

It "Dawned" On Me... a message from Dawn Giganti

Dear Creative Carpet & Flooring Friends and Family,

I wanted to share something that happened recently... something that shook me but also reminded me of who's really in control.

The first Tuesday in March, I was at work when my dad called. My mom had a strange cough and then passed out. He called 911, and they rushed her to the hospital. I could tell he was holding it together, but I knew better. I dropped everything and rushed to pick him up to meet her at the hospital.

Let me tell you, I lost it in the car. I cried out to God, "Don't take my mom! Not now. I'm not ready." My parents are turning 77 this year, and no matter how long they live, I won't be ready. But that's the thing... I'm not supposed to have it all figured out. I had to remind myself that this wasn't my plan to control. It never was. I had to trust God's plan, even when it didn't make sense or felt unfair. His plan is always bigger, always better.

Mom stayed in the hospital for three days. Her blood sugar was high, and her heart rate was off, but she's okay. She's following up with doctors and wearing a heart monitor for two weeks. I'm thankful for every day I get with her and my dad.

As Easter nears, I reflect on the resurrection, not just of Jesus, but of our trust in Him. Life is unpredictable and scary, but we don't need to have it all figured out. We just need to trust that God is working behind the scenes. I'm learning to trust Him more, and Easter reminds me He's in control, no matter what.

Maybe you've had a moment like this, too, where life hits hard, and you realize just how little control you have. It's terrifying! But I'm learning to trust Him, and I hope you are too. Easter reminds us that resurrection and hope are always ahead.

Richter Scale Day: Shaking Up Earth Science

Richter Scale Day is celebrated every year on April 26, marking the birthday of American seismologist Charles F. Richter, born on April 26, 1900. On this day, we honor the man who revolutionized how we measure earthquakes with his invention of the Richter Scale in 1935.


Earthquakes are natural events caused by the movement of tectonic plates beneath the Earth's surface. When these plates shift or slip, they release immense energy, creating shockwaves that result in tremors and, in some cases, catastrophic earthquakes. The Richter Scale was developed to measure these seismic waves' strength. This scale measures the energy released during an earthquake, ranging from 0 to 9, with each number representing an earthquake ten times more powerful than the previous one.

For instance, earthquakes of magnitude 4.5 can cause damage to buildings, while those above a 7.0 on the Richter Scale can cause severe destruction. The most powerful earthquakes, like the 9.5 magnitude earthquake in Chile in 1960, release unimaginable amounts of energy.

Throughout history, many devastating earthquakes have been recorded. Some of the most notable ones include the 1906 San Francisco earthquake (7.8), the 1923 Great Kanto Earthquake in Japan (8.3), and the 2004 Indian Ocean earthquake (9.0), which created the deadliest tsunami in recorded history. More recently, the 2023 earthquakes in Turkey and Syria, which measured 7.8 and 7.5, tragically killed tens of thousands of people.

How can you observe Richter Scale Day? Here are a few ideas:

- Learn how the Richter Scale works and its impact on understanding earthquakes.
- Watch an earthquake-themed disaster movie like *San Andreas* or *Earthquake*.
- Discover more about the science behind seismic activity and how it affects our planet.

Richter Scale Day is about the science of earthquakes and remembering the lives these natural disasters affect. So, take a moment to appreciate how far we've come in understanding seismic activity thanks to Charles F. Richter's groundbreaking work.



Answer: (A) Abraham Lincoln

Lincoln's first inauguration was on March 4, 1861. Lincoln was inaugurated in March instead of January because, at the time, the U.S. Constitution set March 4 as the official inauguration date. This was originally established to allow enough time for election results to be finalized, for the new president to travel to Washington, D.C., and for an orderly transition of power. However, as transportation and communication improved, the long gap between Election Day in November and the March inauguration became unnecessary. To shorten this "lame duck" period, the 20th Amendment, ratified in 1933, moved Inauguration Day to January 20, starting with Franklin D. Roosevelt's second term in 1937.
