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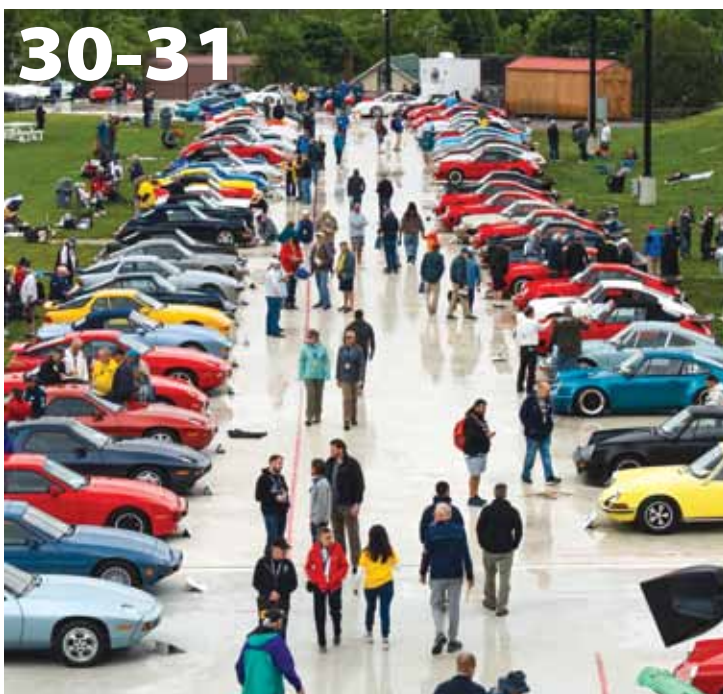
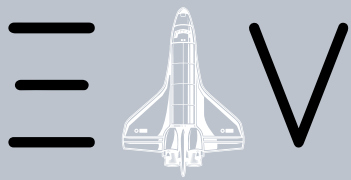

I look forward to continuing to work with SCPCA to make our awesome club the best around!



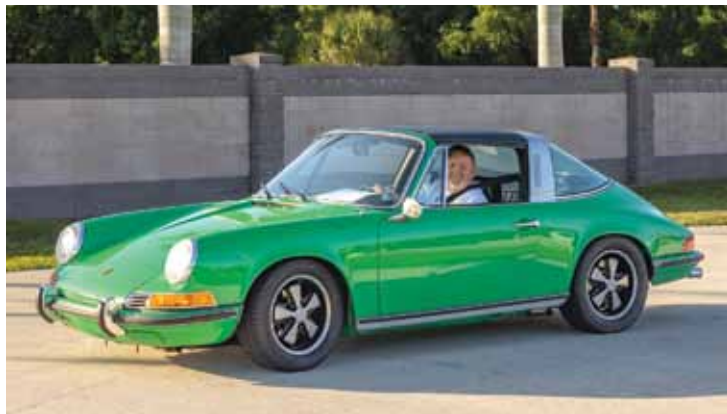
All European Car Show at AMCM

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Tech Session: Xtreme Cylinder Heads

On April 11th we had a very special opportunity to visit Xtreme Cylinder Heads located in Palm City, Florida. Over twenty fearless members took to I-95 for an 85 mile trip to see this incredible facility which is the premiere manufacture of the highest quality Porsche aftermarket cylinder heads and restoration and rebuilding of Porsche OEM cylinder heads.

This facility is not in some fancy area, it is tucked in a small industrial area of Palm City surrounded by landscaping and palm growing areas, hence Palm City. The building has no sign and in fact, I thought we were in the wrong area as my GPS stated we I was at the address. If it were not for the fact that the owner Bill DiCondina and his crew met us outside we would have never found this place. This non-descript building opened up to a state-of-art manufacturing facility that was humming with activity. When I say I was impressed, I was impressed and I have had experience working in manufacturing facilities. Bill and Company (all of his crew) met us and actually demonstrated their machining prowess to us.

This facility manufacturers Porsche cylinder heads for some of the most famous Porsche aftermarket shops in the US and Europe, such as Reimagined by Singer, Porsche Motorsports (ex-Andial) and others. They manufacture their own cylinder heads from scratch. Their manufactured cylinder heads are cast in the USA (Midwest somewhere), utilizing the lost wax casting process. The cores are manufactured from RR350 aluminum alloy chosen for superior heat dissipation. These castings are manufactured using the Hot Isostatic Pressing (HIP) which are subjected to very high temperatures, pressures which is applied in all directions to minimize porosity and casting defects. If you don't know by now, these are superior castings that meet the highest standards for turbine blades and nuclear and aerospace programs.

No expense has been spared in his facility as it is second to none. It is clean, well thought out and versatile and well laid out. He has numerous CNC machines that have tolerances far superior to that of Porsche, but that is Bill's standard. I could go on about what each of these

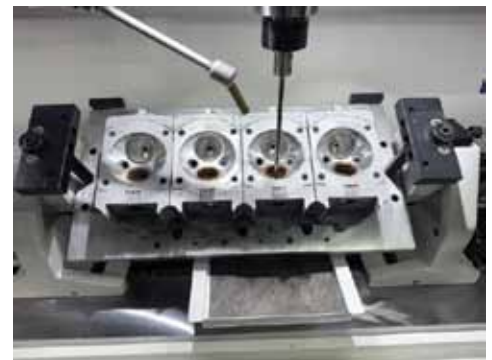
machines can do, but I think I might bore you with that. Suffice it to say, I was truly impressed with their capabilities. All of his people were handpicked to work at his facility. None of them have had machining experience. Bill does this on purpose, he wants to train them cradle-to-grave and have them do the work to Bill's standards, he does not want them to come to his shop with poor behaviors and learned skills where they would make mistakes. He is relaying on training them the correct way without bad behaviors to get a superior product and it works.

Hard to believe, but we were told that we were the only Porsche region ever to visit Xtreme Cylinder Heads and hard to believe we have never heard of this place. I even went to our local independent shops and they have not heard about them either. One note, the local independent shop now uses Xtreme Cylinder Heads after I showed them the facility and capabilities. Well done guys.

After all the demonstrations Bill treated us to a barbeque feast from Beer and Barbeque that Bill brought in for all of us. I have to say, it was some of the best brisket and homemade sausage I have ever had. We should make this a drive and dine if we head south on a drive and dine in the future.

Thank you Xtreme Cylinder Heads for allowing us to visit with you and your team. I am sure we will hear more about you guys in the future and hope we can visit with you again.

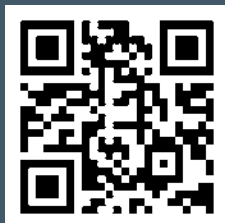

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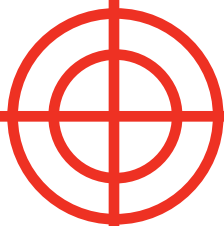


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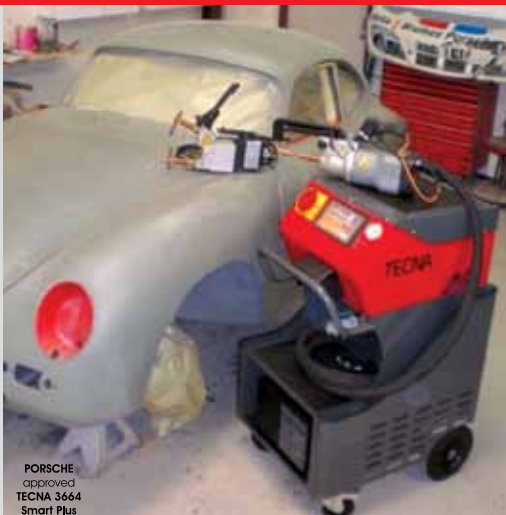
