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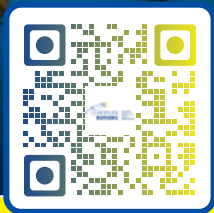

SHOW POLICIES

Child Attendee Policy. All children (anyone under 18) must be accompanied by an adult. Registration for children ages 14 and under is free. However, children ages 14 and under must wear a registration badge, which can be picked up at Attendee Registration. Children ages 15–17 must obtain a paid registration to attend. Student rates are available for qualifying attendees.

Drone Policy. By law, drones must be registered with the FAA, have a trained operator, and remain within the operator’s view while in operation. All drones must be approved by VAI in writing prior to arriving on-site at VERTICON 2026. Operating drones in any exterior areas of or around the Georgia World Congress Center is explicitly prohibited under FAA airspace restrictions.
