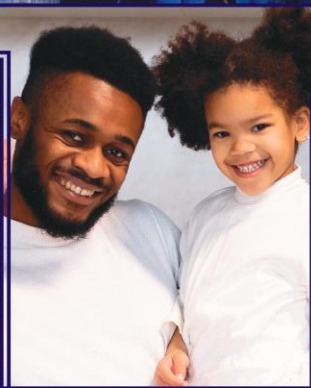

When our volunteers felt safe enough, they returned to serve with us to meet the needs of our neighbors. These dedicated individuals ensured the increased demand for programs and services was met. **TOGETHER they provided 24,678 hours of volunteer time.**

## Investing to Meet the Needs of our Community

Frisco Family Services has seen great success since its beginning in 1994. However, our Frisco and Frisco ISD community has changed dramatically in the past 27 years.

Having long operated at maximum capacity at our 3rd Street location, and the Resale Store and Market at another location, we dreamed of (and planned for) **expanding space for programs and services, and creating a single location.**

In December 2020, thanks to foresight and contributions to our capital campaign, we opened the doors to a 19,000 sq. ft. facility. For the first time in our history, we're able to house the Agency, the Market, and our UPSCALE Frisco Resale store on one campus to make accessing services easier.

**The new Client Services Building provides space for program expansion, vocational training, on-site counseling and offers a better, and more streamlined client experience with greater privacy.**

This increased capacity with greater efficiency helps ensure that Frisco Family Services is able to keep up with the growing and diverse needs of the city as it continues to grow.

## Who We Serve

### Community is Everything!

**Together is Better** is something we experience firsthand at Frisco Family Services and we're proud of our 27-year record of providing emergency assistance to our neighbors facing hunger, homelessness, and other urgent needs.

Many are surprised to learn that there is need here in Frisco. However, life-altering events such as a job loss, a medical diagnosis, or a divorce can (*and do*) happen to any one of us as evidenced by a recent report released by Children's Health<sup>1</sup>.

- Based on family income, Frisco ISD is home to 8,500 students that qualify for free- or reduced-price meals.<sup>2</sup>
- During 2019, 17,875 (or 7%) school-age children across Collin County lived in a household earning less than the federal poverty level of \$26,500 annually for a family of four (or \$2,208 per month).
- During 2020, 1,071 children lacked a fixed regular or permanent nighttime residence due to a recent economic hardship.

Together, we can ensure our neighbors regain self-sufficiency when a crisis strikes.

## During a Crisis, a Hand Up, Not a Hand Out

### Meet Catherine, a Proud Grandmother of Three



Catherine is a proud grandmother of three. Two are currently attending college, and the third is completing her senior year of high school. She has had legal custody since they were very young. "I simply could not permit them to remain in foster care," says Catherine.

She admits that there were tough times and further emphasizes that unexpected changes in circumstances also required her to make hard choices.

For example, deferring her own clothing, medical and mental health needs in order to put food on the table; or, after being displaced by Hurricane Katrina, living with various friends and relatives until she could secure permanent housing. Moreover, simply asking for help was the hardest she says. "It just wasn't something I was comfortable with."

**She also adds that during these times, Frisco Family Services had been a great help** – "particularly with my utilities, and for sure getting the children prepared for school in the fall as well as gifts during the seasonal holidays."

She also shared that she has been humbled by our attention to detail. For example, while shopping for much-needed groceries at the Frisco Family Services Market, she not only found a birthday cake, but candles and gift bag as well for her granddaughter's upcoming birthday. Otherwise, it would have been another hard choice to do without it.

She said that those small details had a huge impact for her family as one of the grandchildren had been recently diagnosed with a brain tumor. "It provided a bright spot during a dark, turbulent time." She has found Frisco Family Services' approach to a crisis, "one of sincere caring".

"I never felt belittled. Amid a crisis they take your hand and guide you through it to get you back up on your feet."

# Preventing Hunger in Our Community

## Frisco Family Services Market

Clients shop in a grocery store-like setting for the food they know their families will eat, enabling them to avoid hunger while using their limited financial resources for other essential needs.

**In addition to nutritious food choices – including meat, dairy, and fresh produce, hygiene and household products are also available.**

Thanks to the Leadership Frisco Class XXI project we developed an expanded produce section for greater client access to a variety of fresh fruits and vegetables.

## Market Express – *new this year!*

Market Express is an online shopping alternative for those who are ill, do not feel comfortable with in-person shopping, or have limited availability due to their work schedule.

Similar to retail curbside pickup, clients access an online shopping list, make their selections, and schedule a pickup time.

The service is convenient as well as confidential.

## Mobile Market

For our seniors and other individuals who are unable to drive, are without transportation, or suffering from an illness, the Mobile Market provides home delivery.

It is just another way we work to ensure our homebound clients have access to the same nutritious food that is available at our Market location.

## Summer Lunch Program

The FFS Summer Lunch Program provides lunch daily and weekend meals throughout the summer to local children typically eligible for free and reduced lunch during the school year.

This year we distributed nutritious produce boxes each week on *Fresh Fridays*.

Children also enjoy participating in recreational activities, social time and meeting new friends.

## Thanksgiving Meal Program

The FFS Thanksgiving Meal Program provides individuals and families with a turkey and everything needed to prepare breakfast and a traditional Thanksgiving meal in the comfort of their own home.

A game or movie is also included to encourage quality family time together.

# Steps to Self-Sufficiency

## Emergency Financial Assistance

We help families stay in their homes, keep utilities connected, purchase prescription medication, and assist with other critical needs. Payments are made to utility providers, landlords and other entities on behalf of the clients. To apply for emergency financial assistance, a prospective client must live within the city of Frisco or within Frisco ISD.

## CHAMPS: Challenging Adult Minds for Personal Success

CHAMPS workshops are facilitated by local businesses and professional volunteers in the community who provide each client with tools, training, skills and support necessary to achieve or maintain self-sufficiency and success.

## ISSP: Intensive Self-Sufficiency Program

This program provides critical support to clients who have limited education and employment experience. Through one-on-one intensive case management, an individualized plan of action is developed that allows the client to remove barriers and obtain their financial independence once again.

## Seasonal Programs

Throughout the year, Frisco Family Services' seasonal programs provide support and a sense of normalcy to individuals and families. Seasonal programs are made possible through generous financial contributions, in-kind donations, and invaluable volunteers who want to make a difference in our community.

### Back2School Fun Fair

Eligible Frisco and Frisco ISD students, grades K-12, receive a new backpack filled with grade-appropriate school supplies, new clothing and shoes, hygiene items, haircuts, vision screenings, glasses, and more to ensure they are ready for a new school year.

Parents and caregivers are provided helpful community resources.



### Holiday Store Program

To help ensure individuals and families have a joyous holiday season during a time of crisis, generous donors provide toys, bicycles, shoes, gift cards, new clothes, and household items for eligible clients to select at our “no-cost” holiday store.



### Silver Bells Holiday Social & Celebration

With your help, the Frisco Family Services' Silver Bells Holiday Social & Celebration spreads joy to our senior clients who join together to socialize and enjoy fun games, food, and holiday gifts!

**Seventeen years later, Mary Beth is still serving every week in the Frisco Family Services Market.**

During the pandemic, like many FFS volunteers, Mary Beth temporarily suspended volunteering. However, as soon as it was safe again and clients were returning to shop at the Market, she not only returned to her regular shift but also took on an additional weekly shift to help ensure that those needing help would continue having access to food for their families.

## Meet John, a Single Father of Four

John, a father of four, worked several years establishing an office and successfully selling products for a supplemental insurance firm.

Then, in 2020 without the ability to conduct in person meetings, he saw his new sales decline by 60% and existing clients gone when businesses closed. As sales declined across the corporation, more changes were made and John, paid on commission, was not earning enough to meet his family's basic needs.

In addition to this financial crisis, John's wife left the family and his mother passed away leaving John to hold his family together.

"I was struggling to have food in the fridge for the kids," said John when his pastor referred him to Frisco Family Services.

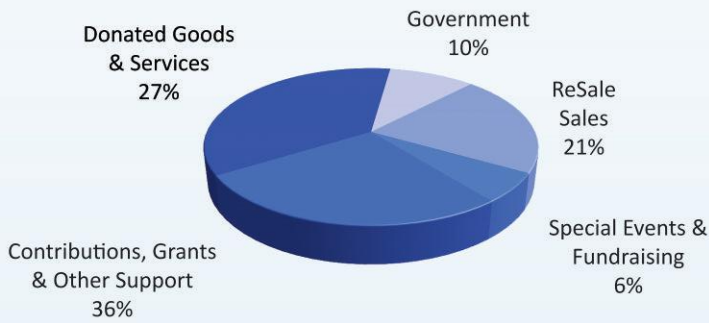

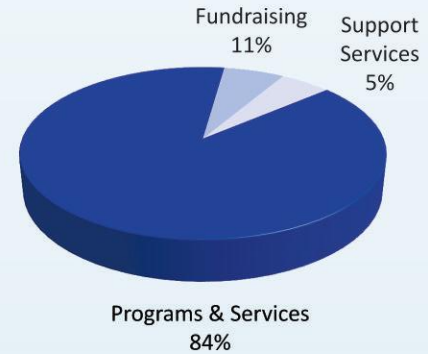
