What goes into the preliminary application?

Information provided in the Preliminary Application is not considered final (i.e. budget or team composition) but should give a clear indication of the proposed research, activities, and partnerships.

The Preliminary Application must be submitted via the SEA DREAM Application Portal by the Principal Investigator from the Lead Organisation.

Preliminary Application is **mandatory**. Only applicants who submit a Preliminary Application may be invited to submit a Full Application.

How will we assess preliminary applications?

Preliminary applications are assessed through a neutral internal review process conducted by experts from SEA DREAM, the Wellcome Trust, and the Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office (FCDO), based on the following criteria:

1.

Alignment with Thematic Areas

Assesses how well the proposal aligns with one or more SEA DREAM priority themes: Infectious Diseases, Impact of Climate Change on Health, Mental Health, and Health Systems and Access to Care.

2.

Alignment with SEA DREAM Objectives

Evaluates the extent to which the proposal contributes to SEA DREAM's objectives, including generating impactful research, nurturing leadership and talent development, fostering regional collaboration, and strengthening research ecosystems.

3.

Indicative Budget and Milestones

Reviews whether the proposed budget and milestones are realistic, and proportionate to the scope of work.

4.

Principal Investigator and Research Team Capacity

Examines the qualifications, experience, and leadership capacity of the PI and research team. Team composition, role distribution, management and mentorship arrangements should be clearly justified and fit for the proposed research.
