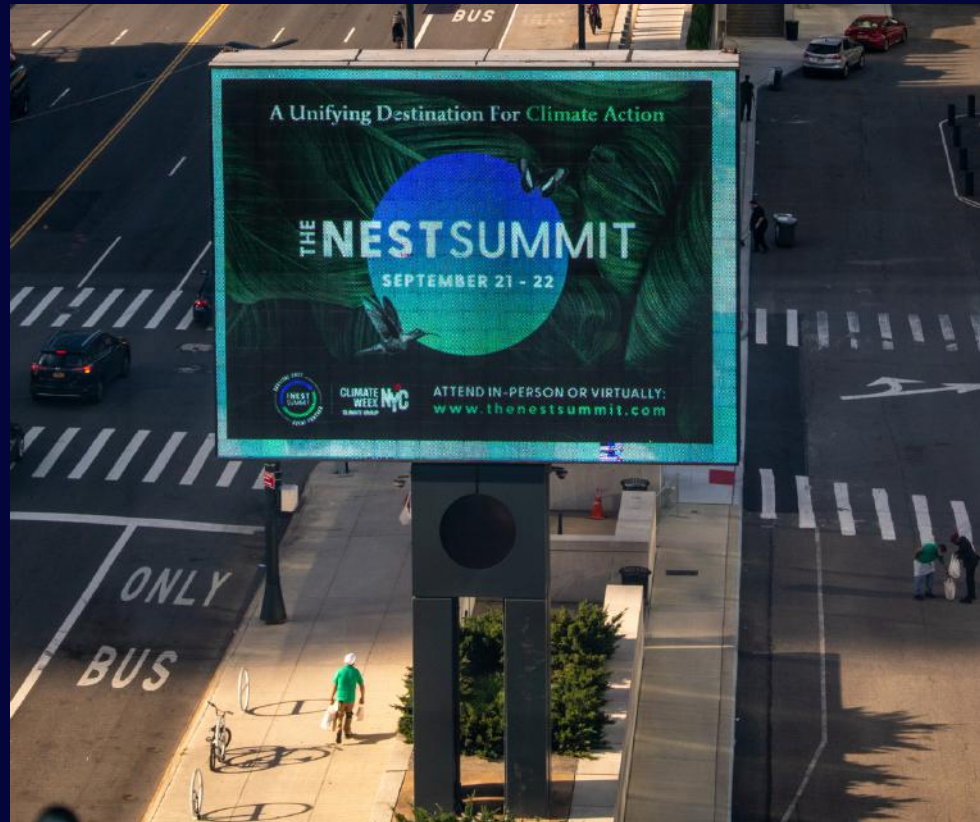

"The impacts of climate change seem to be **arriving now**. But when we talk about solutions, they tend to seem kind of far away – in the future, or in a state capitol somewhere, or in the UN – somewhere far away from us and far away from **now**.

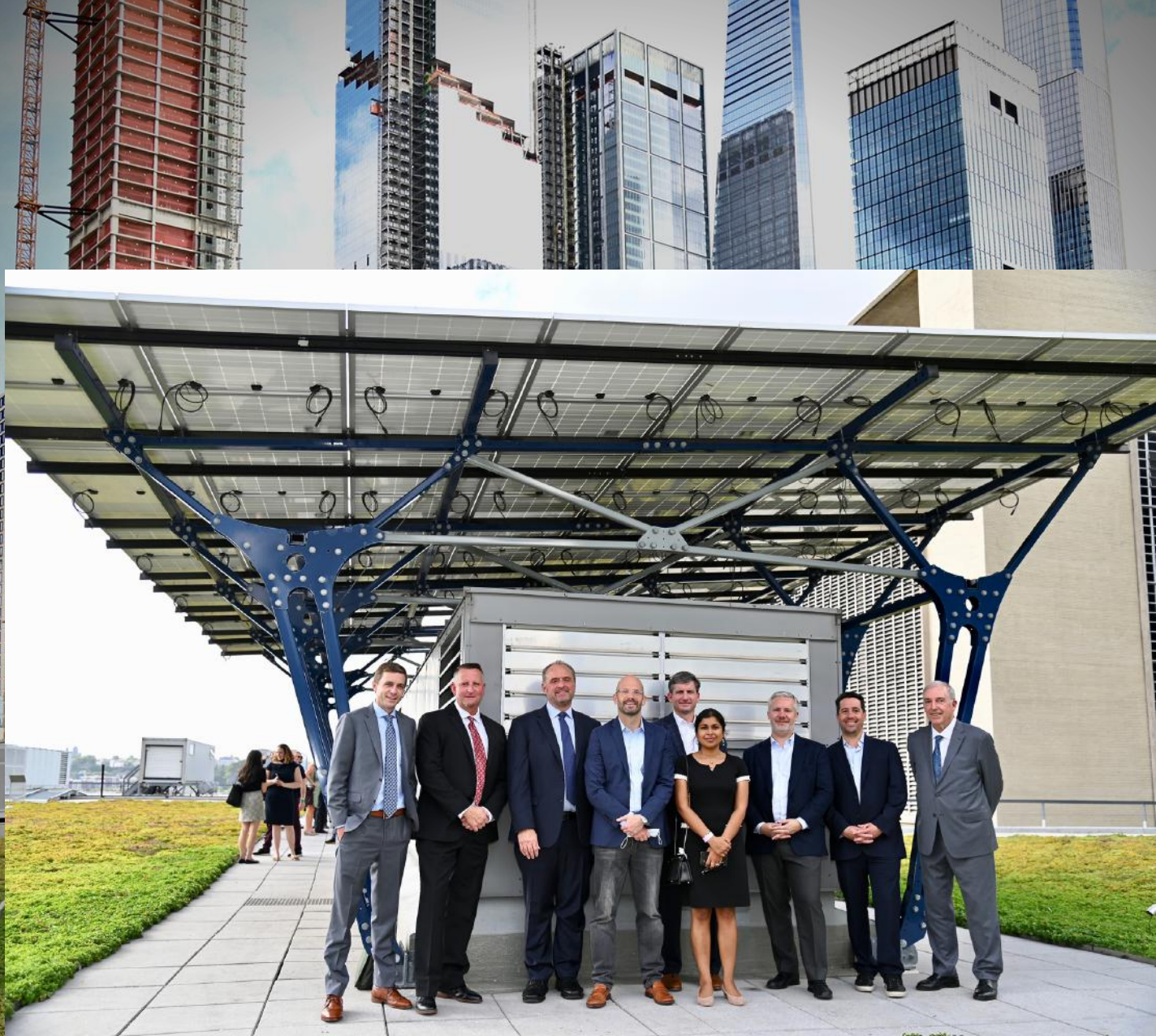

Aiding the Javits Center in its commitment to advancing sustainability and furthering New York state's path to carbon neutrality, Siemens will design, construct, and install nearly 3,000 solar panels. The unique canopy design, which is built atop existing HVAC units, was created to accommodate the convention center's green roof without disturbing the roof's thriving ecosystem, which is currently home to 35 bird species, five bat species and thousands of honeybees.

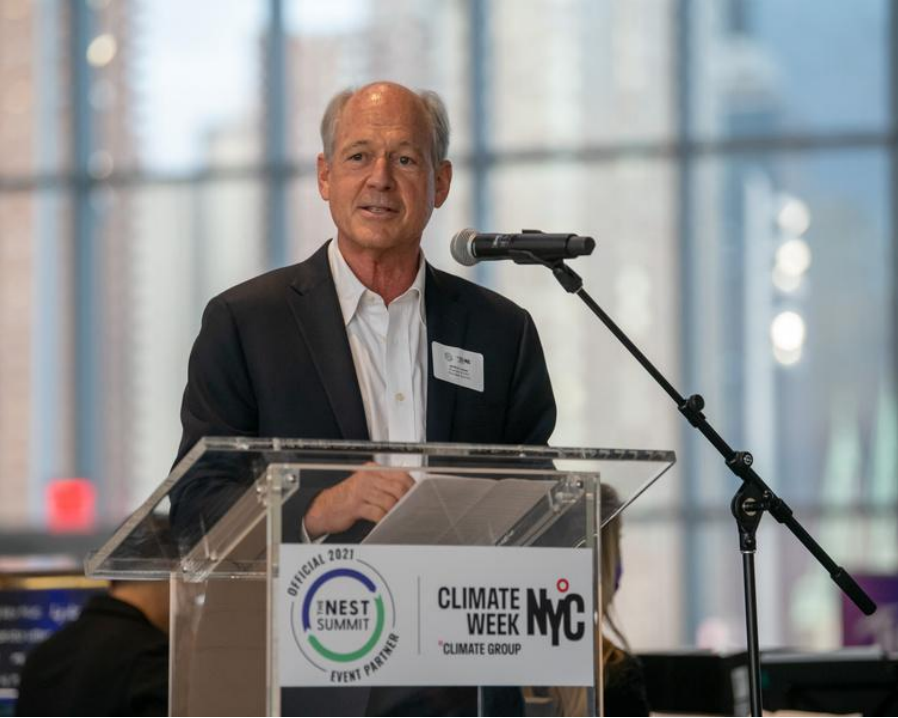

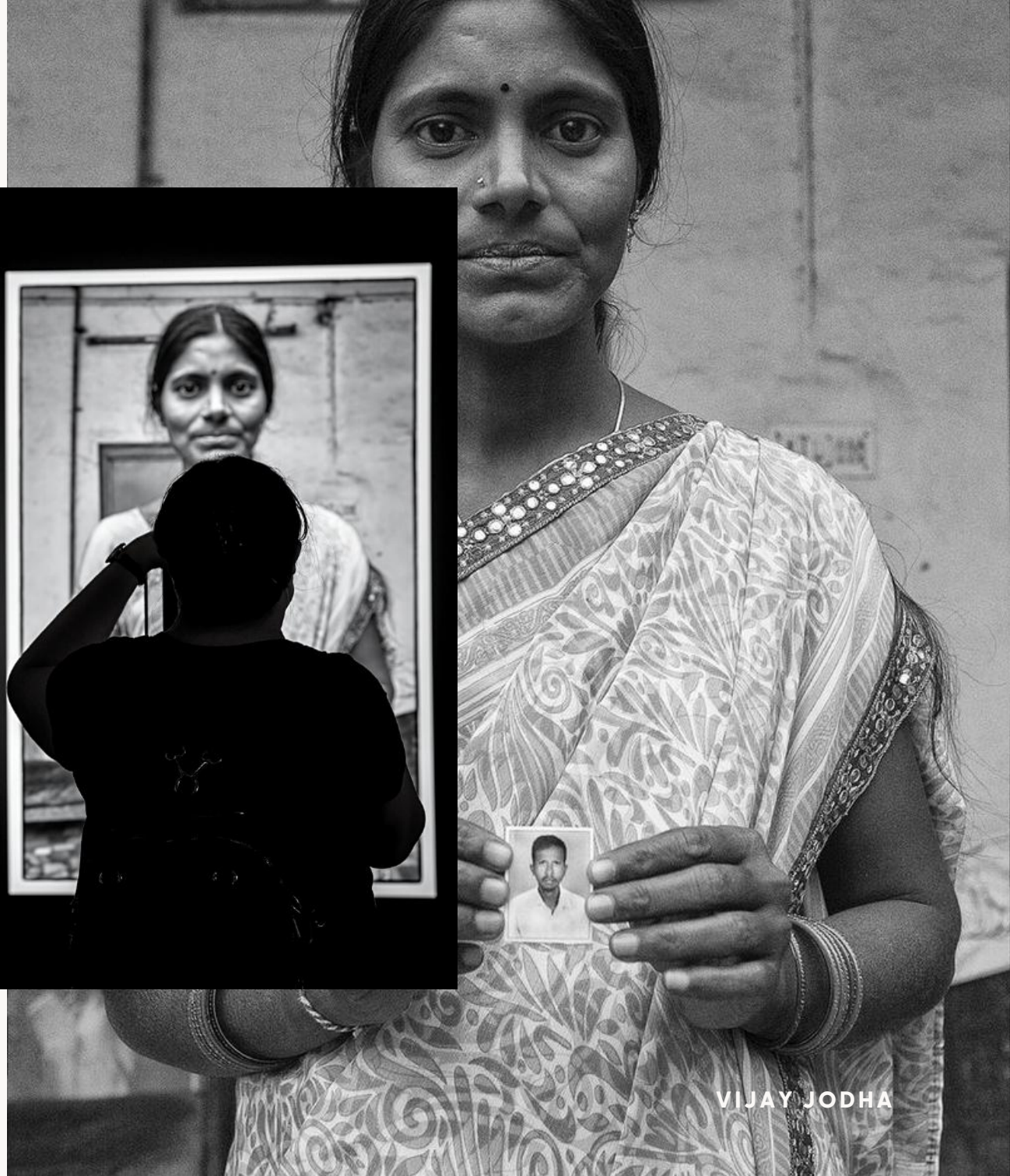
