Through tailored coaching, intensive training, and dynamic networking, these companies become investment-ready and equipped to scale both business and impact. Participants receive technical assistance and a catalytic grant of up to \$10,000 to implement transformation projects. The hybrid delivery which combines in-person bootcamps, online modules, and field support ensures sustainable growth and deepens their capacity to deliver safe water solutions across Uganda.

The company is now taking full responsibility for running and operating water systems themselves, drawing on long engineering experience to ensure sustainability and reliable service delivery. Their transformation project focuses on shifting towards service-based revenue models and data-driven maintenance scheduling.

Impact: Over 5,000 people with reliable access to clean water

Investment ask: Water Giants Africa Ltd is currently raising \$150,000 for CAPEX and growth in loans and grants.

Sunda develops locally engineered smart prepaid metering systems that enable transparent, pay-per-use water access at public taps and handpumps. With over 50,000 users already, Sunda's patented meter-valve technology and real-time dashboard ensure accountability for vendors and utilities. Their transformation project refines commercial models for private water vendors using public taps.

Impact: 50,000+ users benefitting from automated billing and reduced non-revenue water losses.

Investment ask: Sunda Technologies Uganda Ltd is raising \$230,000 for working capital and CAPEX in loans and grants.

WaterKit is a Ugandan fintech enterprise transforming community water management through its WaterKitPay platform. The digital wallet enables rural Water User Committees to save, request maintenance, and access small repair loans. Building on its 600+ existing community clients, the company is piloting direct onboarding models and expansion into credit for solar water pumps and filtration systems. Its transformation project focuses on defining a scalable, profitable model for rural water service delivery and improved financial data tracking.

Impact: 2,500+ households and institutions with sustained water access, stronger O&M performance across 500+ rural sites.

Investment ask: WaterKit is currently raising \$150,000 for nationwide expansion.

Cama Women Plumbers Network Ltd is a pioneering women-led plumbing enterprise providing water-saving installation and maintenance services for households and institutions. To date, the company has served more than 150 clients, and is now professionalising its internal systems, digitalising CRM and rolling out a targeted institutional marketing campaign as its transformation project.

Impact: 150+ clients engaged; scores of women trained and placed into formal plumbing roles; measurable improvements in water efficiency across homes and schools.

Health Shore Ltd delivers solar-powered water purification systems to rural schools, combining off-grid solar energy with reverse-osmosis and UV treatment. The company is already profitable, and its transformation project expands outreach to new schools and communities while introducing digital monitoring and service-fee systems.

Impact: Over 5,000 students now have daily access to safe drinking water; CO₂ emissions reduced by an estimated 1,250 tons annually through use of solar-powered purification instead of boiling of water

Investment ask: Health Shore Ltd is raising \$150,000 for CAPEX and market expansion in debt and grants.

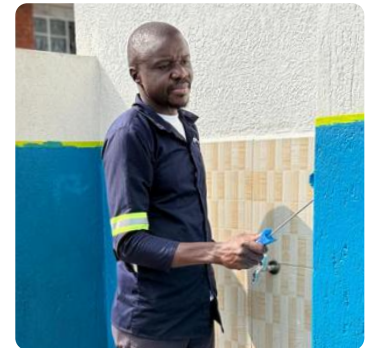
TUSAFISHE



Tusafishe designs, sells, and installs community-scale water purification systems for schools, refugee settlements, and rural communities. Over the last seven years, Henry and his team have installed over 200 systems, demonstrating strong field traction. Their transformation project is centered on launching a subscription-based digital billing model to improve sustainability and customer retention.

Impact: 569,000+ people with access to safe water and significant carbon emissions reductions

Investment ask: Tusafishe is currently raising \$100,000 in loans for additional systems.

Sandi AI is an AI-driven platform that links co-operatives and community groups with financing for water infrastructure projects. The enterprise is fast-growing and profitable, leveraging its chatbot to simplify access to loans and equipment for underserved rural water markets.

Impact: 8,000 people served; partnerships with 28 financial institutions unlocking new funding pathways for water and irrigation systems.

Investment ask: Sandi AI is currently raising \$250,000.

Keza Water provides an eco-friendly alternative to bottled water via a network of refill stations and dispensers with advanced filtration technology. The business is reducing plastic-waste and offering affordable purified water across urban and peri-urban Uganda. Their transformation project pilots new B2B acquisition channels and digital payments to scale.

Impact: Thousands of customers currently served; measurable reductions in plastic-bottle usage and associated environmental footprint.

Investment ask: Keza Water is currently raising \$150,000 in debt for working capital.

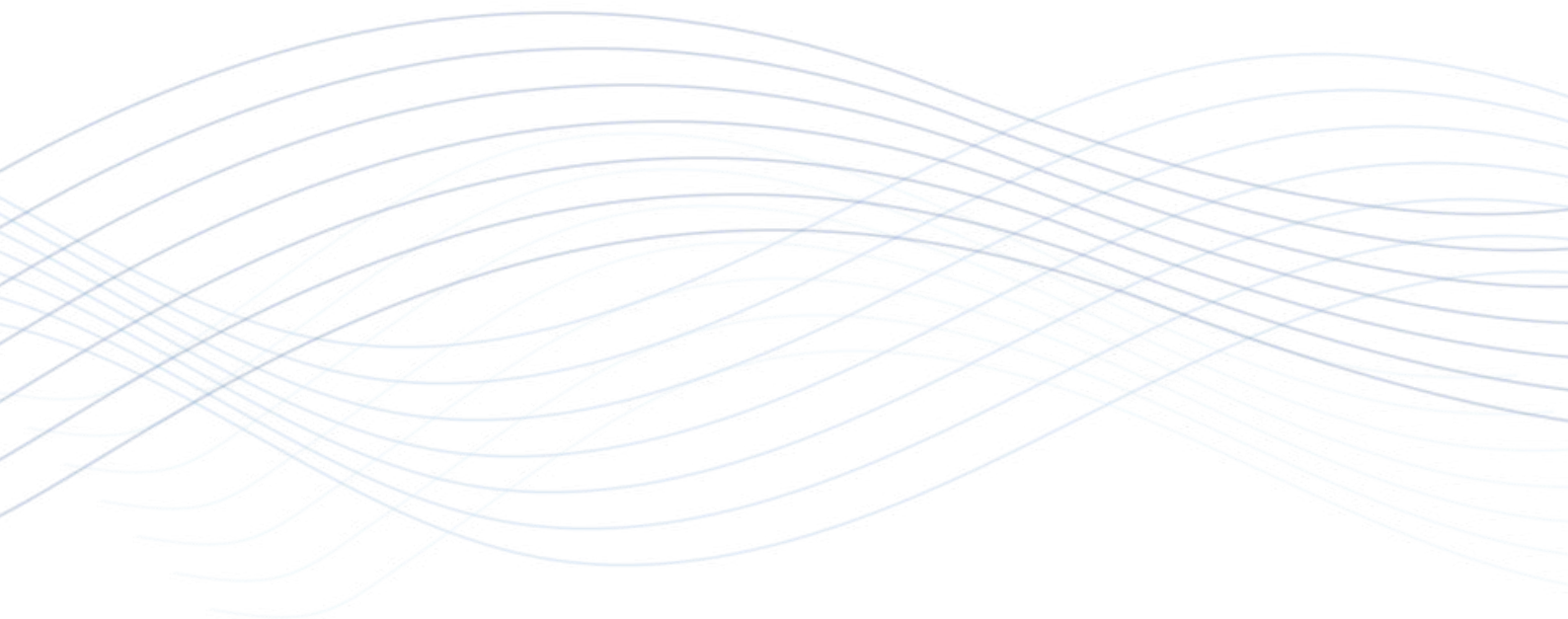
