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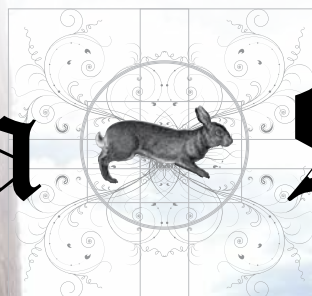

Hinterland Art School Winchelsea is entering its second year of art classes. In February 2023 Hinterland Art School commenced its offering of Art Classes in Winchelsea from Figure Drawing, Creative Drawing, Printmaking to Painting.

Classes had steady attendance and are set to commence next week. Each class gained its own rhythm and momentum establishing communities within the groups. Students were pleased to find that the Art School provided all the materials needed; from easels to drawing boards, clips, watercolours, paper, paint, visual diaries and printmaking equipment. The school has received great feedback with comments from "supporting lifelong learning" to "great value for money" and it hopes to attract an increasing number of newcomers in 2024.

Figure Drawing

The offering of classes in drawing the figure from life, here in Winch has attracted a steady following of weekly attendees. Newcomers likewise pop in for a one-off session to try their hand.

A venue change was required, from the Globe Theatre Supper Room following damage to the floor. It was a seemingly perfect venue for setting up easels in a well-lit, private and spacious area, to draw the model.

Creative Drawing.

Held in at St Thomas Church Hall, with great natural light and access to all materials. Students will progress from a traditional class set up, to a studio scenario with one-to-one tuition.

The change of venue to St Thomas Church Hall has been ideal, offering all the above and improved room dimensions. HASW is most grateful to St Thomas for the use of the venue.

Printmaking

The last of the HASW classes to hit the ground running! This class commenced in June 2023, conducted in the home studio, which is set within the home garden. The class offers skills in mono printing, lino cutting and dry point etching. In this well-equipped studio you can test ideas, refresh skills and try a new technique. The press bed a comfortable 45 x 70 cm.

Painting.

Also started in a brand-new location in Term 3, The Star Room, sporting a warm, intimate, well-lit space at the Neighbourhood House, Winchelsea.

Painting classes offer a selection of water-based mediums, sub straights and mixed media applications, from blending of water-soluble graphite and pencils to acrylic and latex block out mediums to oil pastels. Each week, students have produced a range of experimental works gaining proficiency across a range of media.

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Older and wiser: driving courses available in Lorne, Aireys Inlet, and Torquay

Free courses for older people, supporting them across various modes of transport, are available in Lorne, Aireys Inlet and Torquay.

The courses being delivered in February and March cover themes including being a wiser driver, walker, traveller, motorised scooter, and wheelchair user, and range from a one-day event to three, to four weeks in duration.

Lorne Ward Councillor Gary Allen said last year's program was a success, with attendees expressing a renewed sense of confidence on the roads and footpaths.

"The informal and friendly courses are a fantastic way for ageing drivers to stay up to date. There are no driving tests, and morning or afternoon tea is also provided," Cr Allen said.

"This is a safe, inclusive environment imparting valuable knowledge on participants. It's all about updating and building on their existing knowledge.

"The course material centres on the safe mobility of ageing people and supporting them in making safe travel choices as a driver, pedestrian, or when using alternative travel options."

Cr Allen said an age-friendly community is one where older people are valued, respected, and actively supported to participate in their community.

"The Council has gained membership with the World Health Organisation's Global Network of Age Friendly Cities and Communities. The Wiser Driver courses are an important part of this membership.

"If the car is not an option, quality of life can be considerably reduced - we need to be confident accessing a wide variety of viable transport alternatives."

The Wiser Driver course is a four-week course available at the Lorne Community House February 5, 12, 19 and 26 (10am to 12pm); Aireys Inlet Community Centre February 28, March 6, 13, and 20 (1pm to 3pm); Council offices, Torquay March 1, 8, 15 and 22 (10am to 12pm or 1pm to 3pm).

The Wiser Walker, Wiser Traveller course runs for three weeks in March at the Surf Coast Shire Council Offices, Torquay March 12, 19, 26 (10am to 12pm).

The Safer Scooter, Wiser Wheelchair course is a one-day event on Monday 4 March at the Surf Coast Shire Council offices in Torquay (10am to 3pm).

Victorians Urged To Prioritise Road Safety This Year

Following a devastating year on the state's roads, the state government is urging all Victorians to make safety their priority in 2024.

Minister for Roads and Road Safety acknowledged the families, friends and communities impacted by road trauma in 2023, with 296 lives lost on Victorian roads so far this year.

Road safety is a shared responsibility, and whether driving, riding, or crossing the road, this new year Victorians are reminded to make safe choices on every journey – slow down, put the phone away, pay attention, wear a seat belt, and don't drive after drinking or taking drugs.

With fatigue a major contributor to road trauma, people travelling long distances are being urged to get a good night's sleep before driving, allow plenty of travel time, drive to the conditions, remove distractions, and take regular breaks.

Driver Reviver Australia will have 21 sites set up across Victoria throughout summer, supported by VICSES and Lions club volunteers providing the ideal location for drivers to take a break, have a free cup of coffee or tea and stretch their legs, before continuing their journey

Data shows that lower-level drink driving and speeding, failing to obey road signs and distraction accounted for more than half of fatalities on state roads in 2023.

Road safety authorities are particularly concerned with the significant increase in driver and passenger fatalities, which have risen to 189 in 2023, compared with 126 at the same time last year.

Drivers are also being urged to drive to the weather conditions especially in parts of Victoria that have experienced flooding. While recent rainfall has eased across areas under a flood watch, parts of the state may continue to experience minor

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Opening Doors photographic exhibition coming to Winchelsea

The Winchelsea Shire Hall is proud to bring its latest exhibition to you opening in February. Opening Doors, an exhibition of photographs, celebrates the power of home to transform the lives of people with disabilities.

The Opening Doors photographic exhibition, which features 28 photographs by Melbourne based photographer, Paul Dunn, is part of the Renting for All Project, created by AMIDA (Action for More Independence and Dignity in Accommodation) and produced with the assistance of The Victorian Government.

AMIDA is an independent organisation, which advocates for a broad range of safe, affordable and secure housing options for people with disability, with priority given to people with an intellectual disability.

The OPENING DOORS - Renting for All project was led by people with a

disability and has developed a range of information resources that guide people through the process of renting and the world of Real Estate.

People with disabilities face a number of challenges in accessing suitable housing - the aim of the project is to break down discrimination and barriers to a range of housing options including access to the rental market. Opening Doors includes a website which houses 40 videos made for and by people with a disability that explore the journey into the rental world.

But of course, the photographs explore much more, especially the power of safe and affordable accommodation to provide a sense of home and all that it offers us - embedding us in time and place and connecting us to others who share our interests, our values and our beliefs. Come along and witness the power that homes offer us to develop a sense of who we are and to build our connection to community. The points of connection are everywhere - in the books that are read and the way they are placed on a shelf; in the photos of families displayed; of children; of friends, and of lovers; in the art that is created or collected and placed on a wall; in the birthday cards and get well cards; in

allegiances to football teams; in the display of faiths and religious beliefs; in political allegiances; in the devotion to pets; in the beautiful design of a loved daughter's bedroom.

As well as the photographs, you will also be able to see a number of the videos as part of the exhibition program. The videos were made by award winning Australian film-maker, Lawrence Johnston who has also managed the project.

These resources have been endorsed by The Real Estate Institute of Victoria and were used in their real estate training sessions in 2020.

The OPENING DOORS - Renting For All Photographic Exhibition which was launched at the NO VACANCY Gallery in the QV Building in Lonsdale Street, Melbourne in November 2019. It has since toured to a number of regional and metropolitan galleries across Victoria and now makes its way to Winchelsea in February. The opening of the exhibition is on Saturday 17th February at 1.30pm. It will be opened by Libby Mears (former CEO of Leisure Networks) and David Petherick, CEO of the Barwon Disability Resource Centre.

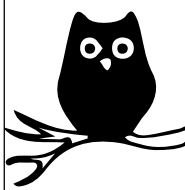
