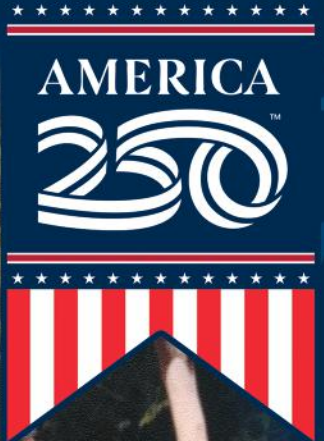

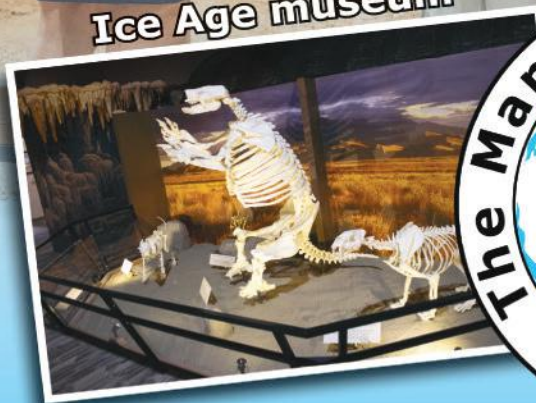

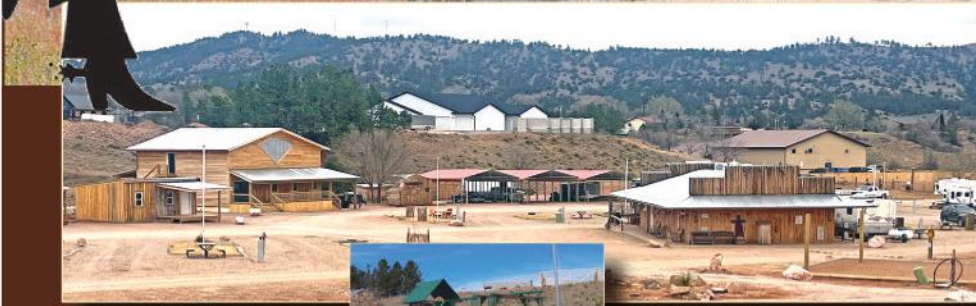

Community Profile

CLIMATE

With the highest average annual temperature at a comfortable 64 degrees, Hot Springs is one of the warmest cities in the state. Our average median temperature, averaging highs, and lows are 48.6 degrees. An average year will see 17.5 inches of rain and nearly 27 inches of snow. During the winter, the prevailing wind comes from the northwest, but switches in the summer to the southwest. We are at 3,448 feet above sea level.

POPULATION / DEMOGRAPHICS

The estimated 2026 population of Hot Springs is 3,712 which is an increase of 9.21% since the most recent census, which recorded a population of 3,399 in 2020.

Hot Springs is the county-seat of Fall River County which has an estimated population of 7,339, which also includes the communities of Edgemont, Oelrichs, Oral, Smithwick as well as a growing population of residents around Angostura Reservoir. Fall River County is 25th largest out of 66 counties in South Dakota.

The median household income in Hot Springs is \$66,338 with a poverty rate of 21.11%. The median age in Hot Springs is 59.4 years: 53.9 years for males, and 60.2 years for females.

EDUCATION

The Hot Springs Public School District serves PK-12th grade. Total enrollment for school year 2025-26 was 694 students: 293 students are at the elementary level, 167 at the middle school, and 234 at the high school level. More information can be found at the district's website www.hssd.k12.sd.us/ or the district's facebook or Instagram.

Private schools include Bethesda Lutheran Church and School which enrolls Prek-5th grade students and offers childcare services. The current enrollment at Bethesda Prek-5th grade is 30 students with 3 full time teachers. Bethesda's childcare is DSS licensed.

For higher education, Rio Grande Bible College, based in Edinburg, Texas, is planning to open a campus in Hot Springs in 2026.

The Boy & Girls Club of Hot Springs (745-8000) is open year-round five-days-a-week and offers an after-school program.

RECREATION

Hot Springs boasts five city parks, many of which contain playground equipment and picnic shelters. Butler Park, located near the library, features six ballfields, (baseball, soccer, and softball), a tennis court, a pickle ball court, a basketball court, horse shoes and an outdoor volleyball pit as well as a skateboard park. There is also a 9-hole disc golf course under development. In addition, there is a challenging 18-hole public golf course, a bowling alley, a miniature golf course, an indoor swimming pool (Evans Plunge), miles of walking trails, and more than 40 active clubs and organizations. There is also a rifle shooting range northeast of town and a trap shooting range southeast of town.

GOVERNMENT

The city of Hot Springs has a Mayor, City Administrator, and eight City Council members, representing four wards. Each term is two-years. For more information about the City of Hot Springs, go to their website at hs-sd.org.

Fall River County has a Board of five at-large Commissioners, each of whom is elected to a four-year term. The county's website is fallriver.sdcounties.org.

The Hot Springs Police Department has seven full-time and two reserve officers and the Hot Springs Fire Department is made up of approximately 40 volunteers. Law enforcement outside of the city limits is handled by the Fall River County Sheriff's Office.

COMMUNITY FACILITIES

Hot Springs is home to 22 churches, approximately 450 lodging rooms, 4 Bed & Breakfast Inns, 6 Banquet Rooms, 5 Caterers, 11 Meeting Rooms, and 1 Entertainment Convention Center, The Mueller Civic Center. With a seating capacity of 401 in the Theater, 1,250 in the Auditorium, 80 in the Conference Room, and 150 in the Annex, the Mueller Center is home to a variety of community functions throughout the year. The Hot Springs Post 71 American Legion also has a large hall where community functions and fundraisers are often held.



MEDICAL

- The VA Hot Springs Medical Center provides primary care and specialty health services, including mental health, nutrition, addiction and substance abuse treatment, kidney dialysis, traumatic brain injury (TBI), and more.
- The Michael J. Fitzmaurice State Veterans Home has 100 beds for veterans and spouses.
- Facilities at Seven Sisters Living Center offer 48 beds.
- Pine Hills Retirement Community has 61 units.
- Fall River Hospital currently offers 25 beds in its critical care hospital.
- Hot Springs also boasts three family medical clinics, two chiropractic clinics, a pair of dental offices, two physical therapy clinics, an eye clinic, three mental health clinics and a health-food store.

The median sale price of a home in Hot Springs was \$370,000 in February 2026, up 13.8% since last year. - Golden West Telecommunications provides, phone, cable television and internet.
- The Hot Springs Post Office (zip code 57747) is downtown and offers a drive-up mailbox. 605-745-4117
- The Hot Springs Public Library offers over 20,000 books and magazines along with more than 3,000 DVDs and 1,000 audiobooks for patrons to enjoy. The library also offers computers, a scanner, printer, and fax machine for public use. Wireless access is available throughout the building, back patio, and parking lot.

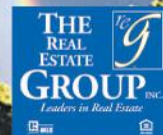

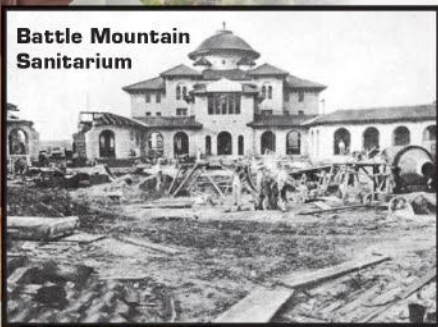

The Veterans Town

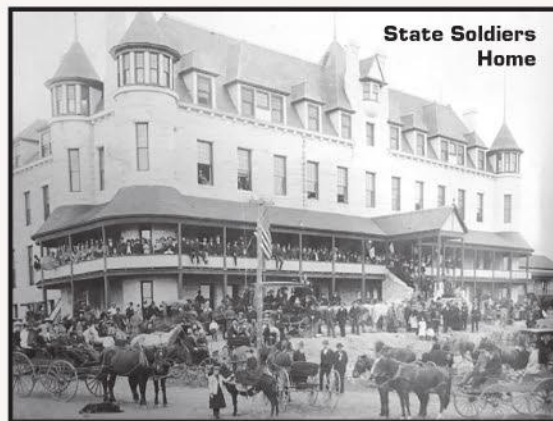
Every day is Veterans Day in Hot Springs.

The City of Hot Springs is known as South Dakota's "Veteran's Town" due to its rich history of caring for our nation's veterans who served their country with immense honor and sacrifice.

Hot Springs is the location of the Michael J. Fitzmaurice State Veterans Home (est. 1889) and also the Hot Springs VA Medical Center (est. 1907), both of which have been in existence for about half of the United States' 250 year history.

Michael J. Fitzmaurice State Veterans Home (originally known as State Soldiers' Home)

After the American Civil War, the Grand Army of the Republic (GAR), a fraternal organization of Union veterans, "was active in establishing Soldiers' Homes in several states."

In 1886 the Dakota chapter of the GAR began to lobby the Territorial Legislature for the building of a Soldiers' Home. Potential sites for the home included Pierre, Watertown, Jamestown, and Hot Springs.

After a series of setbacks, the continued efforts of the GAR and other prominent figures in the Territory led to the eventual passage of a bill funding a Soldiers' Home in 1889.

Hot Springs was selected because of the medicinal properties of the warm mineral springs and its "healthful climate."

The laying of the cornerstone occurred in November of 1889, "with the Masonic ritual conducted in the midst of a blinding

snowstorm."

Despite the poor weather conditions, about 200 people and 82 teams of horses took part in a celebratory parade that ran from downtown up to the Soldiers' Home.

Fast forwarding to 1998, the facility was renamed in honor of Michael J. Fitzmaurice (pronounced fitz-morris), a South Dakota veteran who was awarded the Medal of Honor for his courageous acts during a battle near Khe Sanh, Vietnam, in 1971. His bronze sculpture (pictured on right) now greets visitors to the State Home.

Today, the original building constructed in the late 1800s still exists, but residents were moved to a new building on campus that opened in 2016.

In 2026 the State Veterans Home still provides "quality health care in an environment and community of trust, dignity, and sharing."





Hot Springs VA Medical Center (originally known as Battle Mountain Sanitarium)

In 2027 the Hot Springs VA Medical Center will celebrate 120 years of operation (1907-2027), but its story begins a little before that.

In May 1902 President Theodore Roosevelt officially signed off on a request to build the sanitarium, and it "was not intended for use as a soldier's home; instead, it was a short-term treatment facility for current residents of the National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers (NHDVS) who suffered from lung or respiratory problems."

Architect Thomas R. Kimball of Nebraska was selected as architect, and planned "a star, or radial plan, in the Spanish Mission style to design the grouping of buildings," while using local sandstone to construct the buildings.

In August 1903 ground was

broken for the facility, with the main group of buildings completed by April 1907.

Warm medicinal waters from a nearby spring supplied waters for "two fine plunge baths" – one hot and one cold – on the campus.

In July 1930 President Herbert Hoover signed Executive Order 5398, creating the newly formed Veterans Administration and consolidating three agencies into it, including the NHDVS, and since then the Hot Springs facility has continued to operate as a Department of Veterans Affairs medical facility.

In 1996, VA Black Hills Health Care System was established with the merging of the VA Medical Centers at Fort Meade (Sturgis) and Hot



Springs. This "consolidation was accomplished to enhance the quality of and access to health care services for veterans in the service area."

Over the decades since its initial opening, the campus has changed with the addition of new buildings, a "grand

staircase" that connects to the downtown area, and other improvements.

Today, the Hot Springs VA Medical Center remains "dedicated to improving the lives of veterans and their families every day."

Warm Healing Waters

The warm healing waters of Hot Springs not only helped establish two veterans-related healthcare facilities, but it also made the area a tourist attraction.

In the autumn of 1881, Dr. R.D. Jennings, an Ohio-born physician who came to Dakota Territory in the 1870s, traveled to the Minnekahta Valley and immediately obtained the title to the site where "hot, crystal-clear water flowed from the living sandstone to fill a large basin that had been carved into the shape of a moccasin." There he operated the

town's first bath house, the present-day location of **Moccasin Springs Natural Mineral Spa (pictured below left)**, which has been welcoming visitors since 2019.

In 1890, "public-spirited capitalist" Fred T. Evans began construction of Evans Plunge (known then as the Plunge Bath), which was "the world's largest enclosed natural warm-water swimming pool at the time."

Evans Plunge, considered the first man-made tourist attraction of the Black Hills, officially opened in May of 1891. Since 2013, **Evans Plunge Mineral Springs** has been owned by the City of Hot Springs.

The quiet and peaceful Minnekahta Valley then went from a few scattered homesteader cabins to a health resort destination. Soon the downtown area

boasted architecturally unique sandstone buildings.

The now lively city benefitted from nationwide tourism campaigns as well as increased accessibility. Not one but two railroads decided to connect Hot Springs to the outside world, with the Fremont, Elkhorn and Missouri Valley rails (via Buffalo Gap) completed by 1889 and the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy by 1890 (via Edgemont). The completion of these railroad lines "became a significant turning point in the long-range success" of the city.





So Much To Soak In

The community of Hot Springs recently celebrated the completion of a three-year downtown reconstruction project which replaced more than two miles of concrete surfacing of U.S. Hwy. 385 as well as curb/gutter and underground utilities.

One of the project's most anticipated and unique aspects was the construction of a 400 yard long **Suspended Sidewalk (pictured below)** that runs along North River Street, across from Centennial Park.



The new walkway overlooks Fall River and also includes a pair of pedestrian bridges which brings people to the **Freedom Trail, Waterfall and Kidney Springs Gazebo**. This new centerpiece of Hot Springs' downtown area promises to become a hub of new activity while also emphasizing the already important aspects of **Centennial Park** which plays home to such events as **Salute to Valor** in May, the **Main Street Arts & Crafts Festival** in June, weekly **Farmer's Markets** from May to October and the **Fall River Flight Fest's Vendor Market & Night Glow** and other events.

The **Rockin' Riverside Summer Concert Series (pictured above)** will also make a return to Centennial Park this year, after it's very popular debut last year. The event features seven different live music concerts spread out during the months of May, June, July and August. See page 28 for a full listing of the concert schedule.

Downtown Hot Springs is home to a wide range of year-round events, including **Octoberfest (pictured below)**, **Merchant's Trick-or-Treating** and **Christmas in the Hills** which features a **Journey of Lights Parade**.

KIDNEY SPRINGS

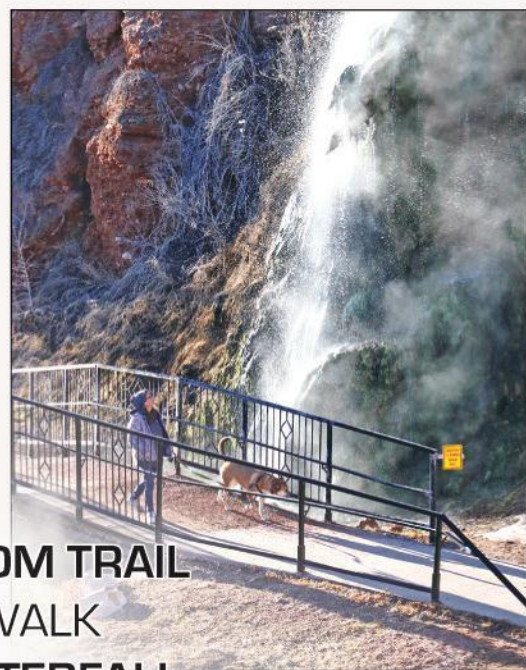

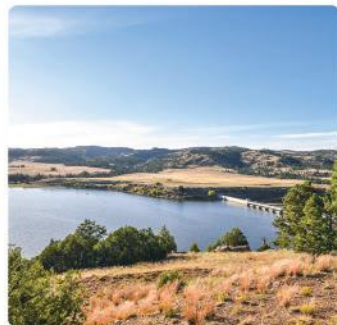

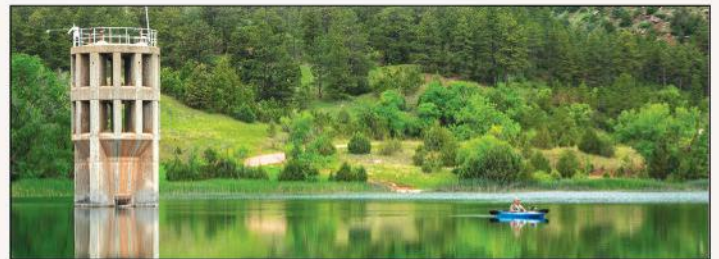

BIKING ON MICKELSON TRAIL



The George S. Mickelson Trail is a 109-mile bike trail that cuts through the heart of the Hills from Edgemont to Deadwood. The Minnekahta Trailhead is located approximately 12 miles west of Hot Springs on U.S. Hwy 18.

COLD BROOK & COTTONWOOD DAMS



Operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, these two man-made bodies of water are both located very close to town. Cold Brook Lake is 3 miles north of Evans Plunge and offers swimming, fishing, camping, playground, basketball and hiking. Cottonwood Lake & Recreation Area is approximately 5 miles west of Hot Springs on Hwy 18, and also offers similar amenities

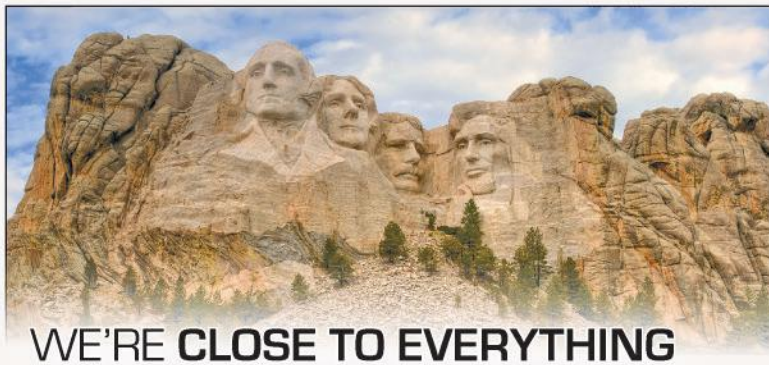

THE MAMMOTH SITE

This is a nonprofit organization dedicated to the mission of preservation, research, and interpretation of the late Ice Age record found at the site in Hot Springs. It is the world's largest mammoth research facility and one of the top fossil interpretive sites in North America, which attracts more than 100,00 visitors annually. Over 60 mammoths (58 Columbian, 3 woolly) have been unearthed, along with at least 87 other Late Ice Age animals. This ancient bone bed was discovered in 1974 and is still being unearthed with annual digs. A must-see educational opportunity for adults and children alike! Your ice age journey begins with a 10 minute high-definition video that sets the stage for your 30-minute guided or self-guided tour. Ask about their Junior Paleontological dig for kids!



WE'RE CLOSE TO EVERYTHING

WORLD FOSSIL FINDER MUSEUM

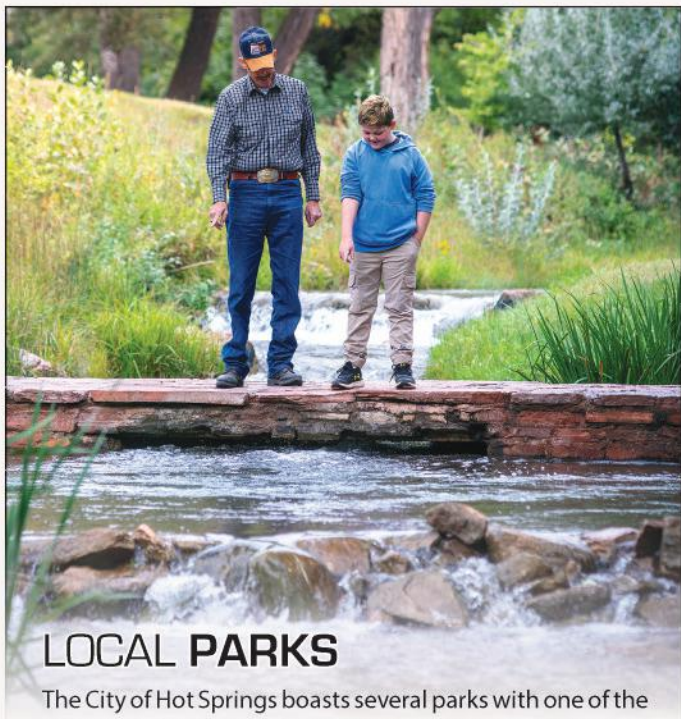


This museum first opened in 2020 and focuses on science, humanity & educating about fossils world-wide. Displays include several first fossil discoveries of both dinosaurs and Ice Age mammals, including "Debby Sue," the largest Tylosaurs ever found in South Dakota (pictured). Last year, the museum unveiled a fully constructed fossilized bison skeleton.

BLACK HILLS WILD HORSE SANCTUARY



Black Hills Wild Horse Sanctuary is a nonprofit organization that provides and maintains a permanent private home for America's unwanted wild Mustangs. The goal of saving the American Wild Mustang also includes the preservation of endangered wild horse bloodlines of the resident mustang bands. The Sanctuary is open for private tours by appointment, and shopping in the Gift Shop. www.wildmustangs.com



LOCAL PARKS

The City of Hot Springs boasts several parks with one of the most popular being Chautauqua Park (pictured) located just to the northwest of Evans Plunge. Another popular one is Butler Park, located on College Hill near the library, which offers playground equipment, a skate park, horse shoes, sand volleyball, picnic areas, pickle ball, basketball courts, baseball and softball fields, as well as disk golf.



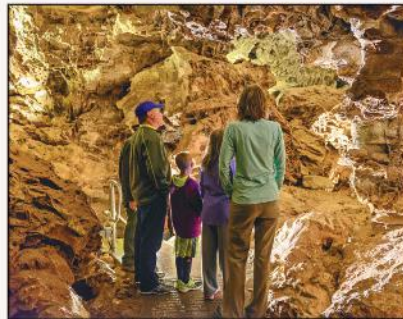
EVANS PLUNGE MINERAL SPRINGS

The Black Hills' oldest attraction, a natural warm mineral water pool built over several warm water springs. Water slides and games, health club and gift shop. Indoor pool is 200 x 50 ft. and up to 5 ft. deep with a volume of 500,000 gallons of water, fed by 13 springs at an average of 87 degrees, year-round.



PIONEER MUSEUM

Originally built as a three-story schoolhouse in the 1890s on a hill in the center of town, this beautiful sandstone structure now contains exceptional artifacts and memorabilia documenting history of Southern Black Hills. This photo above was taken on Nov. 11, 2025, during an unusually spectacular showing of the Northern Lights.



WIND CAVE NATIONAL PARK

Underground, explore Wind Cave, the sixth longest cave in the world, known for its "boxwork" formations. Above ground, wildlife like buffalo, prairie dogs, pronghorn, deer, coyotes and more roam free on the preserved American prairie landscape. Camping and hiking available.

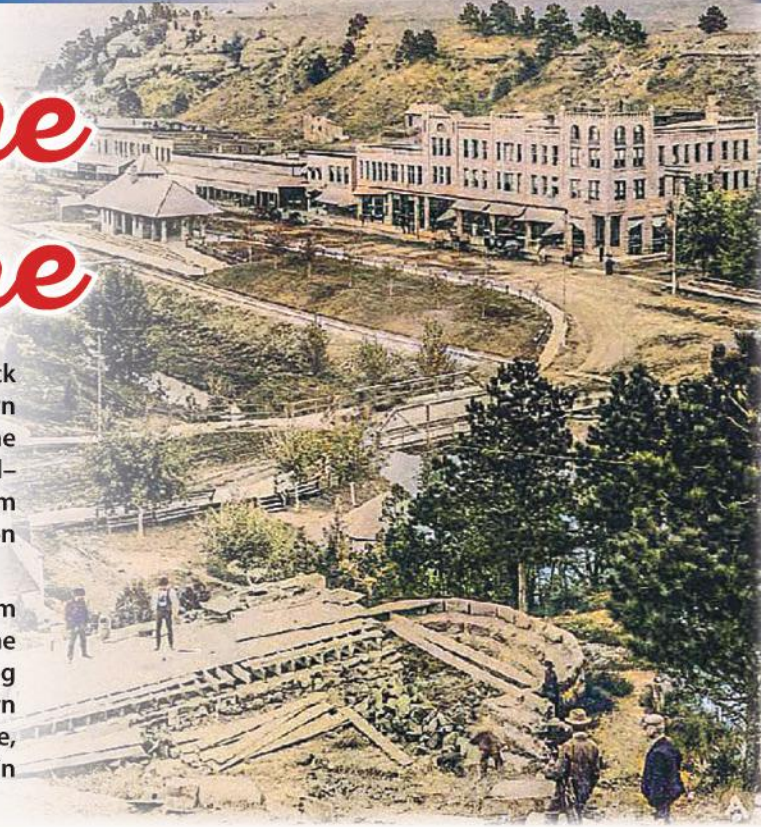

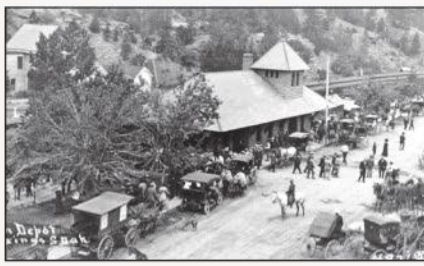
Soak in the Architecture



The primary founders of Hot Springs had come to the Black Hills of Dakota during the gold rush of the late 1870's. The town was developed as a warm-water resort at the southern end of the Black Hills in an area containing about 75 warm-water, mineral-rich springs. With the pursuit of health and enjoying the warm mineral springs in mind, Hot Springs was unique in the region and attracted visitors from around the globe.

Sandstone was the bulding block of Hot Springs and from 1886 to the mid 1930s, there were 27 sandstone quarries in the area. Sandstone, which comes in a variety of colors including white, pink and tan, was shipped from here to six Midwestern states, with many important buildings built from the local stone, including the Omaha Public Library in Nebraska and the Franklin Hotel in Deadwood.

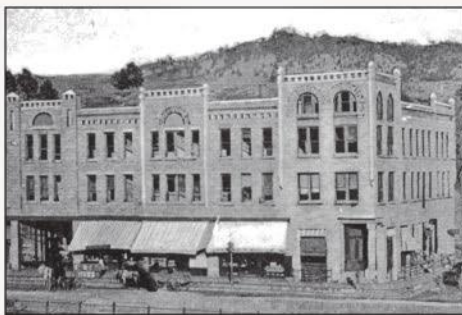
UNION DEPOT VISITORS CENTER



An original railroad train depot built in 1891 and made of sandstone, it is located at 630 N. River Street, and is now where you'll find all the information you need on the Hot Springs area or the Black Hills by stopping in! Free Wi-Fi for visitors. Operated by Hot Springs Chamber of Commerce through tourist season.



MINNEKAHTA BLOCK



Built by Fred Evans in 1891, the Minnekahta Block is the largest and one of the most ornate commercial buildings in Hot Springs. Some of the first businesses to occupy the space included a dry goods store, the Minnekahta State Bank, an opera house, the Times-Herald newspaper, attorneys offices as well as a meat market. Today, it is home to the Red Rock River Resort.

EVANS HOTEL



Originally built in 1892, The Evans was purportedly an imitation of the King David Hotel in Jerusalem. In 1979, a fire gutted the entire structure, which was within five months of being completed for elderly housing. The Evans, or Century House, was and is, the most significant building in Hot Springs. It conveyed the essence of the early resident's aspirations for the city and symbolized the community's efforts to revitalize the downtown. For safety reasons, the fifth floor was removed after the fire.

The Chamber's Union Depot (pictured on left) is your home for visitor information throughout the summer season. If you're interested in taking an online tour to learn more about Hot Springs' historic sandstone architecture, the website SoakInHotSprings.com features information on nearly 40 of the town's sandstone buildings as well as details about how the sandstone was quarried and cut.

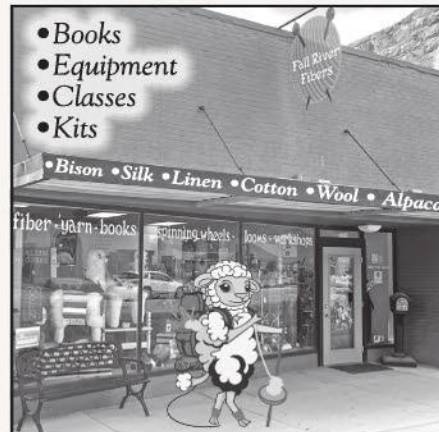

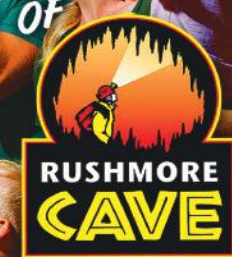

Sandstone was the building block of Hot Springs and from 1886 to the mid 1930s, there were 27 sandstone quarries in the area. Sandstone, which comes in a variety of colors including white, pink and tan, was shipped from here to six Midwestern states, with many important buildings built from the local stone, including the Omaha Public Library in Nebraska and the Franklin Hotel in Deadwood.



The **Mammoth Site** was discovered by Phil Anderson in 1974 when the area was being developed for housing. He then sold all the lands at his cost to the newly formed Non-Profit for scientific study and public education. It is now 1 of only 2 accredited museums in the Black Hills, and 1 of only 5 in the state of South Dakota.

Now 18 holes, **Southern Hills Golf Course** was once named the "Best 9-hole Golf Course in North America" by Golf Digest magazine. It expanded to 18 holes in 2005 and, at just under 6,000 yards, it is still considered one of the best places to play golf in all of South Dakota.



The **Pioneer Museum** located on a hill in the center of town was built in 1893 and served as an elementary school until 1961 before being repurposed into the museum. Built of local sandstone, teamsters unloaded rock from railroad cars and hauled it up the hill.



Angostura Reservoir was created on the Cheyenne River when the dam was built from 1946 to 1949. While the dam's main purpose is to store water for the irrigation of more than 12,000 acres of ag lands, it has become one of the most popular lakes in the Black Hills for recreational purposes as well.



Founded in 1988 by Dayton O. Hyde, the **Black Hills Wild Horse Sanctuary** is one of America's greatest private wilderness areas on 10,000 acres located along the Cheyenne River south of Hot Springs. It features around 550 wild horses, as well as about 50 cattle, which all shared the land with wild turkeys and deer.



The 13 geothermal springs which feed **Evans Plunge Mineral Springs** keep the water in the pool at 87 degrees Fahrenheit (31 degrees Celsius). The main pool is 200-foot x 50-foot with a depth of up to 5 feet. It is a fresh pool every 90 minutes, as it recycles itself 16 times per day at a rate of 5,000 gpm.

Moccasin Springs Natural Mineral Spa reopened in 2019 but was originally one of Hot Springs' first bathhouses known as the Black Hills Spa, established in 1881 by Dr. R.D. Jennings. The "Moccasin Springs" name honors what the native people called the pool based on its shape of a moccasin.

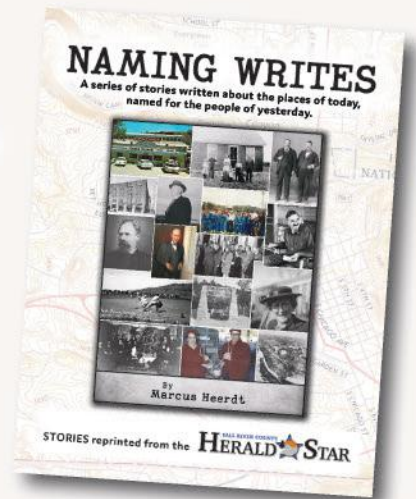

The book features articles that were written for the Fall River County Herald-Star about the Places of Today named for the People of Yesterday.



Did you know?



The **Jensen Highway** that links Hot Springs to State Highway 79 at Maverick Junction was named for former South Dakota Governor Leslie Jensen. He was the 15th governor of the state and served in both WWI and WWII.



The Mueller Civic Center is named after **John Mueller, Sr.**, who immigrated to America in the 1880s. He eventually made his way to Hot Springs in 1886 and was most well known for being an outstanding musician and bandmaster.

Fred T. Evans began construction on Evans Plunge (then known as the Plunge Bath) in 1890. At the time it was "the world's largest enclosed natural warm-water swimming pool." It officially opened in May 1891. Today it is owned by the City of Hot Springs.



Hot Springs' Butler Park is named after **F.O. Butler**, a Chicago native who owned a large paper company. The park was once home to a track that hosted horse, motorcycle, and auto races. Today it is owned by the City of Hot Springs and features baseball fields, basketball and tennis courts, playground and skate park.



Badger Clark Road is named after **Charles Badger Clark, Jr.**, who was South Dakota's first Poet Laureate. The famous cowboy poet, known for "A Cowboy's Prayer," always considered Hot Springs his hometown and he is buried in Evergreen Cemetery.



Jennings Avenue that runs through town is named after the Jennings family, the fifth family to settle in what is now Hot Springs. Dr. R.D. Jennings traveled to the southern Black Hills in 1881 and obtained the title to a warm spring in the valley. There he operated the town's first bath house, which is now the present location of Moccasin Springs Natural Mineral Spa.

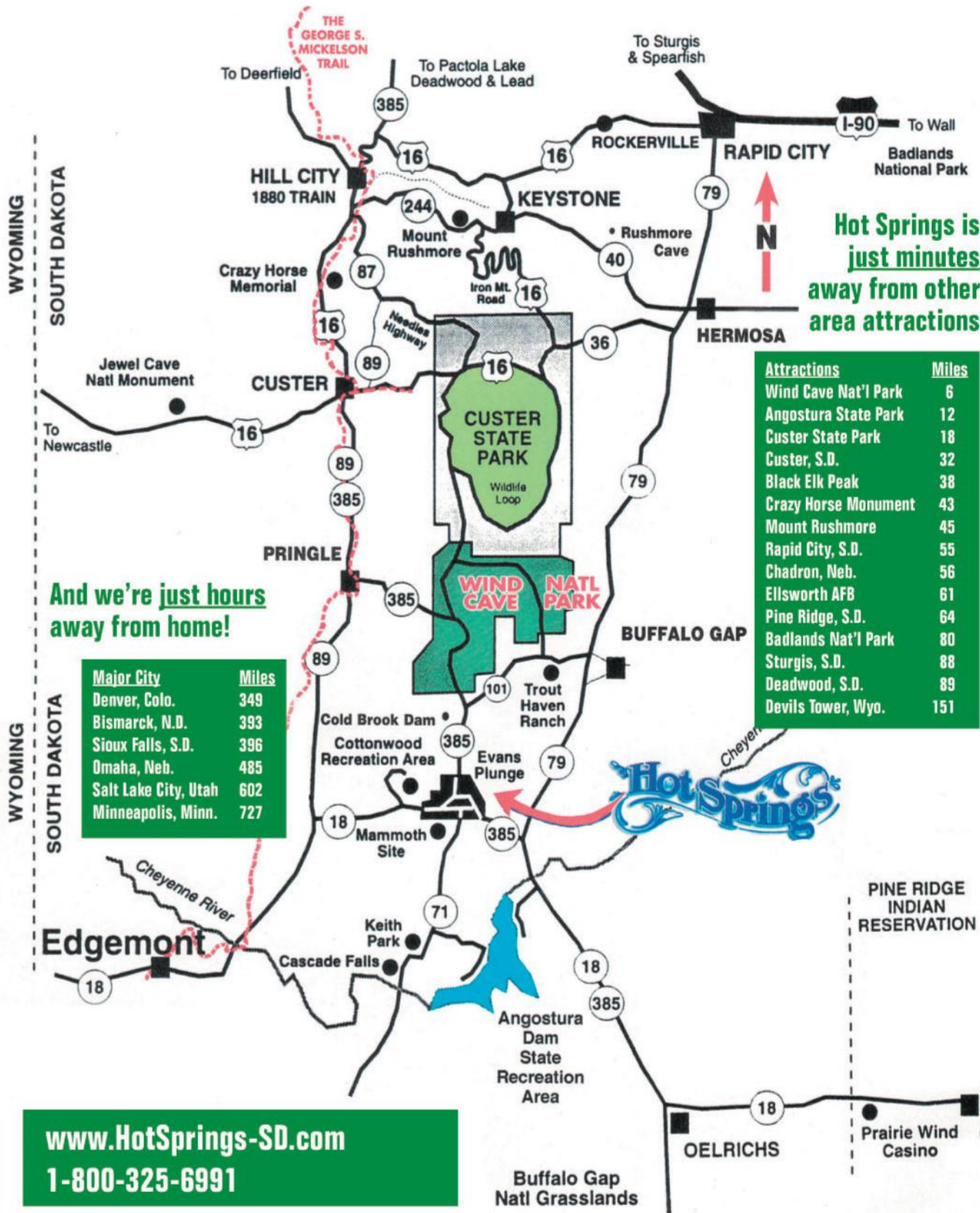
