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Introduction

Raising the “WOW” Factor

The second edition of Smart Lift & Mobility World, with five concurrent events, witnessed crowds, connections and cheers during three action-packed days in February at BIEC in Bengaluru.

From dawn to dusk, Smart Lift & Mobility (SLM) World 2026 proved to be a comprehensive and strategically integrated three-day event. Those present at Bangalore International Exhibition Centre (BIEC), Bengaluru, from February 5-7 witnessed a truly global convergence. Top-notch vertical transportation (VT), security and access control, mobility solutions, car parking, people-flow and building-movement ecosystems representatives – as well as prominent dignitaries representing related stakeholder sectors – came together under one roof. Taking forward the success story of its debut edition held in 2024 at Bengaluru, the second edition of the expo exceeded all expectations once again.

Observing the intense interactions taking place during the international event and unique knowledge summits on all three days, plus the unique SLM Awards presentation and Elevator Safety Run conceptualized by event organizers Virgo Communications and Exhibitions, was truly heartwarming. The ELEVATOR WORLD India and Future Building & Smart Mobility (FBSM) summits covered several relevant and topical themes, providing a dedicated platform for exchanging ideas and formulating a blueprint for the future.

Designed to be larger and more comprehensive than its debut edition, SLM World 2026 kicked off with a prestigious inauguration ceremony featuring industry titans Anitha Raghunath, director, Virgo Communications; T. Bruce MacKinnon, president and CEO, Elevator World, Inc.; Abhijit Dandekar, president, Pacific Asia Lift and Escalator Association (PALEA); Suraj Thodimarath, (then) managing director (MD), Wittur India and president, Elevator & Escalator Component Manufacturers Association of India (EECMAI); Sumit Bhatnagar, director (Rolling Stock, Electrical [RSE], Operations and Maintenance O&M), Bangalore Metro Rail Corp. Ltd.; Dr. HR Shivakumar, Karnataka Administrative Service, secretary, Karnataka Real Estate Regulatory Authority Real Estate Regulatory Authority (K-RERA); and Massimo Bezzi, president, European Federation for Elevator Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (EFESME).

In her welcome speech, Raghunath explained that SLM World was conceived as more than an exhibition. To move with time, it was envisioned as an integrated ecosystem – bringing together manufacturers of elevators, escalators, mobility solutions, parking systems and building access technologies alongside architects, developers, policymakers and solution providers. This platform is a convergence of ideas, insights, partnerships and leadership that will define how people move within the built environment, she said.

As India builds taller, smarter and more inclusive cities, vertical and horizontal mobility have evolved from being invisible backend infrastructure to becoming central enablers of urban experience, safety, efficiency and sustainability. Today, mobility systems are no longer just cost components in a project – they are strategic value drivers. They directly influence project return on investment, operational efficiency, user satisfaction, accessibility and, ultimately, the livability of our cities. In a rapidly urbanizing India, how people move within buildings and across urban spaces is fundamental to how cities function, grow and thrive.

This platform has also played an important role in media engagement and policy advocacy. During the runup to the event, Virgo actively amplified the industry's voice on the need for a “One Nation, One Lift” policy and on the importance of stronger budgetary support for real estate and infrastructure

— sectors that directly drive employment, urban development and vertical mobility demand, Ragunath added.

MacKinnon shared information about EW, its evolution and growth journey, observing it is in the third generation of a publication established in 1953 by his grandfather to bring the industry together. He pointed out that EW has focused completely on the elevator industry for 73 years, and it is the only independent publisher covering this industry in all the major markets — the U.S., Middle East, China, Türkiye, Europe, the U.K. and India. EW continues to partner with nearly every association and every event across the planet, trying to help achieve the goal of growing the VT industry and making it safer for riders, workers and the industry as a whole.

MacKinnon recalled partnering with Virgo Communications two decades ago and his first visit to India. Appreciating the SLM World platform — which brings all stakeholders together to communicate, broaden their horizons and improve construction and architecture — MacKinnon emphasized the human need to connect at a face-to-face event will not change.

Dandekar provided a brief introduction of PALEA and the need for having a common code and certifications for VT worldwide. In his Industry Vision Address, he presented a compelling global perspective on the elevator sector and emphasized the urgent need for a unified “One Nation, One Lift Policy” to strengthen regulatory alignment and safety standards across India.

The India Outlook Address was delivered by Thodimarath, who spoke on the theme “Global Standards Powering India's Next Phase of Vertical Mobility.” He presented a forward-looking perspective on strengthening India's elevator and escalator ecosystem through alignment with global standards. He emphasized the critical role of component manufacturers in enhancing safety, quality benchmarks and manufacturing excellence to support India's rapid infrastructure growth. He reinforced the importance of global benchmarking, regulatory coherence and industry-wide collaboration in shaping a future-ready vertical mobility landscape for India.

During the Guest of Honor Address, Bhatnagar spoke on the theme “Metro-Led Urban Development: Shaping Mobility, Connectivity and Growth Opportunities.” He presented a forward-looking perspective on advancing India's urban transit ecosystem through metro-led initiatives. Drawing on his 32 years of experience across Indian Railways' Research Designs and Standards Organization, Delhi Metro Rail Corp. and Bangalore Metro Rail Corp. Ltd., he emphasized the critical role of rolling stock, signaling and electrical systems in enhancing operational efficiency, connectivity and sustainable urban growth.

Delivering the second Guest of Honor Address, Shivakumar spoke on the theme “RERA and India's Future-Ready Real Estate Ecosystem.” He presented a forward-looking perspective on transforming India's real estate sector through regulatory reforms, transparency and robust governance. He emphasized the pivotal role of K-RERA in enhancing compliance, protecting consumer interests and fostering sustainable urban development. His address added strategic depth to the Expo, reinforcing the importance of regulatory coherence, accountability and industry-wide collaboration in building a resilient and future-ready real estate ecosystem for India.

Presenting the “Special Address on SME Growth,” Bezzi explained how common European standards have empowered elevator SMEs to compete, collaborate and scale globally.

In his concluding remarks, Dandekar outlined key takeaways and the road ahead for building a standards-driven, future-ready vertical mobility ecosystem — reinforcing the importance of collaboration, policy

reform and global benchmarking in shaping India's next phase of growth.

During all the three days of SLM World 2026, representatives of prominent exhibitor brands and a large number of enthusiastic visitors expressed immense happiness with the high quality of products and technologies showcased, as well as the senior management-level teams exchanging insights at the stalls.

From launches to innovations, unveiling new technologies to upskilling and training sessions, profitable business development to mutually beneficial buyer-seller meets that initiated tie-ups to impactful networking, SLM World 2026 had much more in store for everyone who exhibited or visited, with the innovative booths and revolutionary technology in the mobility space being the center of attention.

More than 10,000 key visitors were seen connecting with key stakeholders and building strategic partnerships in the exclusive business-to-business zone, getting high-quality leads and engaging directly with decision-makers and targeted industry buyers. Visitors had a rare opportunity to explore advanced technologies featuring leading brands under one roof.

The international expo provided a powerful opportunity for manufacturers, suppliers and solution providers to showcase their latest products, technologies and services, interacting with top industry professionals and expanding brand visibility and influence across international markets. Buyers benefitted from exploring multiple solutions under one roof, engaging with both new and established players, comparing offerings and making informed decisions aligned with their specific project requirements.

SLM World 2026 was hailed as an ideal platform for buyers to witness the latest-generation products from credible and compliant suppliers with focused outreach to large developers, mid-scale builders and owner-driven decision-makers – a key buying segment in the Indian market.

These compact, self-supported, wheelchair-friendly home lift systems are ideal for duplex/triplex apartments and villas.

Wittur India introduced its 2-h fire-rated small glass door designed for projects where safety, visibility and compliance matter most. IS 17900-compliant, it is designed for modern elevator applications. The company also launched all new, IS 17900-compliant variants of its Core MD, Core and Stellar Steel doors, marking a complete upgrade in safety and compliance standards in its products, effective March 2026.

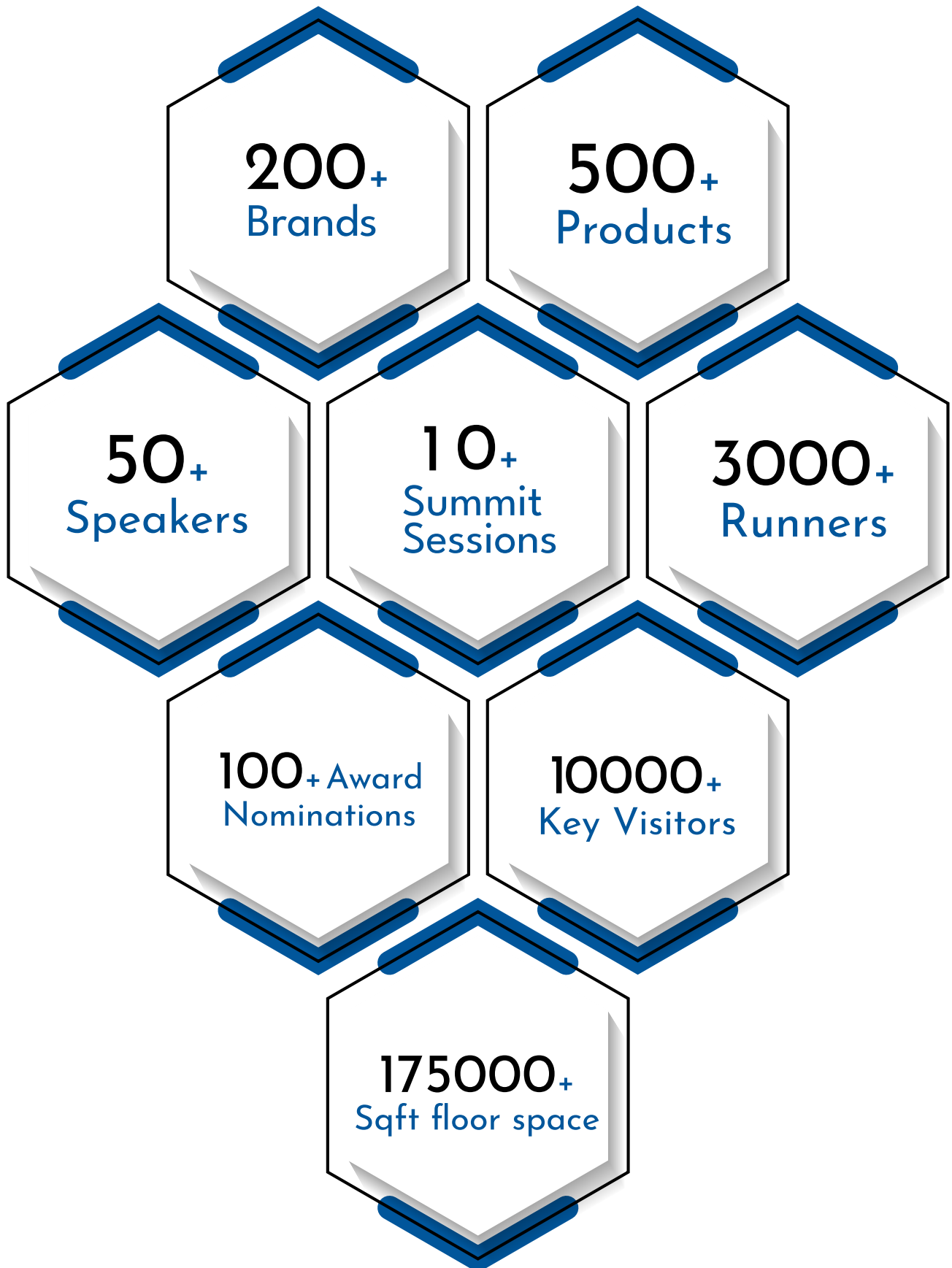

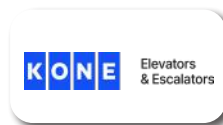

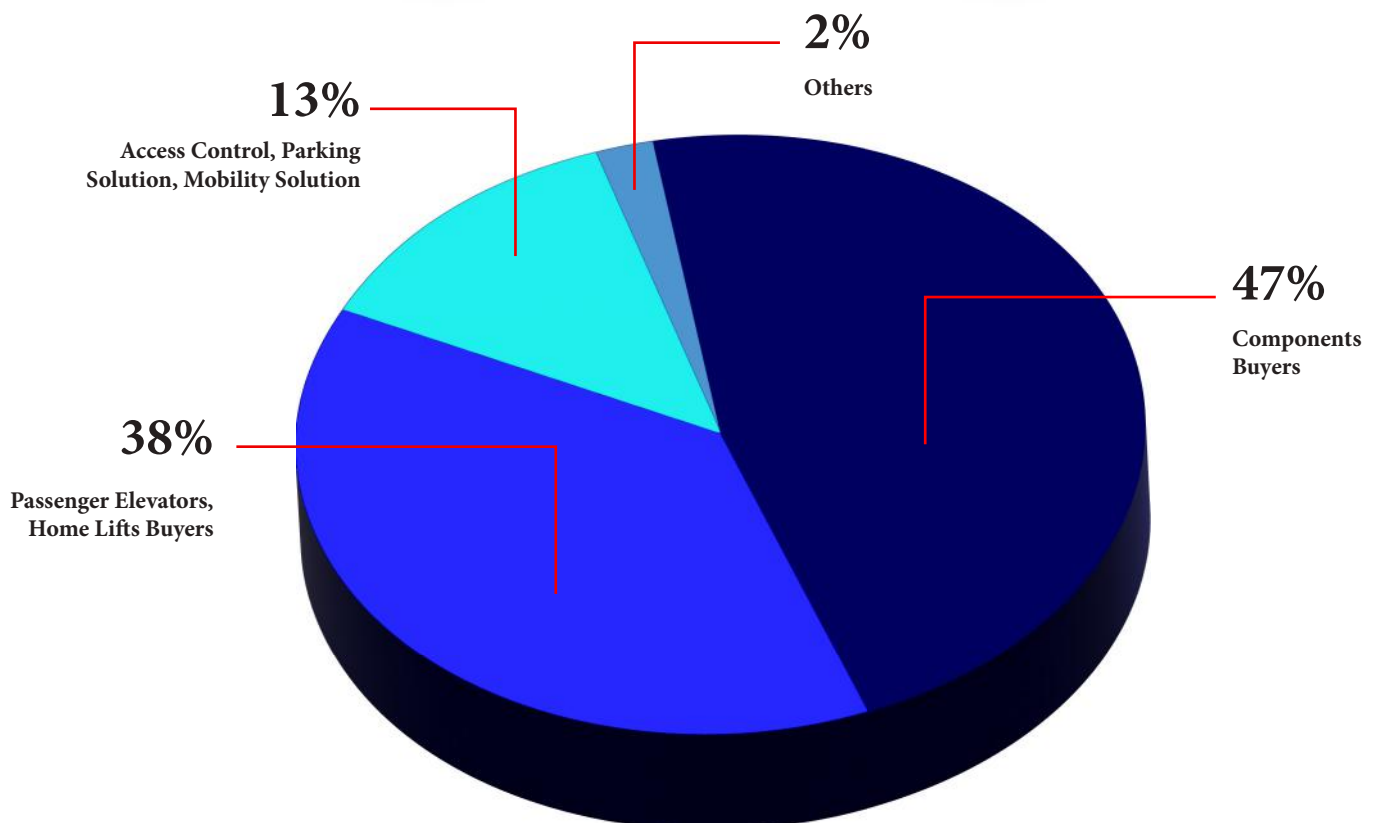

Profile



Elevator World India Summit



A key highlight of the 2026 edition was the Elevator World India (EWI) Summit with sessions featuring a keynote address on One Nation One Lift Policy, Global Standards Powering India's next phase of VT growth and a first of its kind exclusive business and leadership coaching curated for business owners, promoters, and senior decision-makers. The Summit also brought together panel discussions on Home Lift - a High Growth Opportunity and Independent Elevator Companies as a Rising Force. A number of training sessions were also held on key technical aspects.

The second edition once again hosted industry leaders, innovators and experts from across India to explore the latest advancements, trends and solutions shaping the future of vertical mobility. 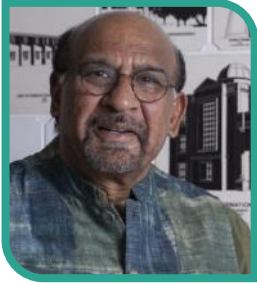
FBSM will continue its journey during 2026 with upcoming chapters scheduled at Kochi, Vizag, Lucknow, Kolkata and Jaipur.
