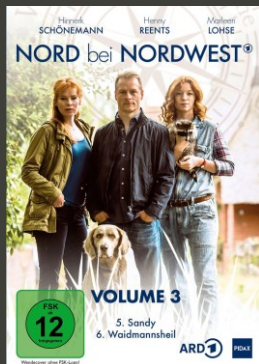

Series Synopsis

Later, to protect Sophie, she lies in court about coercing a confession and is suspended from the force. Working as a private detective, Julia gets caught in a web of Polish gang crime...

After Julia's suspension, Ellen transfers from Denmark to take her place. Tensions with Karin run high – likely because Karin knows something about Ellen's mother and can't let go of the past.

Ellen's return to the island seems driven as much by personal history as by duty. As the two women grow closer and Ellen moves into Karin's house, the former prosecutor gains insight into both Ellen's cases and her private life.
