






HISTORIC BAYLOR CAMPUSES




On the east side of FM 50 at Windmill Hill, a modern pavilion and bell tower with interpretive signage mark the original Baylor male campus.

On the west side of FM 50, columns mark the site of Academy Hill, the original Baylor University female campus. Jointly maintained by Baylor and the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor, the surrounding park includes picnic tables, a playground area, and is one of the best places in the state to enjoy springtime bluebonnets.






