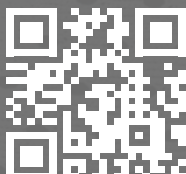

2+2 DEGREES

UNOH'S 2+2 DEGREE PROGRAMS GIVE STUDENTS THE OPPORTUNITY TO BUILD ON THEIR ASSOCIATE DEGREE AND EARN A BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN JUST TWO ADDITIONAL YEARS.

This pathway is especially beneficial for students graduating from career centers, technical schools, community colleges, or UNOH associate degree programs who are looking to build on the education and hands-on training they have already completed.

Through the 2+2 program, previously earned college credits may transfer toward a bachelor's degree program at UNOH, helping students save time and continue their education without starting over. Programs and transfer credits are subject to review to determine eligibility and degree compatibility.

Students who complete an associate degree in one of UNOH's technical programs, or graduate from a career center with an associate degree, can continue their education at UNOH by pursuing a bachelor's degree in a business-related field, combining technical expertise with leadership, management, and business skills. This combination helps prepare graduates for supervisory roles, management opportunities, and long-term career advancement in their industry.

Accountants comprise the backbone of every business, whether it be a restaurant, non-profit organization, or Fortune 500 corporation. The UNOH Accounting program will teach you how to organize financial reports, evaluate financial operations, examine financial statements for legal compliance, and make recommendations to management.

UNOH offers three accounting tracks to match your career goals. The traditional Accounting program prepares you to become a managerial accountant and provides the foundation needed to pursue your CMA certification.

The Forensic Accounting program focuses on fraud prevention and detection, equipping students with the knowledge needed to pursue the Certified Fraud Examiner credential and investigate financial crimes such as embezzlement and securities fraud.

The CPA Track is a five-year program that provides the additional credit hours required to sit for the CPA Exam and prepares graduates for careers in auditing, tax preparation, and consulting.

Whether you choose Accounting, Forensic Accounting or the CPA Track, certification and licensure will enhance your employment qualifications and expand your career opportunities.

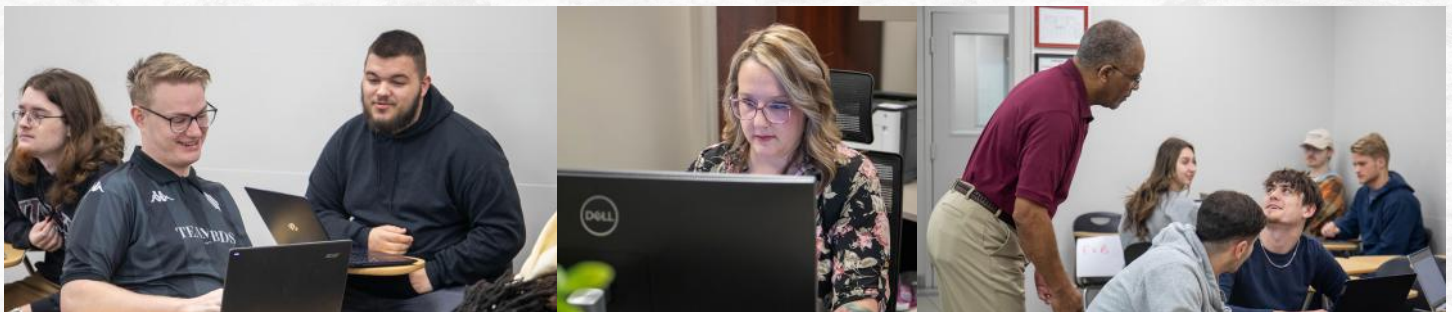

Students in UNOH's Network Security program are taught the latest strategies and technologies used in the IT industry, with hands-on training that can be applied in the workplace immediately. Coursework focuses on real-world security challenges, threat detection, and risk prevention across modern networks. Graduates leave the program prepared to serve as a company's first line of defense against threats to critical systems and private information. Students also gain experience working with industry-standard tools and systems used by cybersecurity professionals every day. The program helps students build the technical and problem-solving skills needed for a rapidly growing industry.

THE DIGITAL MULTIMEDIA DESIGN PROGRAM IS IDEAL FOR CREATIVE STUDENTS WHO ARE INTERESTED IN MEDIA, ENTERTAINMENT, AND TECHNOLOGY. Students learn how to use their creativity to design corporate logos and brand identities, build websites, and create print advertisements, television commercials, short films, and other engaging digital content.

Coursework is hands-on and project-driven, allowing students to integrate design, video, animation, and web technologies using industry-standard tools and software. Students work with professional HD video cameras, lighting equipment, sound recording booths, and the Adobe Creative Suite, along with web and 3D design tools. FEDERAL DIRECT PARENT PLUS LOAN

TESTING is used to evaluate students' readiness in English and math through placement tests. Students who score below 70% are required to enroll in EN070 Basic English and/or MH065 Review Math to strengthen foundational skills before progressing to college-level coursework. All students will receive communication regarding placement testing prior to the start of classes.

Students who have previously taken the ACT or SAT may use those scores in place of placement testing. A score of 18 or higher on the ACT English or math sections, or a score of 450 or higher on the SAT writing or math sections, exempts students from placement testing in those areas.

THE STUDENT SUCCESS CENTER at the University of Northwestern Ohio was developed to support every student through a comprehensive educational support program. The Student Success Center helps students succeed in three key ways:

FIND A TUTOR

Tutoring is available for students in math, reading, writing, English, and study skills at no charge.

STUDY SKILLS

The Student Success Center can help students with time management, organizational skills, and test anxiety.

STUDENTS WITH ACCOMMODATIONS

Students who have accommodations, Individualized Education Plans (IEP), 504 plans, or may need special assistance with their academic program should meet with a staff member in the Student Success Center to discuss all of their academic options.

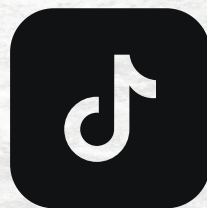
