vs Non-Resident (NR)

A resident of Southern Pines is a person, whose permanent, primary home is in the town limits of Southern Pines or who owns property within the town limits of Southern Pines on which the person pays property taxes to Southern Pines. Valid ID and documentation with proof of residency is required for resident rates.

REFUND/CANCELLATION POLICY: Any qualifying refund or credit must be requested by the payer via recreation_parks@southernpines.net at least five (5)* business days in advance of the first day of the activity. * For Summer Explorers Day Camp, a credit or refund must be requested ten (10) business days in advance of the first day of the activity. Non-refundable amounts are non-transferable. There may be non-refundable portions of any program or rental fees. Any qualifying refund issued will be less both a \$5.00 administrative fee and any non-refundable portion. Final refund amounts of \$10 or less will be issued as credits only. If the Recreation & Parks Dept. cancels an activity, a full refund is issued. The full policy and details of any non-refundable fee portions are available under *Policies* online and/or with the individual activity information.

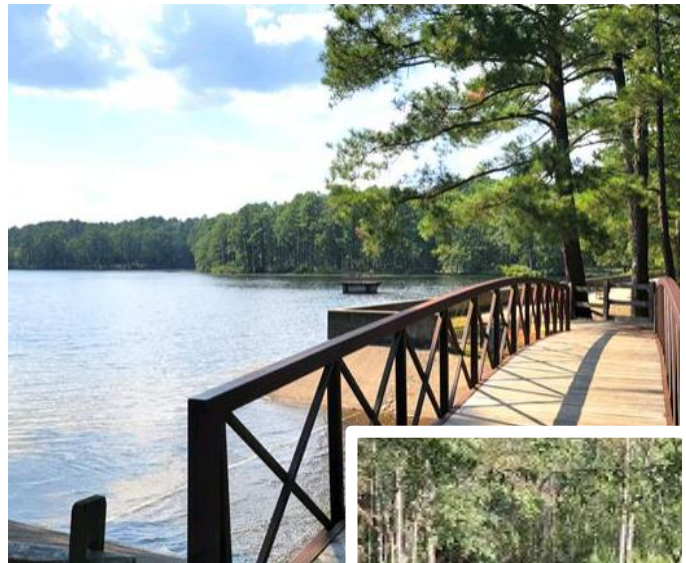

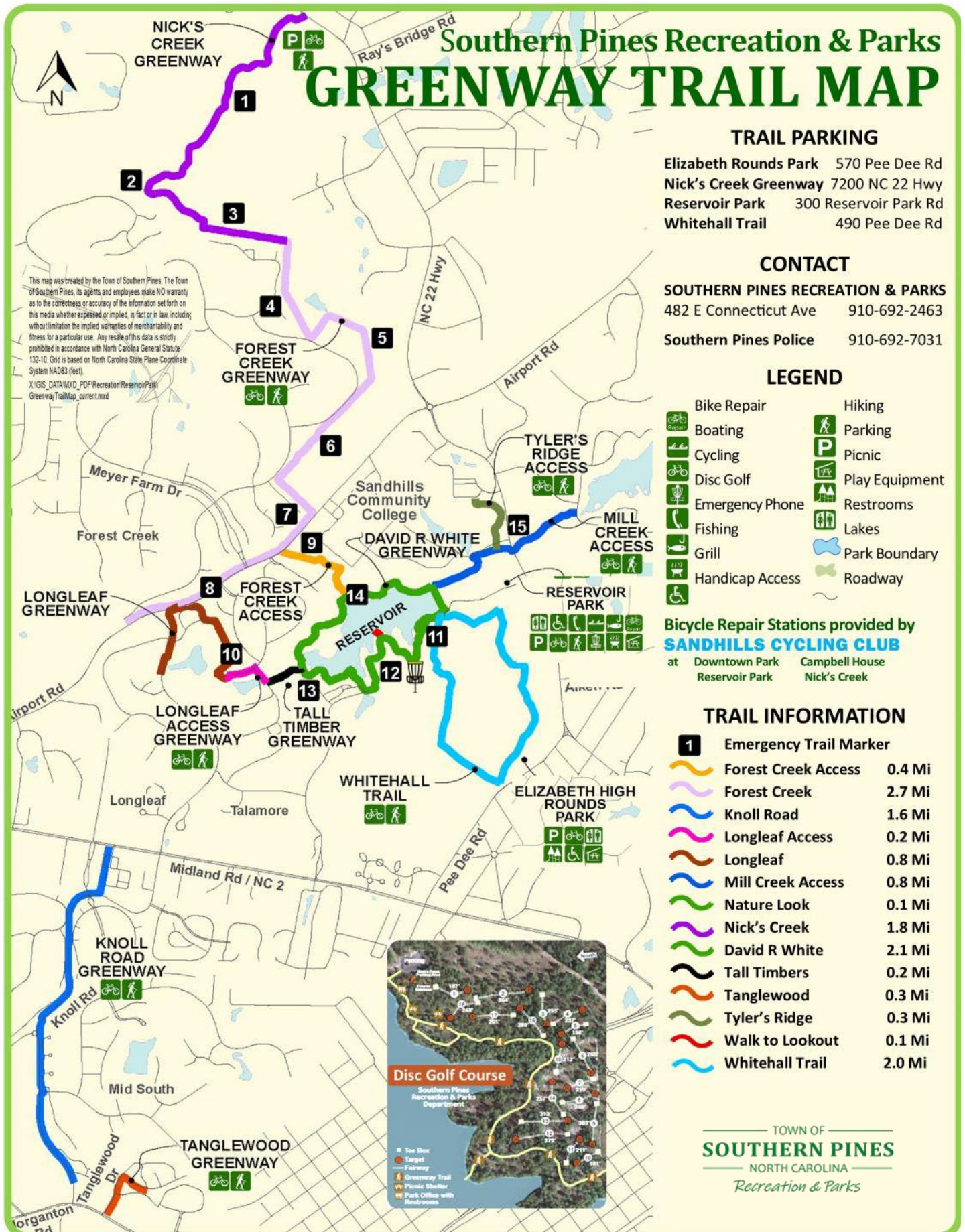

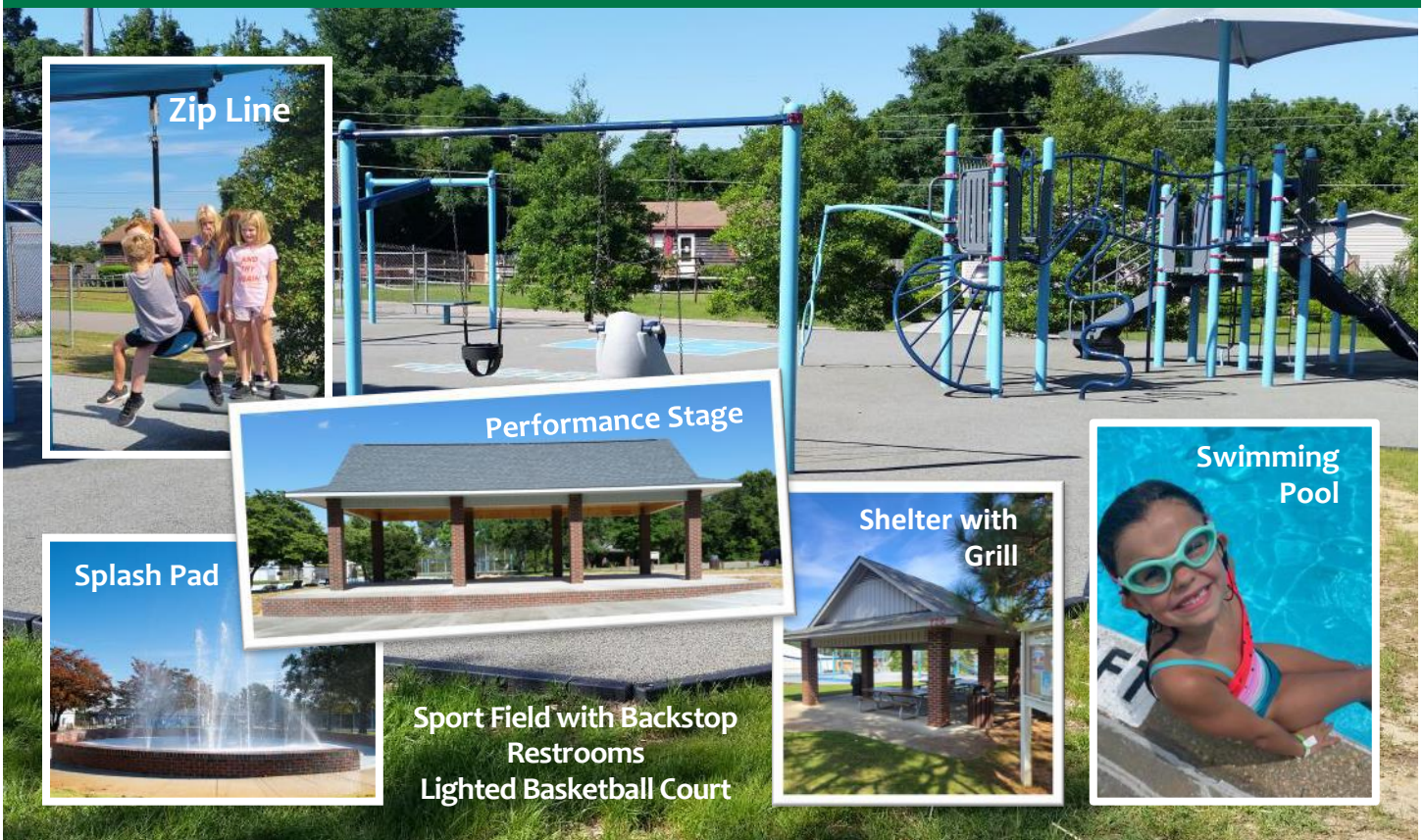
