Available in an 8-millimeter thickness, its polished finish enhances light reflection, amplifying the material's visual dimensionality.

Pearl Finish

Pearl is a contemporary wood finish blending a soft, luminous white base with delicate caramel undertones. Hoyos said the interplay between the light background and warm nuances creates a subtle pearlescent effect to the primarily matte finish, adding depth texture, and natural contrast that enhances the wood grain.

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
