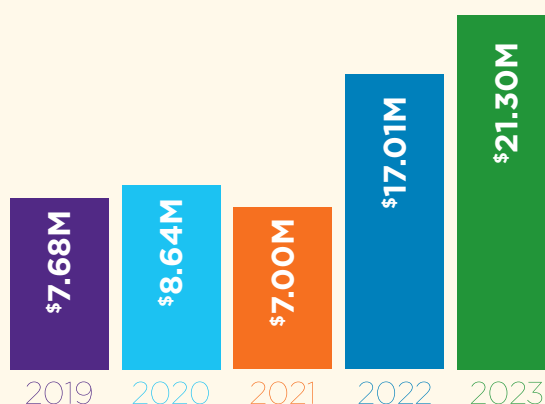
THE POWER OF UNRESTRICTED GIVING

Philanthropy plays a critical role in Denver Health's ability to deliver high-quality care across Denver's diverse communities. In 2023, unrestricted giving was one of the most significant drivers of impact, providing Denver Health with the flexibility to meet urgent needs and invest in long-term solutions.

Unrestricted funds allow us to respond swiftly to challenges such as the rising cost of uncompensated care, which has doubled from \$60 million in 2020 to over \$130 million in 2023. Flexible donations help support essential care for all who need it, including trauma care, primary and specialty services and critical initiatives.

The **Kaiser Permanente Community Challenge** offers a powerful example of how collective and flexible giving can amplify impact. Kaiser Permanente Colorado, through the **Kaiser Permanente Community Health Fund at The Denver Foundation**, contributed \$5 million and pledged to match that amount if donors would meet the challenge.

Our generous community exceeded the goal, contributing \$8.7 million. The resulting total of \$18.7 million in funding flowed into critical areas of need at Denver Health, allowing us to strengthen care where it was most essential and ensure flexibility in addressing urgent challenges.

Rose Andom contributed **\$55,000** as an unrestricted gift to our Foundation Impact Fund, empowering us to allocate resources where they are needed most across Denver Health.

TRANSFORMING HEALTH THROUGH PHILANTHROPY

School-Based Health Centers (SBHCs)

Thanks to the generosity of **The Anschutz Foundation**, **Caring for Denver Foundation**, **The Denver Post Community Foundation**, and individual donors like **Susan and Lee McIntire** and **The Patricia Crown Family**, Denver Health's 19 SBHCs provided critical health services to more than 15,000 students in 2023. These clinics offer accessible medical, behavioral health and dental care within schools, offering students the support they need to succeed academically and in life.

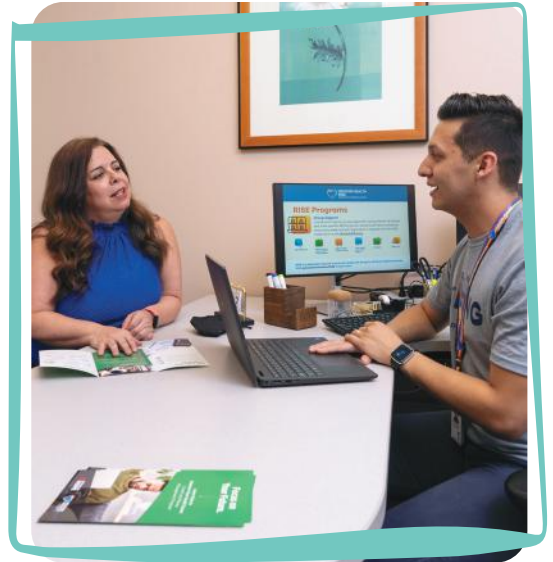


LGBTQ+ Health Services

Generous support from various donors, including **Dr. Stephen Wolf** and **Brian and Jake Wolfburg**, alongside contributions from **The Colorado Health Foundation** and **Caring for Colorado**, have helped Denver Health strengthen and expand its LGBTQ+ Health Services. These contributions fund vital services such as gender-affirming care and mental health support, ensuring compassionate, inclusive care for LGBTQ+ individuals throughout the Denver Health system.

Workforce Development

Funding from **Dependable Cleaners** has provided critical scholarships for paramedic training, ensuring Denver Health's emergency medical services are equipped with highly skilled professionals. Additionally, support from **Delta Dental of Colorado Foundation** has helped aspiring dental professionals overcome financial barriers to training, fostering a diverse dental workforce that better reflects and serves Denver's communities. These investments are essential in preparing health care professionals to meet the growing demands of care in our city.



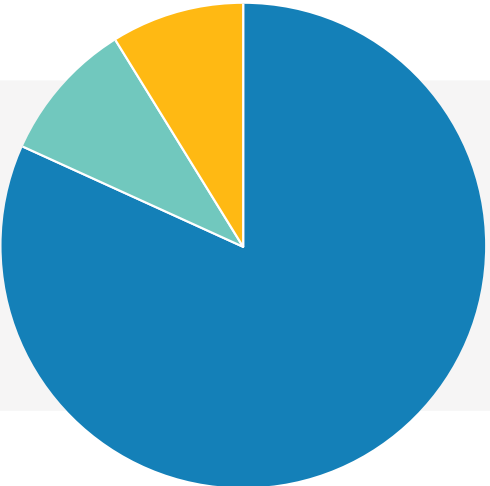
Hybrid Operating Room (OR)

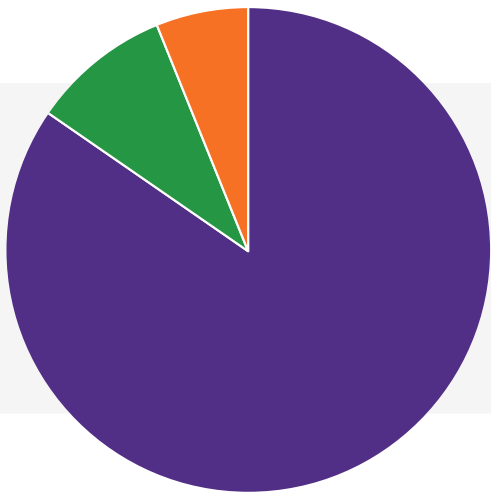
DHF Revenues
