



# History of the NIAA



The Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association (NIAA) is a private, 501c3 organization of secondary schools in Nevada. In essence, the NIAA is the non-profit governing body of high school athletics in the Silver State as recognized by the Nevada state legislature. It is important to note, however, that the NIAA does not receive direct state funding. The NIAA's revenue streams are corporate partnerships, event ticket sales and member school's dues.

The original (NIAA) Nevada Interscholastic League was formed in 1922. It became affiliated with the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) in 1939. School administrators established the League in order to develop and enforce high school athletic welfare and safety standards, eligibility and amateurism policies, and ethical conduct and behavior policies that would complement the academic work of students. The NIAA ensures that Nevada's student-athletes engage in pure competition under uniform regulations.

The NIL became the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association in 1967. The first full-time salaried Executive Director was hired in 1974 and an office was established in Carson City. The NIAA office moved to Reno in 1997, and it has occupied four locations. The NIAA office moved to its current location in Sparks in 2018. Bert Cooper (July 1974 – June 1989), Dr. Jerry Hughes (July 1989 – December 2006), Eddie Bonine (January 2007 – February 2015), Bart Thompson (July 2015 – 2020) and Donnie Nelson (2020 – current) are the five individuals to have served as full-time Executive Directors of the NIAA.

As of August 2022, the NIAA had 123 member schools (including independents) divided into five classifications. The NIAA is responsible for sponsoring, directing and developing athletics and activities in Nevada's high schools. In addition, the NIAA oversees the Nevada Association of Student Councils (NASC). The NIAA office is responsible for sanctioning activities, conducting post-season tournaments, regulating officials, certifying coaches, and providing a host of services to its member schools surrounding health and welfare standards. The Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association is incorporated in compliance with NRS 81.170-81.280 and was recognized in 1974 under the provisions of NRS 386.420-.470. The NIAA's Handbook (rules and

regulations) was assumed in chapter 386 of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) in 2004 after having previously been developed in Regulation 2080.

The NIAA also provides the following services to its member schools in addition to the 168 league/region tournaments and 86 state championship tournaments it conducts:

- \* Awards, in each NIAA-sanctioned sporting event, an academic team champion and honors individuals on the all-State (4.0 gpa) academic team;
- \* Hosts a Hall of Fame banquet and induction ceremony, which honors outstanding athletes, coaches, officials, administrators and contributors who have had a significant and positive impact on Nevada's youth;
- \* Hosts an end-of-the-year awards banquet honoring the top 10 student-athletes in both northern and southern Nevada;
- \* Certifies coaches (Nevada Coaching Education Program) and contest officials;
- \* Promotes cooperative spirit among member schools through its special Citizenship Through Sports program;
- \* Publishes NIAA informational materials (Reference Manual - School Directory Handbook (NIAA Regs), Year In Review, Record Book, etc.) for all member schools, sponsors, the media and the public;
- \* Oversees a Sports Medicine Advisory Committee;
- \* Endorses the Drug, Alcohol and Tobacco policy;
- \* Works to prevent the exploitation of student-athletes by special interest groups.

## PURPOSE AND INTENT

"In recognition of the many educational values to be derived from participation in all forms of interscholastic activities, and in recognition of the need for guidance and direction in the conduct of these activities, it shall be the purpose of this Association to promote, coordinate and regulate league, region and statewide activities to the end

that they shall be part of and contribute to the total educational program of the students in the secondary schools of the State of Nevada.”

## ORGANIZATION

### Legislative Commission

The policy-making authority of the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association is vested in the Legislative Commission. The Commission consists of the superintendents of each of the 17 county school districts of Nevada (with the exception that Esmeralda County does not have a high school).

### Board of Control

The governing body of the NIAA is a Board of Control. This Board of Control has 12 voting representatives from the four administrative regions. The NIAA will provide for the election of members of the Board from throughout the State of Nevada. The state must be divided into regions based upon pupil population. Each representative must

be elected by the county boards of school trustees from within the region they represent.

The Class 1A, 2A, 3A & 4A/5A South, 5A North and three student representatives all serve as non-voting liaisons to the Board of Control. Other liaisons to the Board include a representative from the Superintendents association, the state’s private schools, the state’s charter schools, the Athletic Directors association, and the state officials association. The Board elects a president and vice-president for a term of two years at its winter meeting in odd numbered years. The Board holds regular (quarterly) meetings throughout the year to conduct the affairs of the NIAA. Member schools are notified of these meetings in a timely manner. A provision is made for special meetings to be called as the need arises.

### Member Schools

The member schools are formed into regions and leagues to facilitate scheduling and interscholastic competition.




