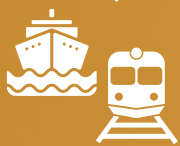

Travel south aboard the sleeper train to Aswan, enjoying a relaxing and sustainable journey through the Egyptian countryside with dinner and breakfast served onboard in your private cabin. Upon arrival in Aswan, enjoy a unique overnight stay in a traditional Nubian Village before embarking on your elegant Dahabiya sailing boat. Cruise peacefully north towards Luxor, visiting Philae Temple, Kom Ombo Temple, and Esna while admiring the beautiful Nile scenery and authentic riverside life.

In Luxor, witness the spectacular Total Solar Eclipse on 2 August 2027, an unforgettable moment set against the timeless landscapes of ancient Egypt.

Discover the wonders of Karnak Temple, Luxor Temple, and the legendary West Bank, including the Valley of the Kings and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut.

Return to Cairo by sleeper train before your final transfer to the airport, concluding a journey filled with ancient history, Nile sailing, Nubian culture, and the rare beauty of the Total Solar Eclipse.

Your Itinerary

July 27: Arrival in Cairo

Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, you will be met and assisted before being transferred to your hotel for check-in and a comfortable overnight stay, preparing for the adventure ahead.

July 28: Pyramids & Grand Egypt Museum

Today, after breakfast, you will begin your adventure with a visit to the **Grand Egyptian Museum** — a landmark project that took Egypt over ten years to complete.

It houses the largest collection of Pharaonic treasures in the world, including the magnificent artefacts of Tutankhamun. Later, you will head to the Giza Plateau to enjoy lunch with spectacular views of the iconic Pyramids.

Afterwards, explore the Pyramids and admire the enigmatic Sphinx before transferring to the railway station for the overnight sleeper train to Aswan.

July 29: Arrive in Aswan & City Tour

Upon arrival in Aswan, begin exploring the city's highlights, including Philae Temple, the High Dam, and the Unfinished Obelisk. In the afternoon, enjoy a relaxing felucca sailing experience on the Nile before you check into your Nubian hotel for dinner and an overnight at teh Nubian Village **Meals: B-D**



July 30: Optional Abu Simbel & Nile Sailing

Enjoy an optional early morning excursion to Abu Simbel before boarding your boat and continuing your journey along the Nile. Savour lunch while sailing past the lush green landscapes lining both banks of the river, observing local farmers and children enjoying the refreshing waters of the Nile. Relax onboard and unwind in the jacuzzi on the sundeck.

Later, visit the remarkable Kom Ombo Temple, uniquely located on the riverbank and dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile god, and Horus, the falcon god. Continue sailing towards Edfu for your overnight stay.

July 31: Esna – Luxor

Visit the remarkably well-preserved Temple of Edfu, dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed god of protection and kingship in ancient Egyptian mythology. After exploring this magnificent riverside temple, continue sailing south through the Esna Lock and along the timeless waters of the Nile towards Luxor..

Arrive in Luxor and spend your first memorable night in the heart of ancient Thebes. As the sun sets over the Nile, enjoy the peaceful atmosphere of this historic city, where ancient temples and timeless landscapes create an unforgettable setting.

August 1 – Luxor Sightseeing

Start your day early with a visit to Luxor's legendary West Bank before the heat of the day sets in. Explore the fascinating Valley of the Kings, the magnificent Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, and the impressive Colossi of Memnon. Return to the cruise for lunch and time to relax onboard. In the evening, experience the magical atmosphere of Luxor Temple beautifully illuminated under the night sky.

In the afternoon, transfer to Luxor Railway Station to board the sleeper train to Cairo. Relax and enjoy the unique experience of rail travel through Egypt while dinner and breakfast are served onboard the train.

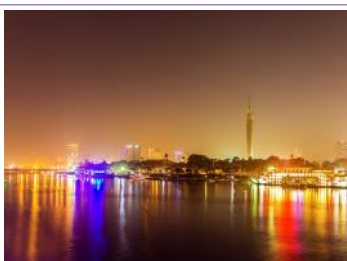
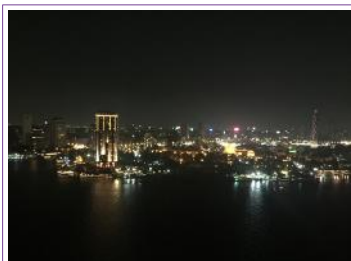
August 3 – Cairo & Farewell Dinner

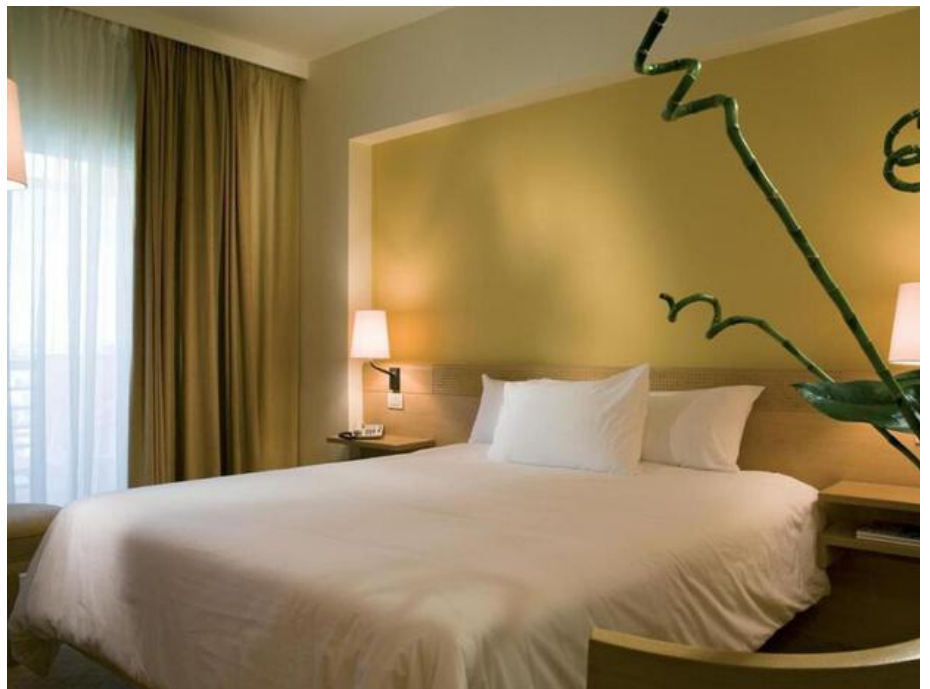

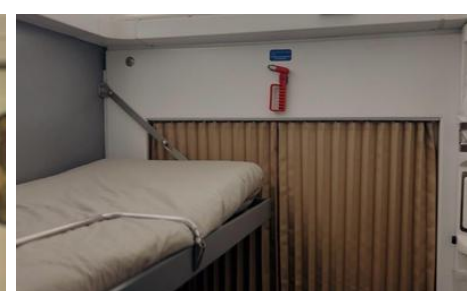

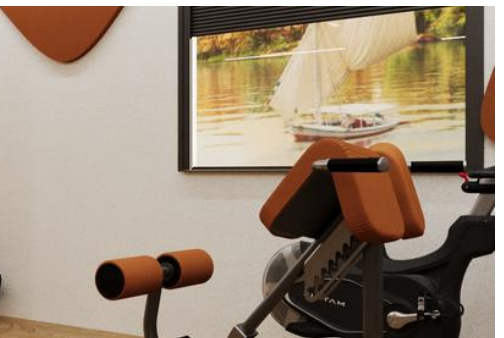

Terms & Conditions: 2027 Egypt Solar Eclipse Expeditions

1. Booking & Reservations

- To secure a reservation for any of our 2027 Total Solar Eclipse itineraries, the initial deposit must be paid at the time of booking.
- Due to the immense global demand for the August 2027 eclipse, our premium allotments in Cairo and cabins on the Nile are blocked years in advance. Your reservation is only guaranteed once your first payment has been successfully processed and a formal booking confirmation is issued by Middle East Travel Alliance.

2. Payment Schedule

To make securing your spot more manageable, payments are split into three installments:

- **First Payment (Deposit):** 30% of the total package price is due immediately upon confirmation to secure your booking.
- **Second Payment:** 30% of the total package price must be paid in full no later than February 5, 2027.
- **Final Payment:** The remaining 40% balance must be paid in full no later than March 5, 2027.
- **Payment Method:** Payments can be made either by bank transfer or via a secure payment link.
- **Failure to meet any of the payment deadlines may result in the automatic cancellation of your booking and the forfeiture of all previous payments.**

3. Cancellation & Refund Policy

Because an eclipse of this magnitude is a rare, high-demand global event, our local suppliers, hotels, and cruise operators require strict, non-refundable financial commitments from us at each stage of the planning process. Standard travel cancellation policies do not apply. By booking, you agree to the following event-specific terms:

- All payments are strictly non-refundable once they are made.
- Once the 30% confirmation deposit is paid, it is non-refundable.
- Once the second 30% payment is made (on or before February 5, 2027), the total 60% paid is non-refundable.
- Once the final 40% payment is made (on or before March 5, 2027), the full 100% of the package price is non-refundable.
- All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing.

4. Eclipse Viewing & Weather Conditions

- **Standard Viewing:** All packages include eclipse viewing from the Sun Deck of your designated Nile cruise vessel.
- **Eclipse Viewing Festival Upgrade:** Guests wishing to secure an unobstructed view may opt into our exclusive Eclipse Viewing Festival for an additional \$300 USD per person. This takes place on an open-air private farm outside Luxor and includes round-trip transfers from/to your Nile Cruise, a barbeque lunch buffet, an open hydration bar, comfortable seating, and safe-viewing guidance.
- **Expert Guidance:** An expert onboard astronomer will sail with our groups, providing lectures throughout the cruise to prepare guests and offering on-site guidance during the Eclipse Viewing Festival.
- **Weather Disclaimer:** While August in Egypt historically provides pristine, cloudless skies, Middle East Travel Alliance cannot control the weather. No refunds will be provided in the event of poor weather, cloud cover, or any natural phenomena that obstruct the viewing of the eclipse.

Terms & Conditions

5. Passports, Visas, and Entry Requirements

- All guests are solely responsible for ensuring they have valid travel documents. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months beyond the date of entry into Egypt.
- It is the guest's responsibility to obtain any required tourist visas prior to arrival or upon arrival, depending on their nationality.
- Middle East Travel Alliance is not liable for any delays, missed flights, or cancelled tours resulting from a guest's failure to obtain proper travel documentation, and no refunds will be issued in such cases.

6. Health, Medical & Mobility Requirements

- Guests must ensure they are medically and physically fit for travel. Nile cruises, traditional Dahabiyas, and temple excursions often involve climbing stairs, walking on uneven surfaces, and navigating gangways. The Eclipse Viewing Festival takes place on a natural farm setting.
- If any guest has specific medical conditions, mobility issues, or dietary requirements, they must notify Middle East Travel Alliance in writing at the time of booking. We reserve the right to decline any booking if we feel the individual cannot safely participate in the itinerary.

7. Force Majeure (Acts of God)

- Middle East Travel Alliance shall not be liable for any failure or delay in performing our obligations where such failure or delay results from any cause that is beyond our reasonable control. Such causes include, but are not limited to: Acts of God, pandemics, epidemics, war, threat of war, civil commotion, riots, strikes, government restrictions or travel bans, terrorist activity, or natural disasters.
- In the event of a Force Majeure, Middle East Travel Alliance reserves the right to alter, postpone, or cancel the expedition without liability for refunds.

8. Limitation of Liability

- Middle East Travel Alliance acts solely as the tour operator and makes arrangements with third-party suppliers (e.g., hotels, cruise vessels, transportation companies) to provide the services outlined in your package.
- We shall not be held liable for any personal injury, property damage, loss, delay, or irregularity that may be caused by the negligence, wrongful acts, or omissions of these third-party suppliers.
