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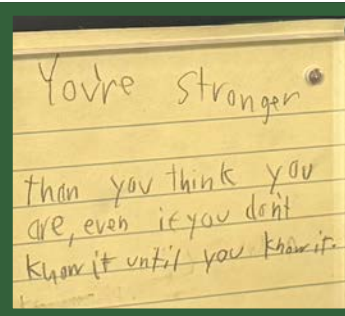

Spreading Sean's Love of Family and Community

Love Like Sean Family Run 5k and Kids Dash

On November 3, 2024 (Kristi and Brian's 23rd wedding anniversary), the Love Like Sean Foundation partnered with St. Isaac Jogues to host the First Annual Love Like Sean Family Run with a 5k and a Kids Dash. Over 400 runners, including St. Isaac Jogues's Pastor, Father Burke Masters, participated in the 5k. We also had over 100 walkers, with plenty of strollers and pets.

The race began and ended at Robbins Park, one of Sean's favorite places in the world and wound through the streets of Hinsdale, including past St. Isaac Jogues and the only home Sean ever lived in. In addition to the runners, walkers and dashers, many family members, friends and community members showed up to enjoy the festivities and refreshments, which included coffee, hot chocolate, donuts, bagels and bananas. Sean Cahill kept everyone's energy up with his witty banter and his masterful DJ'ing, featuring songs off Sean Richards's favorite playlists.

Through Kristi's contacts at Notre Dame, we were able to raffle off a unique Notre Dame Football Experience for the Notre Dame game against Virginia. The experience included a Friday evening reception in the Schivarelli Football Players' Lounge inside Notre Dame Stadium, pre-game sideline passes and 4 tickets to the game. Hundreds of raffle tickets were sold at \$50 each. The winner was Augie Goebel. Augie and Sean were great friends for 10 years and spent Sean's last full week on this earth as tent mates at Camp Tesomas with the Boy Scouts, where Augie accompanied Sean in a boat while Sean completed a 1-mile open water swim 3 days before he was killed. It was a fair pull on the raffle – Kristi had her eyes closed – but maybe Sean helped a bit.

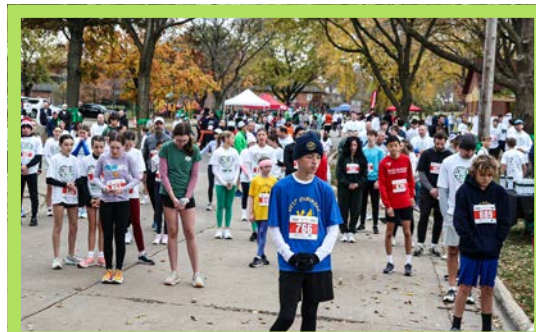
In connection with the race, the DuPage (IL) County Board and its chair, Deborah Conroy, declared November 3, 2024, "Love Like Sean Day" in DuPage County to honor the life and memory of Sean Richards.

In addition to the fellowship and love that was celebrated that day, the event raised almost \$29,000, which was split evenly between the Love Like Sean Foundation and the St. Isaac Jogues outreach mission.

Sean was present with us, but his physical presence was missed by all.

Spreading Sean's Love of Learning, Friendship and Faith

Scholarships provided by the Love Like Sean Foundation

During 2024, the Love Like Sean Foundation, working with the staff of Benet Academy, instituted and awarded the first Love Like Sean Scholarships to members of the Class of 2027 and Class of 2028. The scholarships are for \$5,000 per year (\$20,000 for Class of 2028 recipient; \$15,000 for Class of 2027 recipient).

- Katie Starr (Class of 2027) and Vincenzo Lucafo (Class of 2028) were awarded the Love Like Sean Scholarship at Benet Academy. We are proud to have both Katie and Vince represent the Love Like Sean Foundation and receive the scholarship that bears Sean's name. Sean would have been great friends with both of them.
- We were overwhelmed with both the quality and the quantity (34 members of the Class of 2027 and 45 members of the Class of 2028) of the students who completed applications. Due to the number of truly outstanding candidates in these groups, the committee created a new category (Finalists) for the Scholarship. Each of these students will receive a \$1,000 scholarship per year for four years (three years for Class of 2027 members) while attending Benet Academy. The Finalists for the Class of 2027 are Kasey Glynn, Daniel Phelan and Andrew Zitlow. The Finalists for the Class of 2028 are Lexie Clanin, Nicholas Huie and Noel Klody.
- All Benet students in the applicable classes were eligible for this scholarship through an application process that included an essay from the applicant as well as a recommendation from a non-relative adult. Scholarship recipients were chosen because they were deemed to best exhibit the qualities and traits lived by Sean during his brief, but incredibly impactful, time on earth. Those qualities and traits include a commitment to the Catholic faith, sincere kindness to everyone, a positive influence to all, love, laughter, joy, compassion, empathy, and wonder; just to name a few. Scholarship determinations were made without regard to academic performance, athletic achievement, financial need, race, gender or any other criteria than those listed above.

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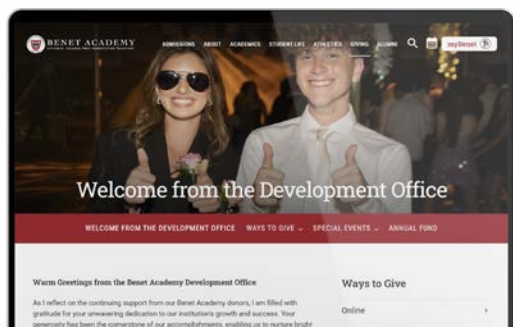
Capital Campaigns

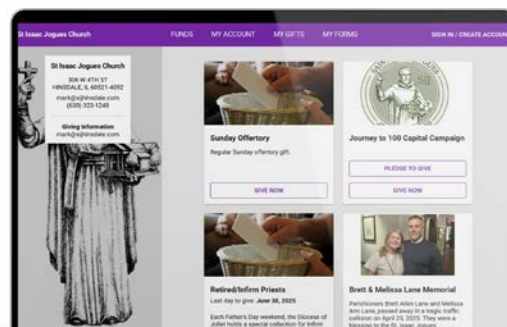

Spreading Sean's Kindness and Love of Stuffed Animals — Beanie Boos

Sean loved stuffed animals and was comforted on a trip to the emergency room when he was 2 with a stuffed animal from Hinsdale Hospital. To provide other children with the same level of comfort and love, the Love Like Sean Foundation partnered in 2024 with Ty Corporation to produce and distribute several thousand Love Like Sean Beanie Babies and Beanie Balls to children at Hinsdale Hospital, Elmhurst Hospital and Comer Hospital at the University of Chicago. We have also provided Love Like Sean Beanie Babies to students at St. Isaac Jogues school, to children at the Migrant Ministry of the Parishes of Oak Park, to families through HCS Family Services and Grace brought a few hundred down to the Arizona/Mexico border to hand out to children of asylum seekers as part of a service trip through Sheil Catholic Center at Northwestern University.



Spreading Sean's Love with Collection Activities, Donations to Charitable Organizations and Acts of Kindness To Those in Need

Migrant Ministries of the Catholic Parishes of Oak Park: \$1000 + Clothing, Toys, Beanie Babies and Books

Migrant Ministry provides assistance to migrants and asylum seekers at the former St. Edmund School (now St. Edmund Center) in Oak Park, Illinois. In February, to commemorate Sean's birthday, the Love Like Sean Foundation organized and executed a clothing and toy drive at St. Isaac Jogues and in the Hinsdale community, in which we collected well over 2000 items for the Migrant Ministry. We filled 5 large vehicles with toys, stuffed animals, coats, blankets, ski pants, underwear, socks and other clothing for the migrants. Sean's friends and other community members helped us organize and prepare the items for delivery. In April, Kristi dropped off another SUV full of additional needed items for the migrants that had been generously delivered to our home. Finally, in August, the Hinsdale Inferno Junior Board collected and donated a truckload of school supplies to the Migrant Ministry in partnership with the Love Like Sean Foundation and in honor of Sean.

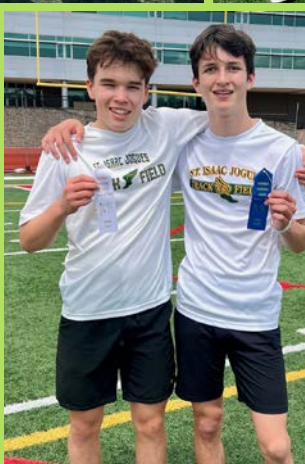
St. Isaac Jogues School has created this award for those students in each of grades K-8. The winners were chosen by their peers and teachers and were determined to be the person in their grade that best.

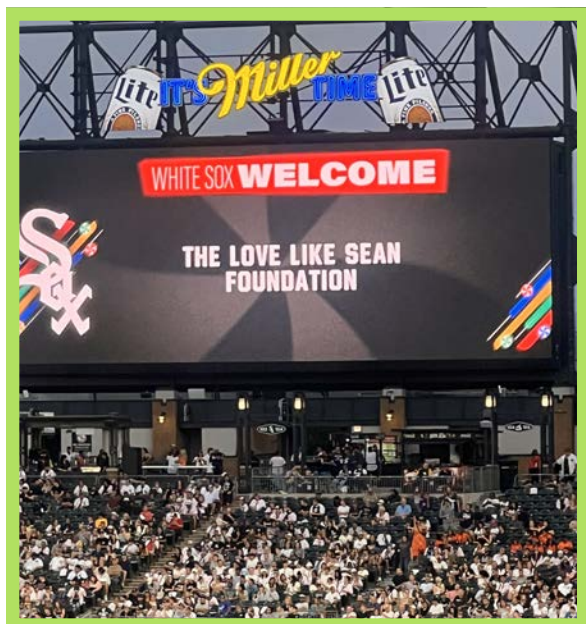

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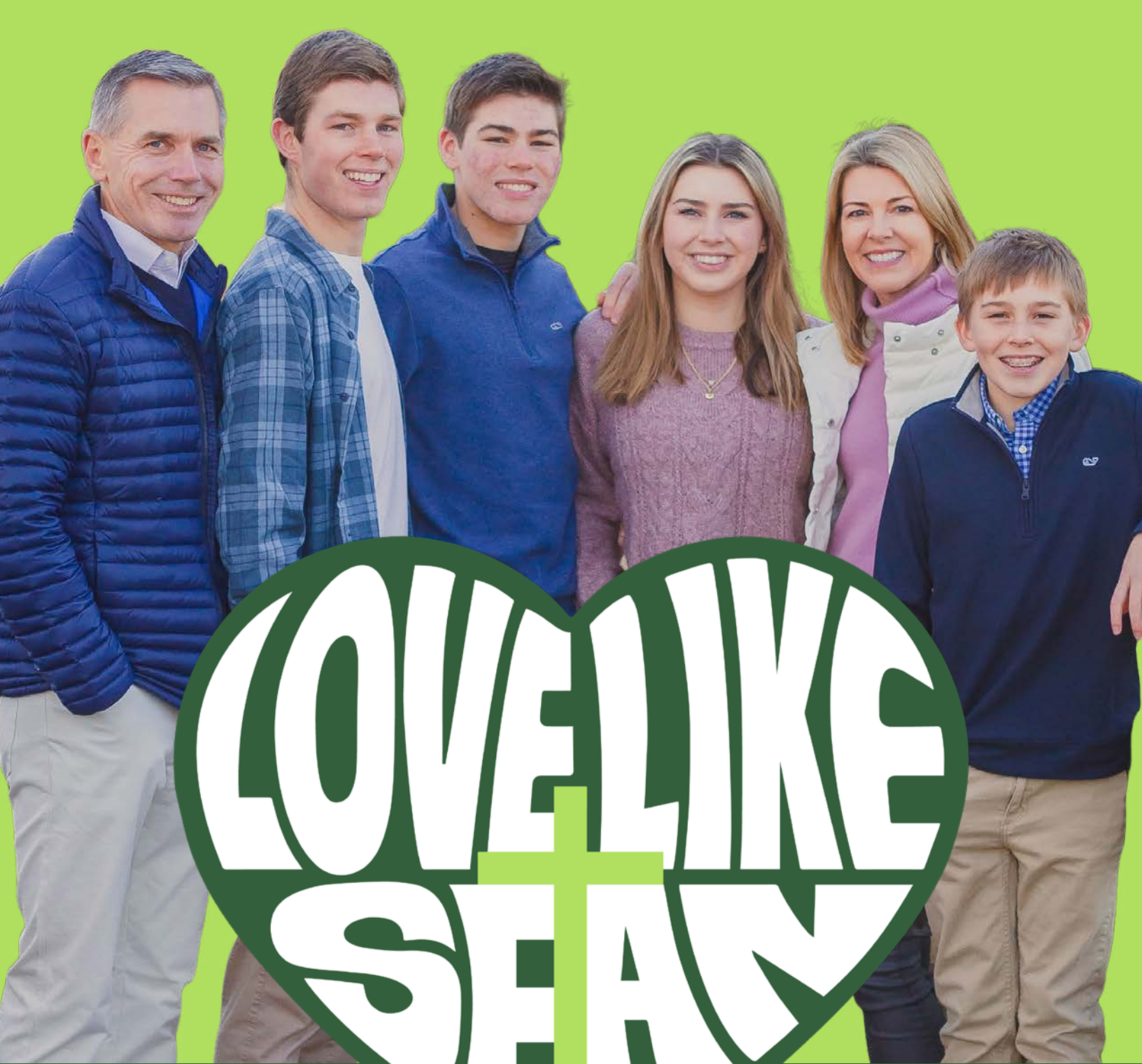
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
