SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE



At Valley Park School, Sixth Form students are role models within the community and are expected to uphold high standards of dress so students in Years 7 - 11 can follow their example.

Whilst students in the Sixth Form have some freedom to dress as individuals, they have a responsibility to set a good example and encourage the respect of younger students and the local community.



We therefore expect our Sixth Form students to maintain consistently high standards of dress and require all Sixth Form students to be smart and tailored in their appearance.

We want students to express self-confidence, pride and gain a sense of the standards expected in professional workplaces and our surrounding community.



The Sixth Form Team reserve the right to decide what is considered appropriate.

All students must abide by the following guidelines:



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Suits

It is optional to wear a two-piece tailored business suit.

Jackets

Tailored jackets/blazers can be worn with your choice of dress

Trousers

- Trousers must be tailored and smart
- No leggings are to be worn
- Leather/denim/chino look trousers should not be worn



Skirts

- Skirts should be of appropriate length near to the knee
- Leather/denim look skirts should not be worn

Dresses

Dresses should be of appropriate length near to the knee



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Tops

- Collared shirts must be always worn with a tie.
- Blouses and shirts must be worn to compliment smart professional trousers/skirts and blazers
- A thin, smart jumper, cardigan, quarter zip to compliment shirt and tie, or blouse can be worn
- T-shirts and strappy tops are not to be worn
- Sweatshirts and Hoodies are not to be worn



Footwear

- Formal footwear must be worn. Smart, flat shoes or heels of suitable height may be worn. Platforms/ trainers are not permitted.



Coats

- Outdoor coats may be of any colour/ style, but they must be smart and practical.
- Coats must not be worn indoors. Denim/Leather jackets are not acceptable.



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Scarves

- Outdoor scarves must not be worn around the inside of the school.

Jewellery

- Plain, simple, practical and discreet jewellery is allowed.

Piercings

- Piercings must be kept to a minimum and discreet



Make-Up

- Discreet makeup may be worn

Branded clothing

- Branded clothing is not permitted.

Lanyards and ID Badges

- Lanyards and ID Badges are part of the Sixth Form Uniform at Valley Park School and must be worn at all times.
