When two letters come together to make one sound, it is called a digraph. In words with a digraph, there are more letters than sounds like in /ch/ /o/ /p/.

Digraph Fun

- Digraphs can be in the beginning, middle, and end of a word.
- Here are some words with ch digraphs: chip, chin, and lunch.
- With digraphs, there are fewer sounds than letters. For example, pinch has five letters but only four sounds /p/ /i/ /n/ /ch/. The ch is the digraph.

High-Frequency Words

come	play
me	when

Decodable Words can be sounded out based on the letter-sound relationships.

High-Frequency Words are the most commonly used words. Your reader will begin to recognize them.

Digraphs are the combination of two letters to represent one sound, as in /sh/ in ship.
