The Galapagos Collection was created by Adriana and her daughter, Andrea Perez. The collection has Adriana's style combined with her daughter's youth and freshness. As lovers of nature and Ecuador's landscapes, mother-daughter duo wanted to pay tribute to one of the most unique places on the planet. They were both inspired by its colors, shapes and textures, to create what they themselves have named their more personal collection.



A place like *No other*

These enchanting islands feature some of the world's most unique and endemic wildlife species and beaches. This playground for scientists offers its visitors a spectacle to be admired. The archipelago is blessed with pleasant weather all year round, so there is no "best" time to visit the precious islands.

The Archipelago is a group of 19 islands of different sizes, and dozens of islets and rocks that cover an area of over 17,000 square miles. Its closest point to the mainland is 600 miles from the West coast of Ecuador in South America.

We adapted the concept of biomimicry to design and create products that offer a sense of purpose and awareness to a location many dream of visiting. The Galapagos collection incorporates the natural colors, textures, movements, and landscapes of the islands to create pieces that form a nature-inspired sanctuary for a myriad of interior living spaces, which seeks to promote wellness and comfort.



Creative *Process*

Adriana and Andrea spent countless days observing the organic shapes of the Galapagos' flora and fauna. When they returned from their trip they began the creative process: transforming the ideation into sketches and the sketches into physical prototypes until the Galapagos Collection was born.

Blue-footed Booby chair

The Galapagos Dining Chair 100 is inspired by the blue-footed and its rippling lines that make it an elegant and unique piece. It has a sophisticated upholstered structure that covers and simulates the “second skin” of the two-toned bird. The chair’s upholstery, curves, and arms were inspired by the bird’s flared arms, spayed legs and beautiful wings.

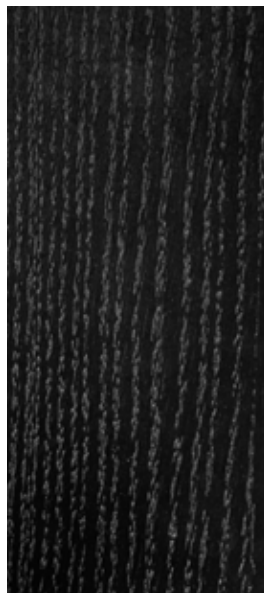

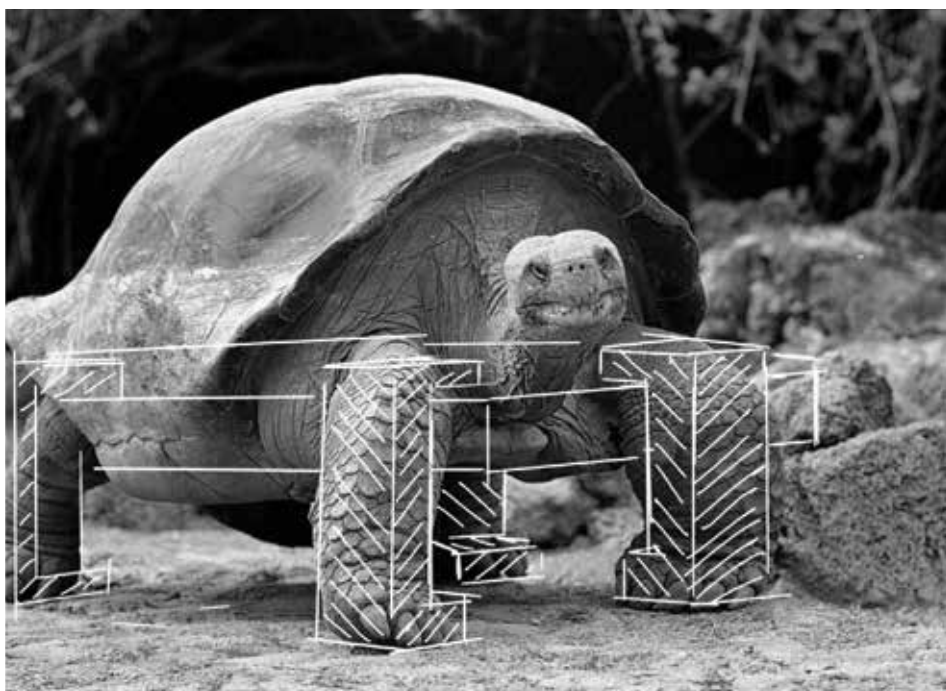




Giant Tortoise

Cocktail Table

The legs of the Galapagos tortoise, like those of the 200 table, are characterized by its robustness. The legs of this piece make it stable so that the entire structure can be supported by it. The distinct tone of the top resembles the color of the turtle's shell when the legs peek through it.





Sea Turtle Upholstered Chair

The Galapagos Upholstered Chair 200 is an icon in this collection. It is designed for smaller spaces that need comfortable, practical pieces that do not take up much space. This chair's rounded shape is inspired by the top view of a sea turtle's shell and its arms simulate its legs.



Volcano

Cocktail Table

Inspired by the crater of a volcano and its conical and imposing forms, the structure is formed by wood pieces that start from the base and end on the top. Its glass top allows for appreciation of the table's interior shape.



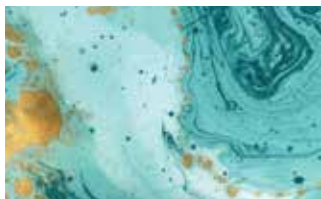

B L U E O C E A N & S K Y

Blue is a color with infinite tones. In its lighter tones, it brings freshness and a feeling of spaciousness in the environments, while the darker shades give just the right touch of elegance and sophistication.







Giant Cactus

This table gives the feeling of movement, because of its unique form.

Its shape is inspired by the cactus, an iconic plant in the islands and its irregularly shaped leaves.





Iconic Upholstered Chair

The Sailor upholstered chair is an ode to free-flow and craftsmanship. This iconic piece of the Galapagos collection was inspired by a sailboat's sinuous shapes on the high seas; its embracing woven high-back is a tribute to the archipelago's beauty, silhouettes, and textures.

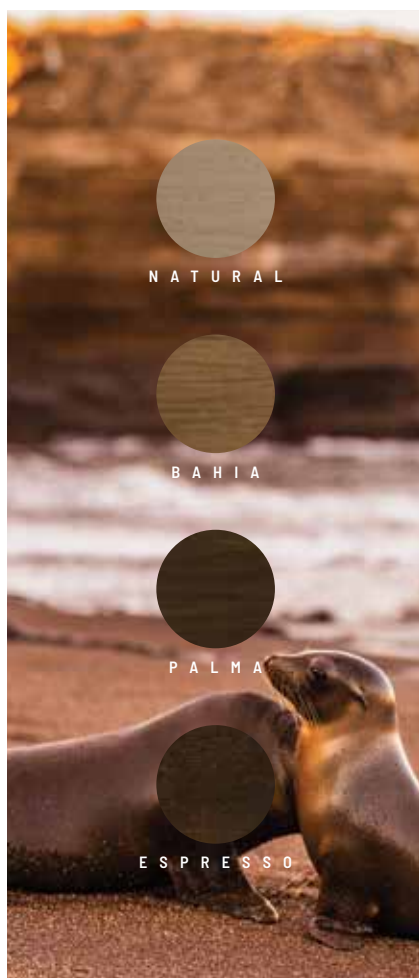


GALAPAGOS *Beaches*

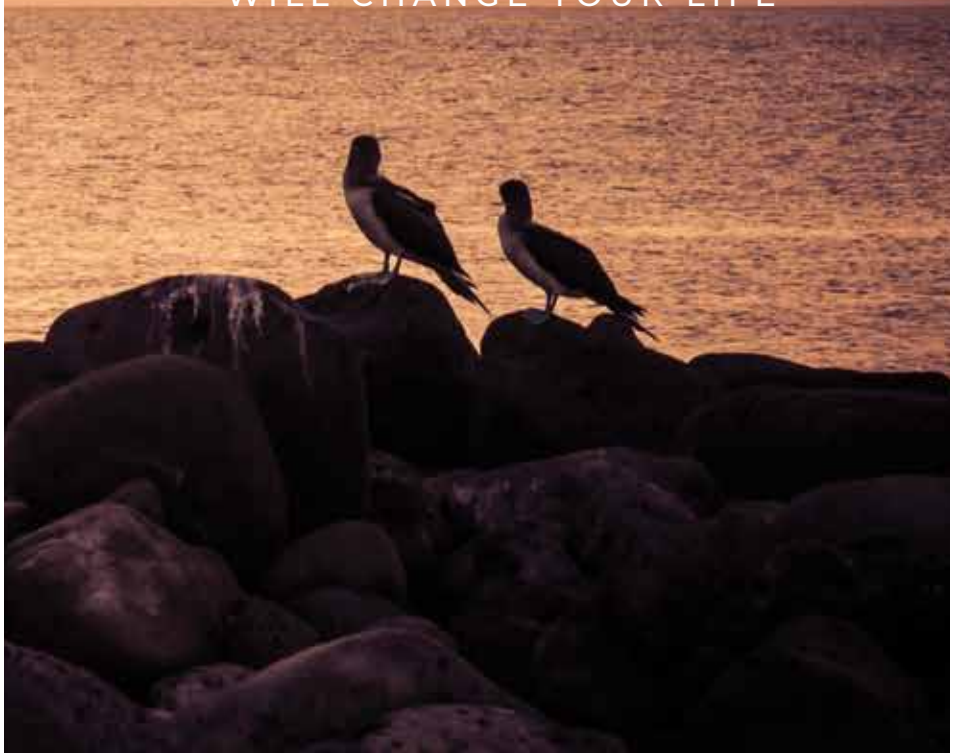


A LIFE-CHANGING EXPERIENCE

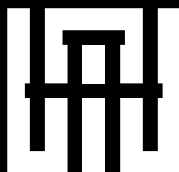
