DEWI SARASWATI

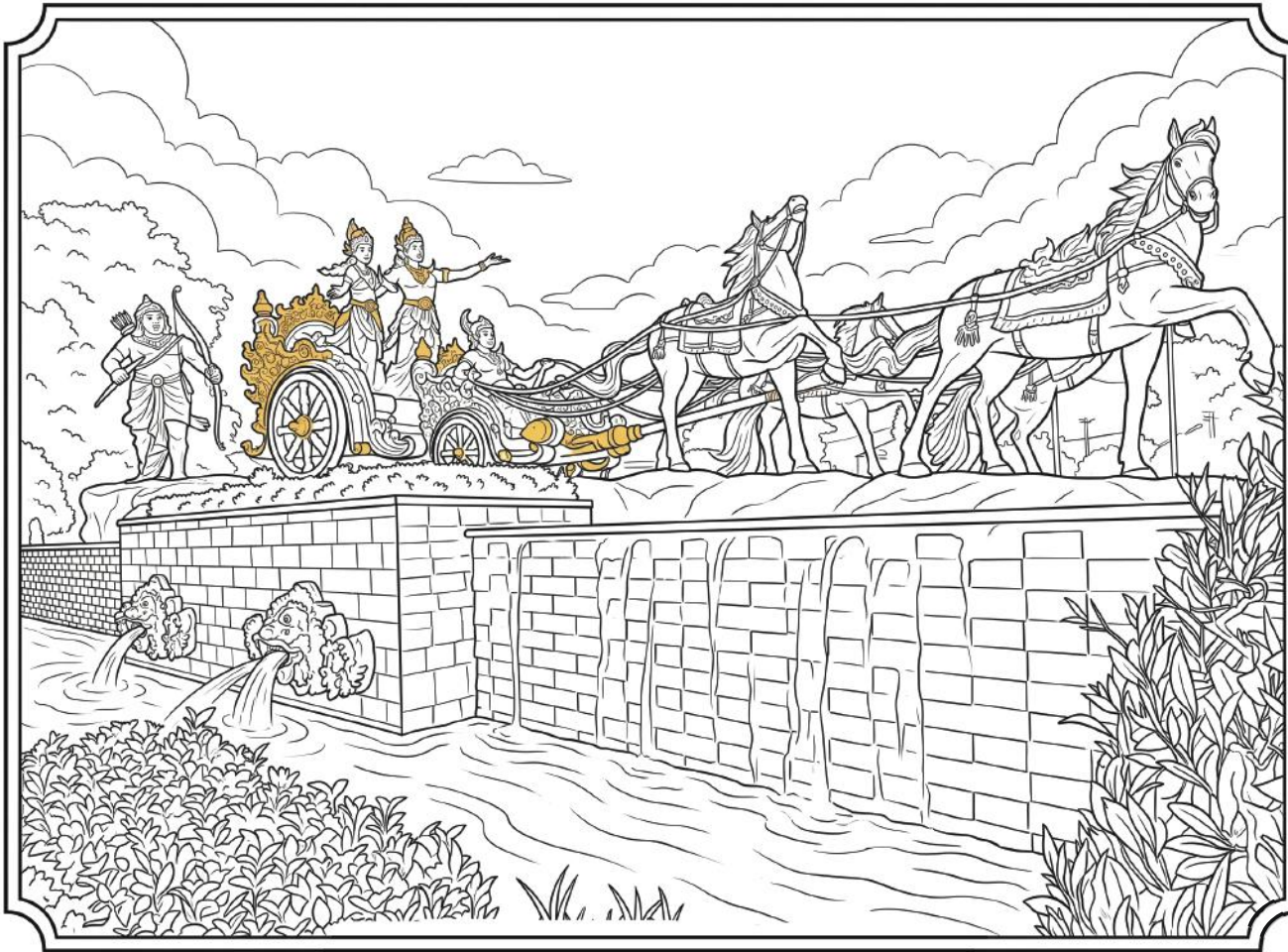
