Resident (R)/ Non-Resident (NR) [Rates]

A resident of Southern Pines is a person, whose permanent, primary home is in the town limits of Southern Pines or who owns property within the town limits of Southern Pines on which the person pays property taxes. Valid documentation verifying personal identity and either a current in-town home address, or payment of property tax to the Town of Southern Pines is required to receive resident rates*.

*Non-Resident Discount Memberships Available

The purchase of a non-resident membership allows all immediate family members residing in your home to pay resident rates for Recreation programs and activities. The non-resident membership is \$60 per year, good for one year from date of purchase. The membership does not apply to rentals and is not refundable.




Natural Disc Golf Course at Reservoir Park | FREE


