## A MESSAGE FROM THE RECTOR

# The gift of an Angelicum education: becoming a light for a universal mission

Dear Friends,

We are grateful for the opportunity to form students for a universal mission, and for the generous support of our friends whose donations make academic studies financially feasible for many. We know that the spirit of gratitude in our hearts prepares us to receive further support and also more students for the wider mission. Our students, coming from every corner of the globe and the various vocations within the life of the Church, demonstrate a common intention to take inspiration from our location. The Angelicum is a place that has developed and thrived over centuries under the shadow of the Papacy, the Holy See, and the Master of the Dominican Order. As we know, Thomas Aquinas wrote the first part of the *Summa Theologiae* in Rome, not far from our university, in the priory of Santa Sabina. Here in Rome we encounter the Saints and the tradition of the Church; we remember all the great missionaries, writers, spiritual figures, and mystics who have lived in our midst and remain profoundly connected to us. Of course, we find time to rest and have times of humane diversion for a balanced and temperate approach to our studies. But we also retain a happy intensity and a fervent gratitude, to keep moving toward something greater than merely a professional formation.

We do believe in professional formation, but every one of our students has a larger mission. Each one is sent by Christ into the world to serve and manifest his mystery. The same God who created the cosmos with the Big Bang and formulates galaxies and solar systems created each of us and instituted the Church. Following this image, we can think of the community of the Church as a kind of massive galaxy of stars. Some are shining very brightly, and some are a little fainter, but, in any case, it is awesome to be a star. And each one of our students is called by God to be one of these luminous stars, meant to shine and illuminate the darkness of this world with the light of Christ. This entails seeking out the gifts that providence provides in order to prepare yourself to serve God in your heart and mind, wherever you may be sent. The Angelicum is a kind of place of passage, where thinking with God, feeling with God, loving God, and having a sensibility for the inner life of the Church, forms our students to bring that light of Christ and of the universal Church with them, wherever they may go. This is the context of our education, and its inner measure is the wisdom of Christ himself. We give thanks to all whose generosity helps to make this education possible.

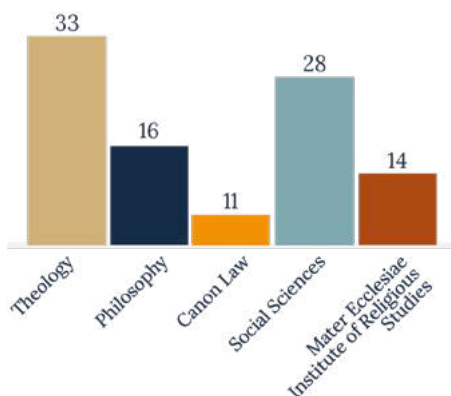

Academic scholarships cover the cost of tuition for the registered program

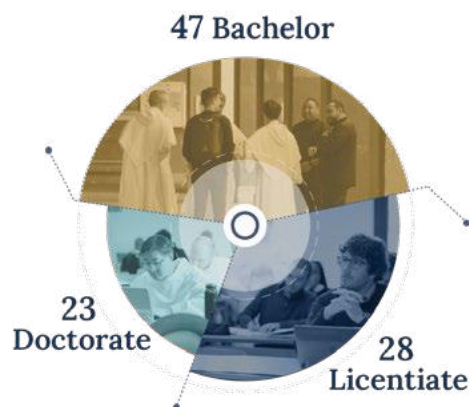

# FOCUSING ON SCHOLARSHIPS

Our ongoing capital campaign "Renewal at the heart of the Church" includes a priority of supporting academic scholarships for our students. Our aim is to create various distinct scholarship funds set apart for particular types of students or areas of study, for the present and into the future.

## Dominican Scholarships

Scholarships for Dominican friars from all over the world, especially at the doctoral level, keep the Order's academic formation strong at a global level, ensuring that Dominicans preach the faith with eloquence and learning for generations to come.

## Advanced Studies Scholarships

Doctoral and Licentiate students at pontifical universities become tomorrow's theologians, authors, and seminary professors. Educating a generation of well-formed teachers is essential for the future of the Church.

## Developing Country Scholarships

Giving students from developing countries a world-class theological formation represents a very meaningful investment in the formation of the Church worldwide.

## Seminarian Scholarships

Scholarships to support the education of seminarians at the Angelicum represent an investment in a well-formed priesthood to serve as pastors and preachers.

## Religious Sister Scholarships

Education for sisters in fields such as canon law, philosophy, and theology allows them to better administer their congregations, teach in Catholic schools, contribute theologically to the Church, and enhance their preparation for the contemplative and spiritual dimensions of their lives.

## Scholarships for Apostolate

The Angelicum has special doctoral and licentiate programs in focus areas such as interreligious relations and ecumenism. Supporting these scholarships gives students specialized knowledge of other religious and philosophical traditions, opening up new possibilities for apostolate and dialogue.

## Scholarships by Faculty

Scholarships can be awarded to students planning to study specifically in one of our four faculties: Theology, Philosophy, Canon Law, or Social Sciences.

## Italian Section Scholarships

As a bilingual university, the Angelicum provides a theological education to students in Italian and English. Providing scholarships specifically for the Italian section provides several advantages. Since Italian is today the predominant language of Church administration in the Vatican, as well as communication between the pope, the curia, and the world's bishops, helping students become fluent in Italian through a high-level theological formation is a great way to prepare future Church leaders, such as bishops and canon lawyers, who will guide the Church both locally and at the international level.

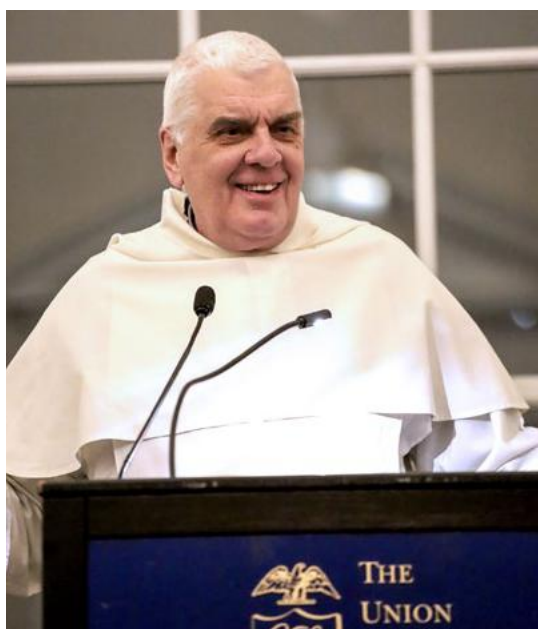

# UPDATES FROM OUR MISSION ADVANCEMENT TEAM

**T**he Angelicum proudly hosted its **Second Annual Aquinas Lecture** on Tuesday, February 3rd, in New York City. In partnership with First Things magazine, Fr. Wojciech Giertych, O.P., Theologian of the Papal Household and professor at the Angelicum, addressed over 400 guests at the Union League Club, sharing the richness of the University's Thomist tradition and its relevance for the Church today. The evening highlighted the Angelicum's mission to bring serious theological scholarship into dialogue with contemporary culture and provided a valuable opportunity for intellectual exchange among clergy, scholars, alumni, and friends of the University.



**I**n recent months, the Angelicum has increased its presence at major Catholic conferences across the United States—building relationships, raising awareness, and engaging directly with those discerning deeper formation in service of the Church. In November 2025, the university participated as a sponsor of the **2025 Good News Conference**. During the three-day gathering, host Bishop Robert Barron expressed his joy in seeing the University represented and shared his continued support for the Angelicum's mission and work.

From January 1-4, 2026, Angelicum staff were on hand at **SEEK26** in Columbus, Ohio, hosted by FOCUS. With tens of thousands of college students in attendance, our team had countless conversations with young adults discerning their vocational paths, answered questions about studying in Rome, and connected with Church leaders from across the country.

Later that month, from January 29 to February 1, the Angelicum served as a featured sponsor of the **2026 Legatus National Summit**. This expanded presence allowed us to share more fully the University's impact and future vision with Catholic business and civic leaders. We are especially grateful for the many connections made and look forward to welcoming Legatus members to the Angelicum in Rome this coming April.

These events reflect a growing engagement with the Church in the United States and a renewed invitation for students, supporters, and leaders to walk alongside the Angelicum in forming the next generation of faithful servants.
