


Former Boston Bruin and Respected Broadcaster John "Johnny" Peirson, died April 16, 2021, at the age of 95 at his home in Wayland, Massachusetts, surrounded in his last days by his family

Signed by the Boston Bruins in 1946, John played right wing for the Bruins' farm team, the Hershey Bears, and then 11 years with the Boston Bruins and was a member of the "Muscle Line." He was a talented goal-scorer, scoring 20 or more goals four times, and played in the NHL All Star game twice.

After his retirement from hockey, John became a well-known and respected broadcaster and color analyst for the Bruins, working alongside Fred Cusick for many years. John had a keen eye, and a deep understanding of the game, and his breakdown of play between periods, known as "Peirson's Pointers," was a favorite among the Boston fans. John retired from broadcasting in 1995.


