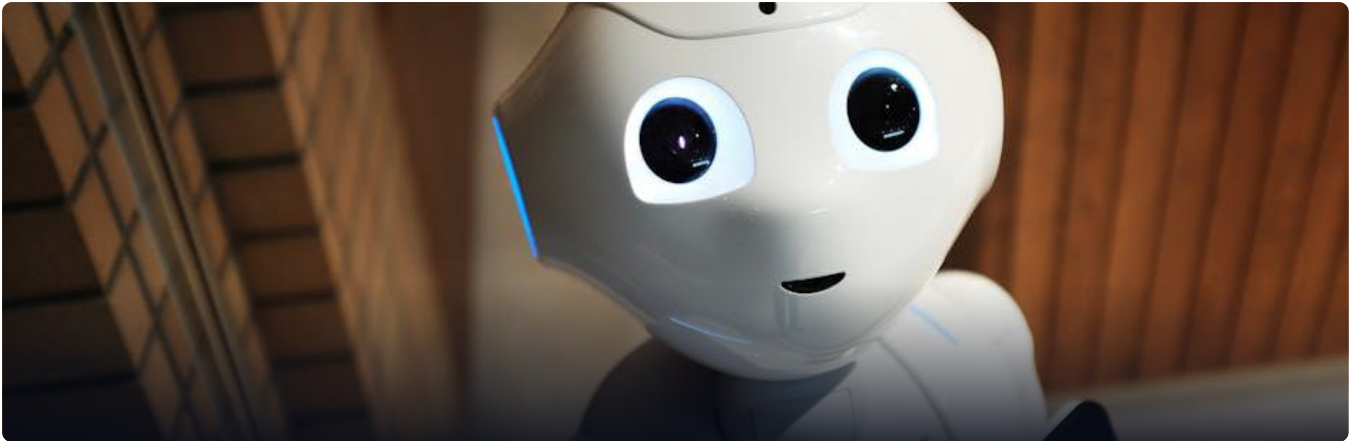

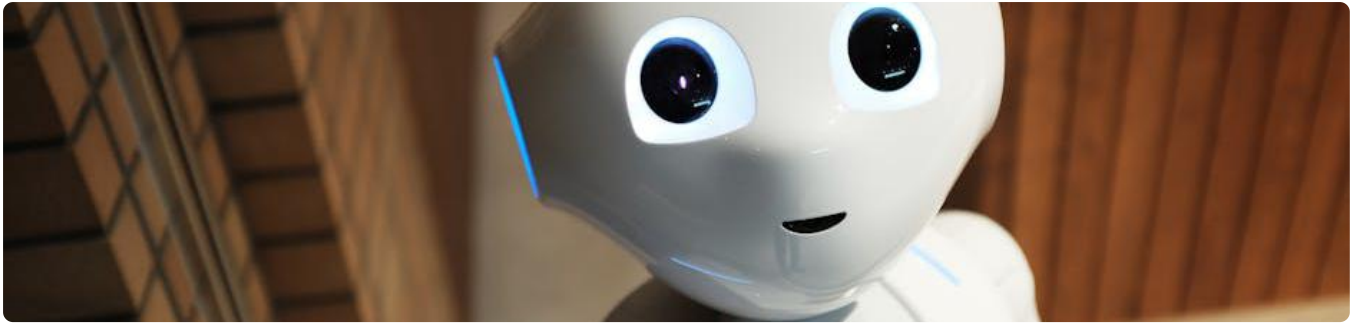

## Stop MFA Fatigue Attacks Before Employees Click Yes

Hackers are overwhelming employees with dozens of push notifications hoping they'll approve one just to stop the annoyance. This "MFA bombing" bypasses your multi-factor authentication without stealing any credentials.

**Step 1:** Enable number matching in your MFA app so users must enter displayed codes.

**Step 2:** Set notification limits to block repeated authentication requests within short timeframes.

**Step 3:** Train employees to report MFA prompts they didn't initiate to IT immediately.

**Step 4:** Switch to hardware security keys for privileged accounts and high-risk users.

# World Password Day (May 1)

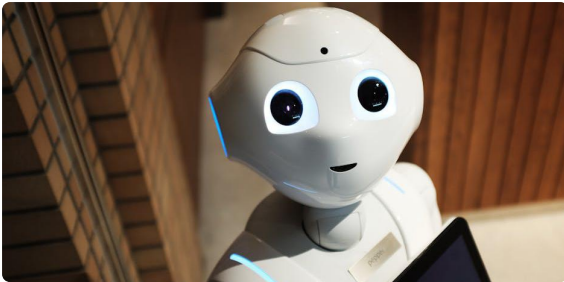
# Security Awareness Spotlight: World Password Day May 1st marks World Password Day, and it's the perfect reminder that weak passwords remain the easiest way for criminals to break into your business systems. If your team is still using "Spring2024!" or reusing the same password across multiple accounts, you're essentially leaving your front door unlocked—most data breaches start with compromised passwords that could have been prevented. This month, commit to three changes: require multi-factor authentication on every business account (that second code on your phone stops 99% of automated attacks), get your team using a password manager so they can actually remember strong unique passwords, and do a quick audit to find any shared logins that need to be split into individual accounts. **\*\*Your action for today: Pick just one critical system—your email, accounting software, or bank account—and turn on multi-factor authentication right now; it takes five minutes and could save your business.\*\***

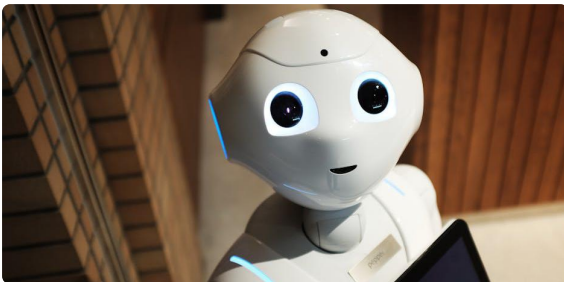

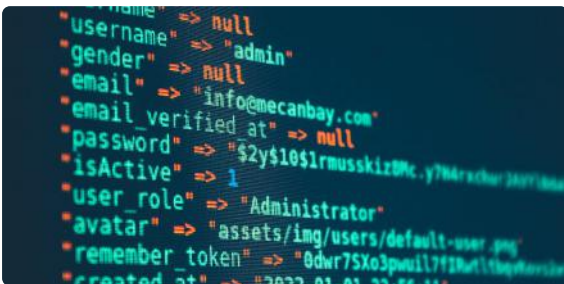

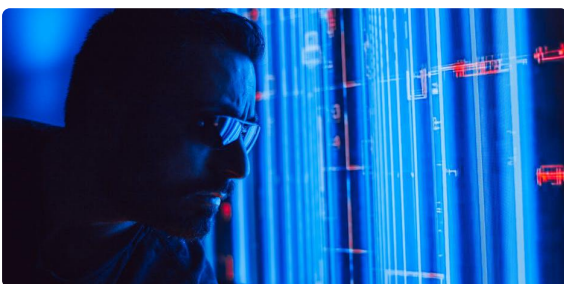

This week's headlines paint a troubling picture, but there's one thread connecting nearly every story: speed matters more than ever. Whether it's AI-powered DDoS attacks, critical SharePoint vulnerabilities, or Iranian threat actors exploiting SEO weaknesses, the window between disclosure and exploitation has collapsed to hours, not days.

CERT-In's recommendation for 12-hour patching timelines isn't arbitrary—it reflects the reality that AI-assisted attacks can now weaponize vulnerabilities faster than traditional security teams can respond. I've seen firsthand how organizations that treated patching as a "next week" task became victims within 48 hours of a CVE announcement.

Here's what keeps me up at night: most small and mid-sized businesses I speak with still operate on monthly patch cycles. That's simply not viable anymore. The good news? You don't need a massive security team to adapt. Automated patch management, vulnerability scanning, and managed detection services can level the playing field dramatically.

The threat landscape is accelerating, but so are the tools available to defend against it. Now's the time to audit your response capabilities and close those timing gaps before attackers do it for you.
