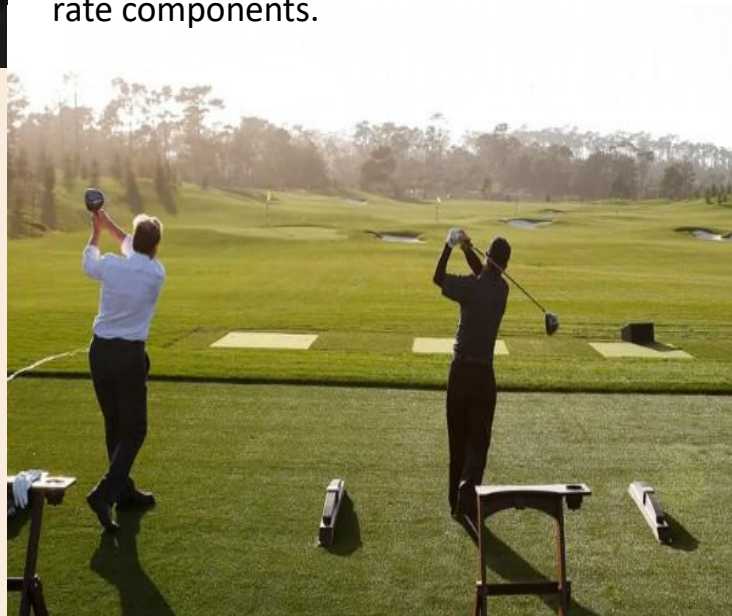
Club Fittings & Putter Fittings

Our Practice Facility Features

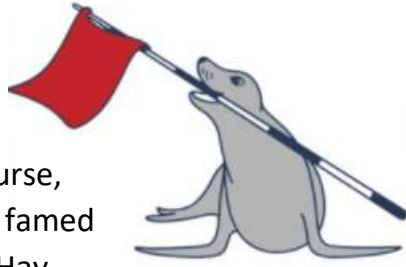
- A 350-yard double-ended driving range which hosts 300 guests and members per day.

The original Peter Hay course, opened in 1957, honored famed Head Professional, Peter Hay.

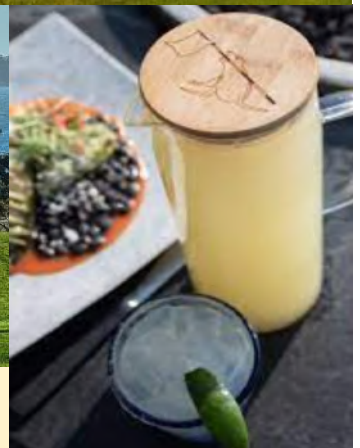
This course was redesigned by Tiger Woods in 2021 and includes an exact replica of the picturesque Hole No.7 at Pebble Beach Golf

Why is Pebble Beach so famous?

Pebble Beach Golf Links is an iconic links-style championship venue with coastal holes along Stillwater Cove and Carmel Bay.

PEBBLE BEACH HAS HOSTED six US Opens—more than any other course over the last 50 years, and is the annual host of the star-studded PGA AT&T Tournament.

PEBBLE BEACH IS KNOWN FOR its challenging **small-target greens**, its seaside holes such as the **famous number 7** (a fantastic photo op for many players), its **unforgiving par 5's** (which are usually a chance for a birdie, but not at Pebble Beach), and **hole number 18** which has been deemed the finest and most famous finishing holes in golf, testing you off the tee with the ocean on the left and a Cypress tree in the fairway.

Spyglass Hill Golf Course

Spyglass Hill Golf Course

The opening five holes feature pristine ocean views along Stillwater Cove, after which the course takes a turn into the awe-inspiring Del Monte Forest.

With its narrow fairways and elevated greens Spyglass hill is widely considered Pebble Beach Resort's most challenging golf course.

Ranked #10 in Golf Digest's list of America's 100 Greatest Public Courses.

Each hole is named after a famed character or element from local author Robert Lewis Stephenson's novel, *Treasure Island*.



In addition to a putting green and short game practice area, Spyglass Hill features its own serene driving range surrounded by walls of tall Cypress trees.

The Links at Spanish Bay

What is a “True Links” Golf Course?

A true links course is **located alongside the sea.**

It consists of sandy soil and has little vegetation other than tall sea grasses and gorse (a hearty, low growing, evergreen plant). **The natural terrain** is used to develop the golf holes.

Many courses along the ocean can be defined as “Links-style,” but the Links at Spanish Bay has earned this highly coveted title of “True Links.”

Del Monte Golf Course



“Old Del Monte” Golf Course can be described as a Pebble Beach quality course with a park-like terrain.

Designed by Charles Maud in 1897, Del Monte Golf Course is one of the oldest golf courses in the West.

It is the original host of the California State Amateur since its inception in 1987.
