VISION

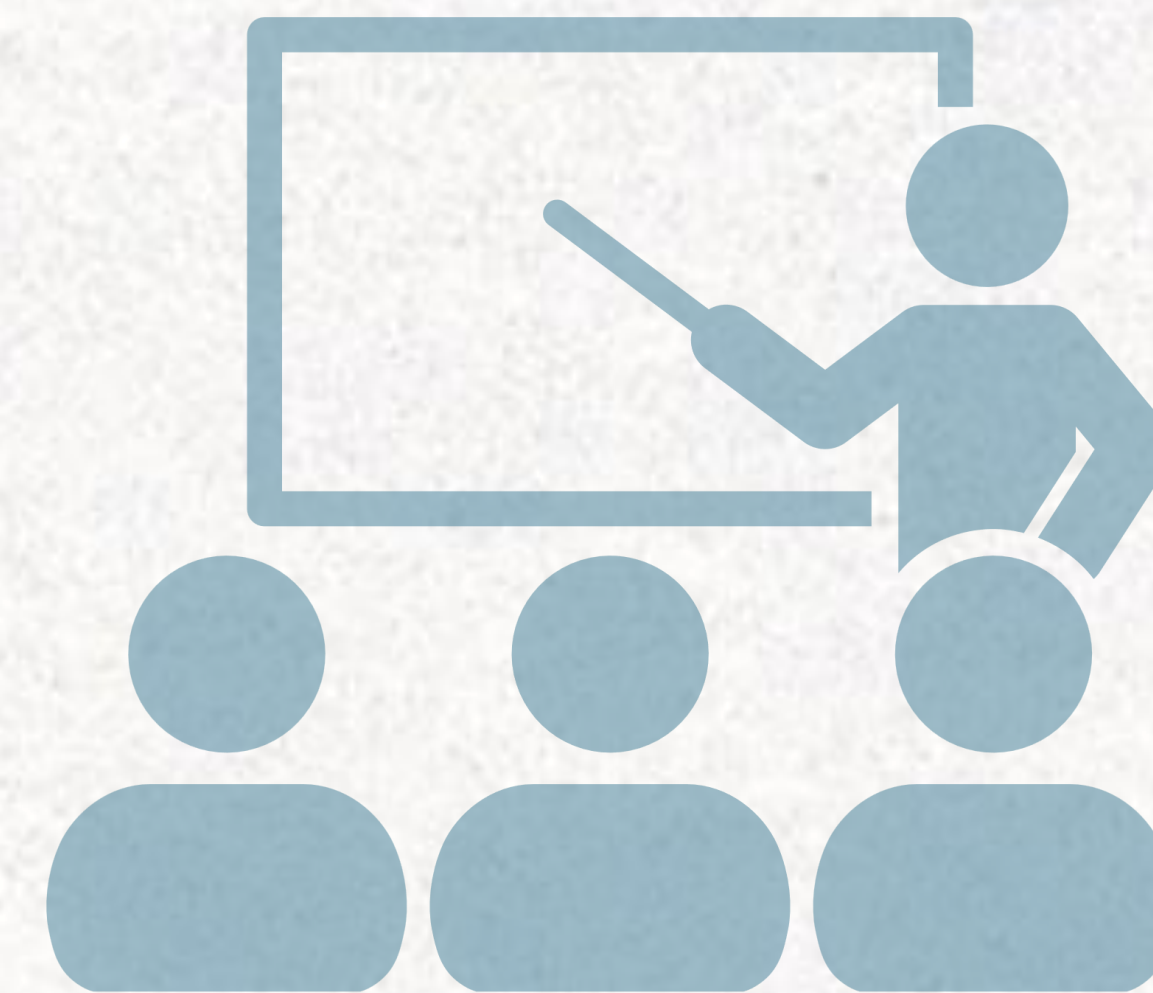

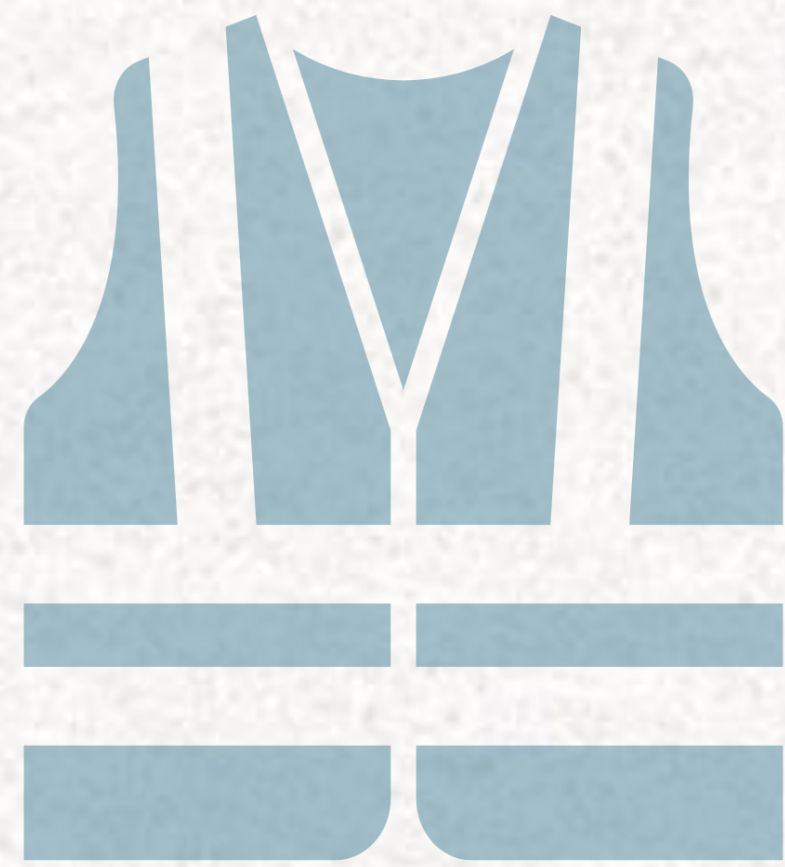

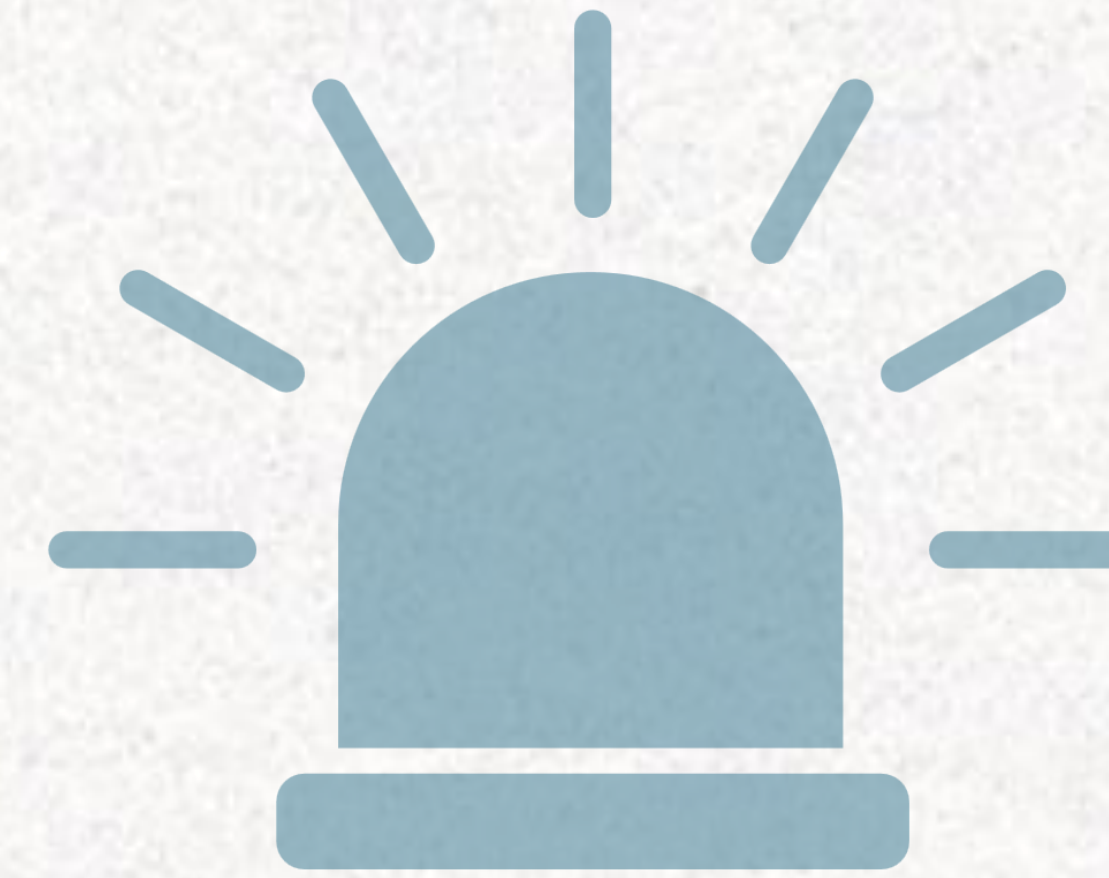
