Carney said, "We will need to do things previously thought impossible at speeds we haven't seen in generations". Although these are early days in the Carney government, Mr. Carney has yet to deliver. Conservatives will be watching carefully in the coming months to see what actions the Prime Minister takes to deliver on the promises he made. Conservatives will also continue to provide proposals and suggestions to help Canadians and Canadian businesses weather the storm and succeed.

# FROM *Joseph Racinsky*

**A**s 2025 draws to a close, I would like to take a moment to look back at just a few of the things we were able to accomplish for our community here in Wellington–Halton Hills. Tariffs have dominated the news cycle, but I would like to focus on the incredible resilience of our community in light of these threats.

We have come together like never before. Many of us have committed to buy Canadian, buy local. To help promote this, our provincial government created “Buy Ontario, Buy Canadian Day”, which falls on June 27th every year. This is just another reminder for our community to support our incredible local businesses that drive our economy forward.

This summer, I was pleased to

help host the Minister of Finance, Peter Bethlenfalvy, alongside the Chamber of Commerce. He had an opportunity to hear directly from you about what’s important for our community. He also provided an update at that event on the Protect Ontario Financing Program, which provides up to \$1 billion of liquidity support in the form of loans to Ontario businesses affected by US tariffs. This program is a part of the provincial government’s \$5 billion Protecting Ontario Account. We will do whatever it takes to protect jobs here in Ontario.

I have spent this past summer getting to know every part of our community so I can better represent you and your values in the Ontario Legislature. From farmers markets to festivals and fall fairs, I have been out listening to residents and

gathering valuable feedback on what they expect. This summer, I also welcomed the Associate Solicitor General for Auto Theft and Bail Reform Zee Hamid to Acton for a productive discussion with police and residents. The issue of auto theft continues to be top of mind for residents here in Halton Hills.

Our government is busy cutting unnecessary red tape to unleash our economy. As parliamentary assistant to the Minister of Red Tape Reduction, I was able to host a number of our local agricultural stakeholders for a productive meeting on ways that the provincial government can modernize its processes to allow farmers to get back to the important work that they do. Our government is also investing record amounts in the skilled trades. I had the opportunity to visit Landscape Ontario’s headquarters right here in Halton Hills, where our government has invested \$3 million to help train workers in this essential and busy industry.

These are just a few of the exciting things happening here in Halton Hills. I am so thankful to have the opportunity to serve as your Member of Provincial Parliament. If there is ever anything I or my office can do for you, please don’t hesitate to reach out. ♦

## Halton Hills: Balancing business growth with rural charm

**W**elcome to Halton Hills, where business is booming and the countryside remains as inviting as ever. Nestled in the western GTA, our town is a unique blend of two vibrant urban centers – Georgetown and Acton – alongside charming hamlets like Norval, Stewarttown, and Glen Williams. With farms and rolling landscapes stretching from Highway 401 and

Steeles Avenue in the south all the way to the 32nd Sideroad at Wellington County, Halton Hills is a place where rural beauty meets opportunity.

The Greenbelt and Niagara Escarpment carve through the heart of our community, framing prime agricultural lands and creating a picturesque setting that's both beautiful and distinct. With a population of just 65,000, Halton

Hills offers that special small-town feel – while still welcoming big ideas. And I know that our residents are passionate about our unique and friendly atmosphere.

### Business on the Rise

Our southern border along Highway 401 is a magnet for investment, and the aptly named Premier Gateway is buzzing with new business activity. Recent highlights include the grand opening of Conestoga Cold Storage, Schneider Electric's new Canadian distribution centre, and the groundbreaking of a new training facility at Landscape Ontario. These investments are reshaping our formerly rural corridor, but there's a commitment to keep the natural and fresh urban/rural feel of Halton Hills.

### Greening the Gateway

Working with builders, we're introducing green infrastructure alongside the new grey roadways. Take a drive by the new logistics site on Trafalgar Road, just north of Steeles, and you'll see hundreds of newly planted bushes and trees. Our gateway will be lively with commerce at the same time as looking natural and welcoming.

economy. Farming is evolving as urban growth encroaches on traditional farmland, but its impact is still profound. According to Statistics Canada, in 2021 Halton Hills agriculture generated an impressive \$50 million in gross farm receipts – almost one-third of the total farm receipts in Halton Region. The local agricultural economy includes food production, horticulture, greenhouse, floriculture and nurseries. Local farmers and agri-businesses play a vital role in sustaining our community’s prosperity and rural character.

### Planning for the Future

Right now, Council and Town staff are reviewing land uses across Halton Hills, guided by provincial

population projections and policy statements. The goal? To earmark land for residential, industrial, commercial, and agricultural uses and renew the foundation for prosperity while maintaining our small-town character.

Recent reports from the Town planning department show that we can meet our population and employment targets to the year 2051 by maintaining an urban boundary recently confirmed by Council. That boundary expands the urban area that we are familiar with today. Council included the land on Trafalgar Road that was donated for a new Georgetown hospital and added an area south of 10th Sideroad in Georgetown. But the land needs analysis indicated that

there was no need to sprawl into all our agricultural lands.

It’s my hope that by holding an urban boundary line, we will save our rural landscapes and the viability of local agriculture for at least the next 10 to 15 years. At that time, a future council – consulting with residents – will revisit our community vision.

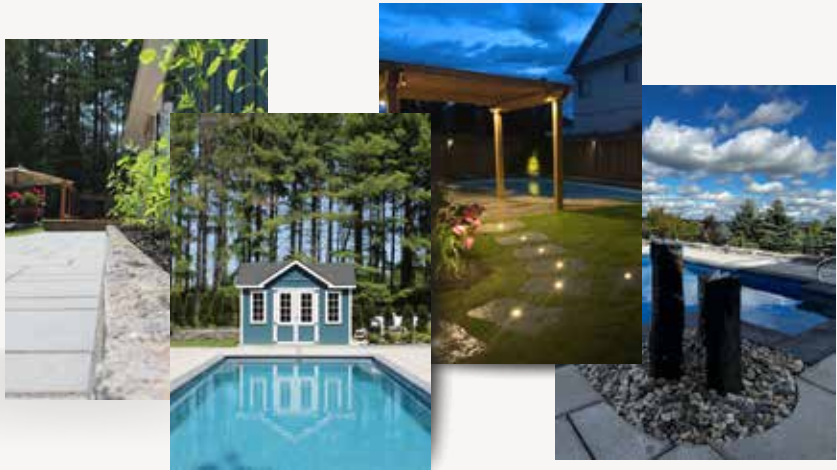

# Secondary property ownership

**O**wning a secondary property – whether a vacation home, rental, or investment property – can be rewarding, but it comes with financial and tax responsibilities.

Understanding these implications is crucial for informed decision-making.

## Personal use vs. rental use

Properties used primarily for personal enjoyment, such as cottages or vacation homes, are considered personal-use property. Capital gains tax may apply when the property is sold. Rental properties generate income that must be reported, and many related expenses – such as property taxes, mortgage interest, insurance, and maintenance – may be deductible. Short-term or commercial rentals may also require GST/HST registration.

## Ongoing costs and record-keeping

Owners should budget for property taxes, mortgage payments, insurance, maintenance, and utilities. Keeping detailed records of rental income, expenses, and capital improvements is essential for tax reporting. Municipal permits may be required for certain rental activities.

## Tax implications

Selling a secondary property can trigger capital gains tax. The taxable gain is calculated as the following:

$$\text{Capital gain} = \text{Proceeds of disposition} - \text{Adjusted cost base} - \text{Outlays and expenses}$$

One-half of the capital gain is included in the seller's income for tax purposes. Rental income is fully taxable and must be reported on your tax return. However, owners can deduct eligible expenses directly related to earning that income, including property taxes, mortgage interest, insurance, utilities, and maintenance.

## When to consult an accountant

An accountant can provide guidance at key stages: before purchasing a secondary property, when selling, if renting, or when transferring ownership to family. Working with an accountant can help minimize tax liabilities and ensure compliance with regulations, whether the property is for personal enjoyment or income generation.

# A walk through time: Inside Beaumont Mill Antiques

**N**estled in the heart of Glen Williams is a proud limestone building with deep roots and a new lease on life. Originally built in 1878, the Beaumont Mill spent over a century producing woollen socks, mittens, and blankets for generations of Canadians. We have one of the best selections of vintage vinyl, militaria, stamps, rocks, and minerals in southern Ontario at our market. Oddities and rarities of every sort round out our selection. If it is unique and unusual, you are certain to find it at our market."

What sets the market apart more than the inventory is the atmosphere. The Beaumont Mill antique shop is a destination shopping experience, and visitors of all ages enjoy their time relaxing and looking around treasure hunting.

"It's just a nice place to walk around," Elliott says. "People come here because they like to - when they need a break, they grab a coffee and

browse on their lunch hour. people just come in and love the building and love the feel of it, and we get our customers so well"

posters and brochures to promote local events and contests!

# Start your holidays at *Light Up the Hills*

Every year on December 1, the countdown begins for Ignition, the moment Dominion Garden Park bursts to life as thousands of lights turn on together. Excitement fills the air as more than 2,000 families, friends, and volunteers share in the magic.

When the park lights up, Festival President Michele Cameron can't help but smile, knowing that months of planning and teamwork have all come together for this special moment.

This is Ignition Night, the kickoff to six festive weeks of the Light Up the Hills Festival. Visitors can stroll through the displays nightly from 5:00 to 11:00 p.m., soaking up the sights and spirit of the season.

And yes, Santa will be there! Little Obie, the CN Safety Train, will also be set up in the adjacent parking lot giving rides, and the Halton Hills Fire Department has been invited to bring one of their trucks for a fun, family-friendly "touch-a-truck"

experience. It's all part of what makes Ignition such a memorable way to start the holiday season.

Light Up the Hills has become a treasured Georgetown holiday tradition. Families, couples, and friends come from near and far to take in the spectacular lights. This year promises to be just as special when Ignition Night returns on December 1.

It all comes together through incredible community effort, creativity, and care.

Many are surprised to learn the festival isn't a Town-organized event. It is completely volunteer-run by a dedicated team that brings holiday cheer to life each year.

The core team includes seven board members, a few long-time helpers, and plenty of new faces each year, from students completing volunteer hours to neighbours who simply want to lend a hand.

"We're so grateful to see people of all ages come together," says Cameron.

"It's amazing how everyone pitches in to make Light Up the Hills happen."

Earlier this year, the team held a 50/50 draw to cover some replacement costs. It was a success, and one lucky winner went home with \$1,377.50.

Creating such a large display takes funding and planning, but Light Up the Hills remains proudly free to attend, something Cameron says is central to its mission.

"That's what it's all about," she says. "Keeping it free so everyone can share in the joy and the spirit of the season."

Fundraising helps make it possible.

The team runs a December prize raffle to help with operational costs, and this year's grand prize is four box seats for the Toronto Maple Leafs versus Vancouver Canucks game, perfect for hockey fans.

Community partners like Tim Hortons make the festival extra special. Along with generous financial support, the local franchise owner donates Timbits and more than 1,000 cups of hot chocolate for Ignition Night visitors.

Other key supporters include Mountainview Residence and Terrace, CN, and many local businesses and residents whose contributions, big and small, keep the lights shining bright.

Light Up the Hills also applies for grants, such as the one in 2022 that helped fund five new displays. To stay sustainable, a few older ones may retire this year, making room for new designs in the future.

Visitors can also take part in one of the festival's most touching traditions, the Memory Balls. More than 500 clear ornaments are hung on glowing trees, each representing someone special remembered during the season.

This year introduces something new: Paw Print Legacy Balls to honour beloved pets. Displayed in a special area, they join the Memory Trees in celebrating the lives that have brightened our homes and hearts.

With new displays, familiar traditions, and thousands of sparkling lights, Light Up the Hills is a holiday must-visit. Bring your family, enjoy a hot chocolate, buy



a raffle ticket, and be part of a Georgetown tradition that continues to shine thanks to community spirit and local support.

"Seeing the park full of families, laughter, and light – that's why we do it," Cameron says. "It's a reminder of how much this community shines together."

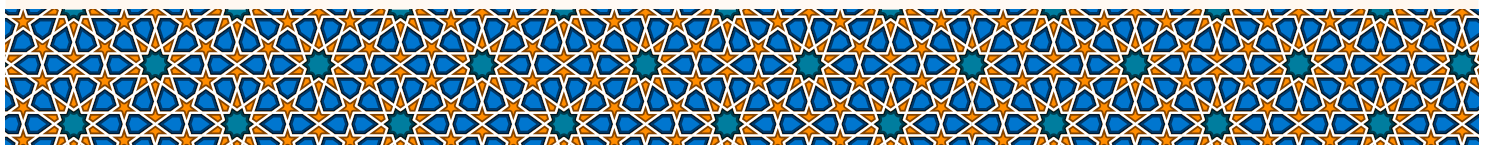

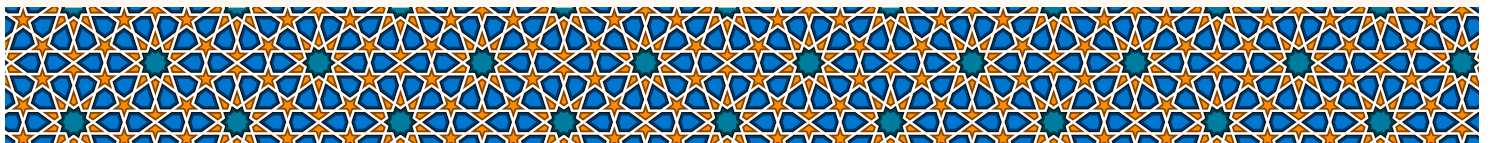

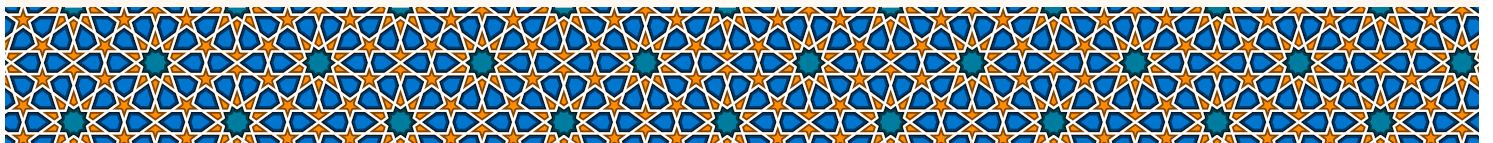

## RAIL SAFETY TIPS

**SPEED MISPERCEPTION** – Because of their size, trains appear to be much farther away and travelling much slower than their actual speed. Don't be fooled!

**TRAINS CAN'T STOP QUICKLY** – The average train needs at least 2 km to stop. Trains can stop, but they can't stop quickly!

**TRESPASSING** – Taking a shortcut across the tracks or being on railway property is illegal, and trespassers can be seriously injured or killed.

**WEIGHT RATIO** – An average freight train weighs over 5,500 tonnes. Compare that to a car, which weighs about 1.5 tonnes. A train hitting a car is like a car hitting a pop can.

**RAILWAY CARS** – Stopped railway cars can move at any time. If you're on one or near one when it moves, you could lose a limb - or worse, your life.

**TUNNELS AND BRIDGES** – Tunnels, bridges, and trestles are designed only for trains. Trespassers can be seriously injured or killed.

**OVERHANG** – Trains can carry loads that are wider than the railroad cars themselves. Chains, straps, or other equipment may extend outside the car. If you stand too close, you could get hit.

**ANY TIME IS TRAIN TIME** – Trains do not always run on schedule. They can run at any time, on any track, and come from any direction.

# Why can't I sleep and what actually helps

**R**oughly, one in three adults worldwide have insomnia symptoms, and about 10 per cent of adults meet the criteria for insomnia disorder. Yet, what many people think helps might actually reduce their sleep quality.

Three things that you might do to fall asleep faster but that reduce sleep quality:

1. Alcohol/THC/CBD;
2. Eating too close to bedtime;
3. Staying up too late.

All three of the above might help someone fall asleep faster but they will not be able to get into restorative sleep. Even if you do sleep through the night, you will not wake feeling rested!

If sleep doesn't come easy to you, maybe it's time to try the 10-3-2-1-0 rule:

- 10 hours before bed: No more caffeine.
- Three hours before bed: No more food or alcohol.

- Two hours before bed: No more work.
- One hour before bed: No more screen time (shut off all phones, TVs and computers).
- Zero: The number of times you hit snooze in the morning.

I've heard many people tell me that caffeine doesn't affect their ability to sleep, yet they have a coffee or tea after dinner and don't sleep well. One thing I've found is that if you follow this rule for a month and then try to have caffeine late, you will notice it keeps you up!

When your body digests food or processes alcohol, your heart rate elevates. When your heart rate is elevated in your sleep to digest your food, it will not be able to work on restoring your body.

Two hours before bed, it's important to do no work. Most people can easily see that sending emails or job-related work will increase your stress and your cortisol, but other things that can raise your cortisol too – getting kids to bed, making lunches, cleaning up the kitchen... and the list could go on. The



question I have for you is, can you do any of those things earlier?

Many people might ask, what would I do if I weren't on my phone or watching TV before bed? You might even say it relaxes you. Unfortunately, study after study shows that screens are stimulating, especially blue light screens. Maybe, it's time to take up reading, or a hobby like drawing, journaling, or knitting, or step up the nighttime beauty routine?

Set your alarm for when you truly want to get out of bed. Pushing the snooze is the worst thing you can do because it sets you into another sleep cycle. The average sleep cycle is 90 mins, so if every 10 mins you're starting a new sleep cycle, your body is disappointed that it won't get the full 90.

Pick just one change to start with! Don't just try it one night – try it for a whole month and see if your sleep improves! ♦
