RAYMOND S. McLAIN

With all of the changes that have taken place in the past year, people often are moving so fast that they sometimes forget to remember what was. In remembering the man on whom we have based our ideals, we dedicate this page to Raymond S. McLain.

In 1912, he enlisted in the Oklahoma National Guard. Nominated by the President of the United States, he was promoted to the rank of Brigadier General and later the rank of Lieutenant General. He was presented with his third star by General Dwight D. Eisenhower.

After his retirement in 1952, General McLain was selected to serve a five-year term on the National Security Commission. At a commission conference, he was stricken with a fatal illness which led to his death on December 4, 1954. The McLain students continue to proudly carry in their hearts the memories of Raymond S. McLain.

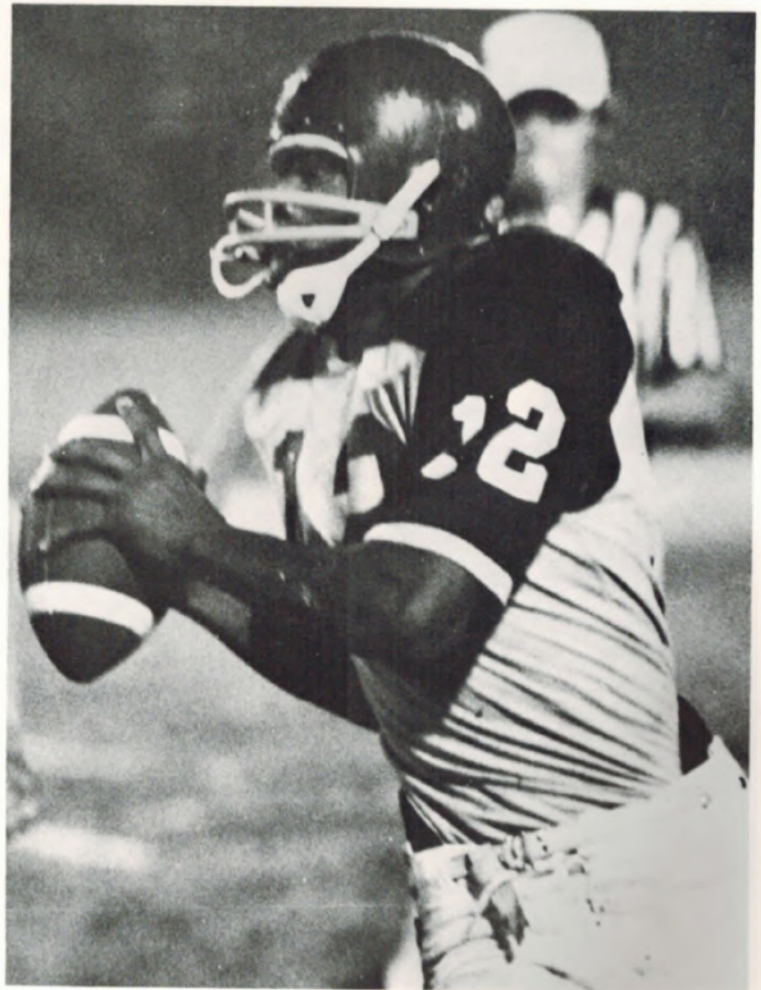

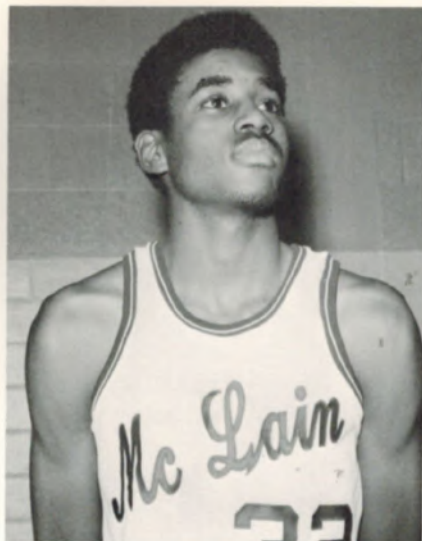

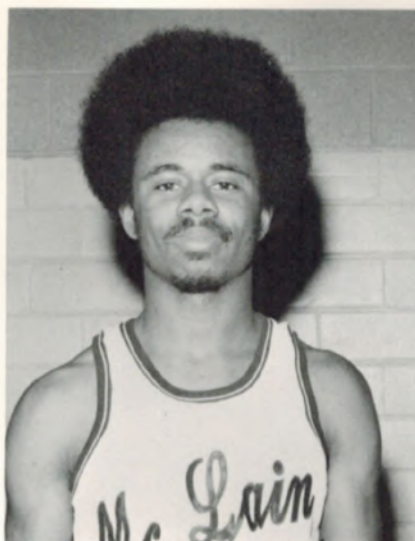
