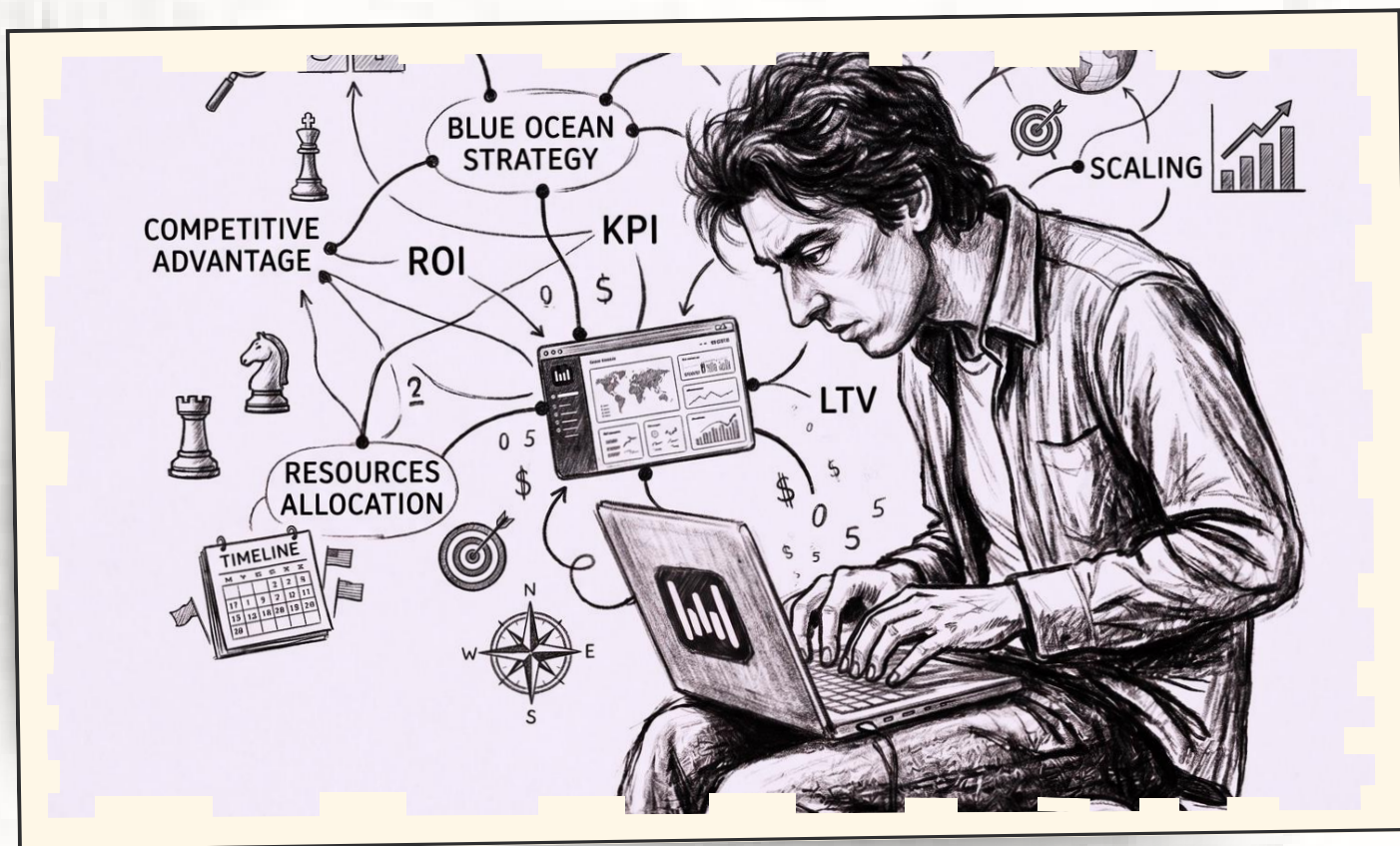

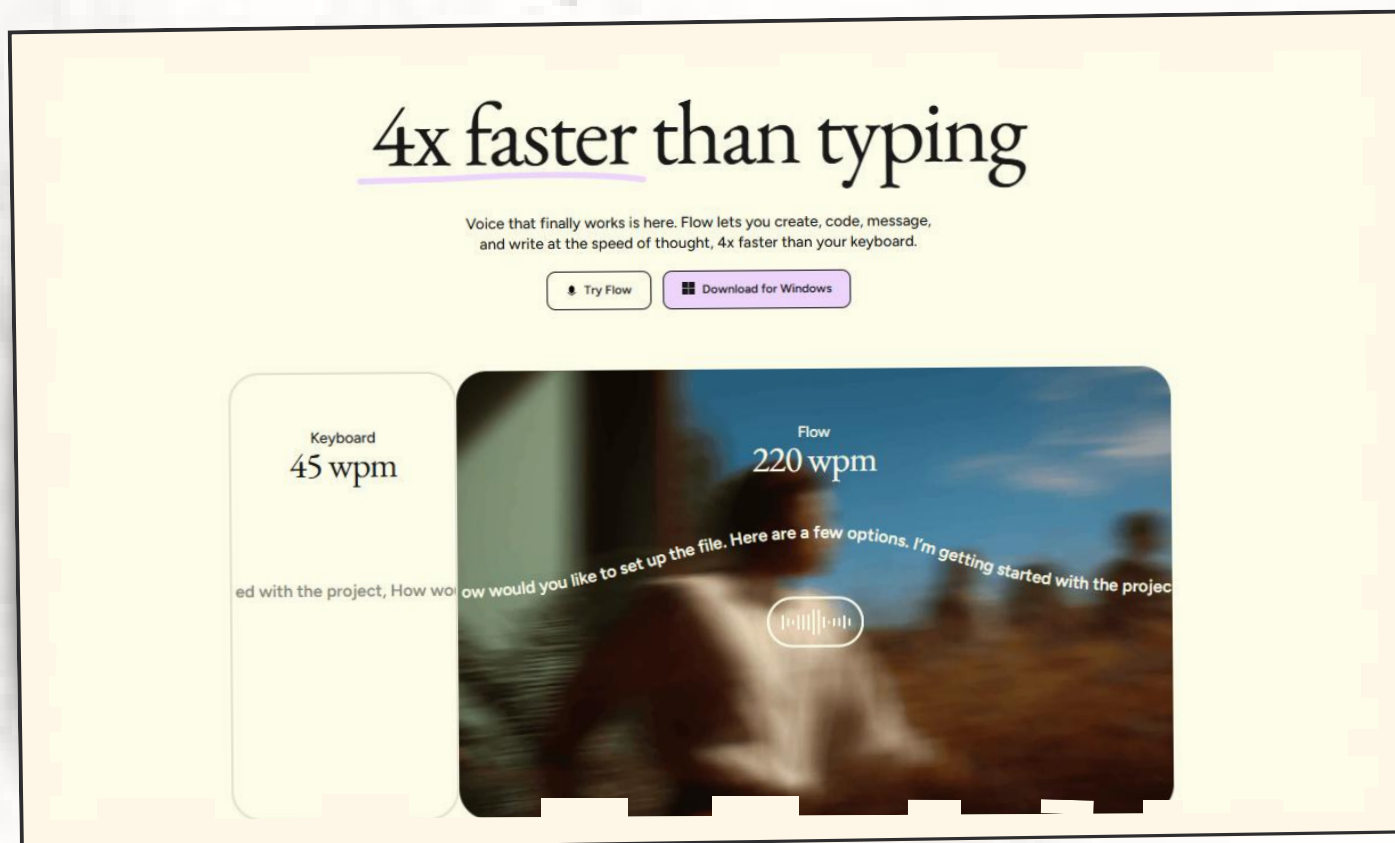
- Say your strategy out loud

- The problem: You can type your way around weak thinking



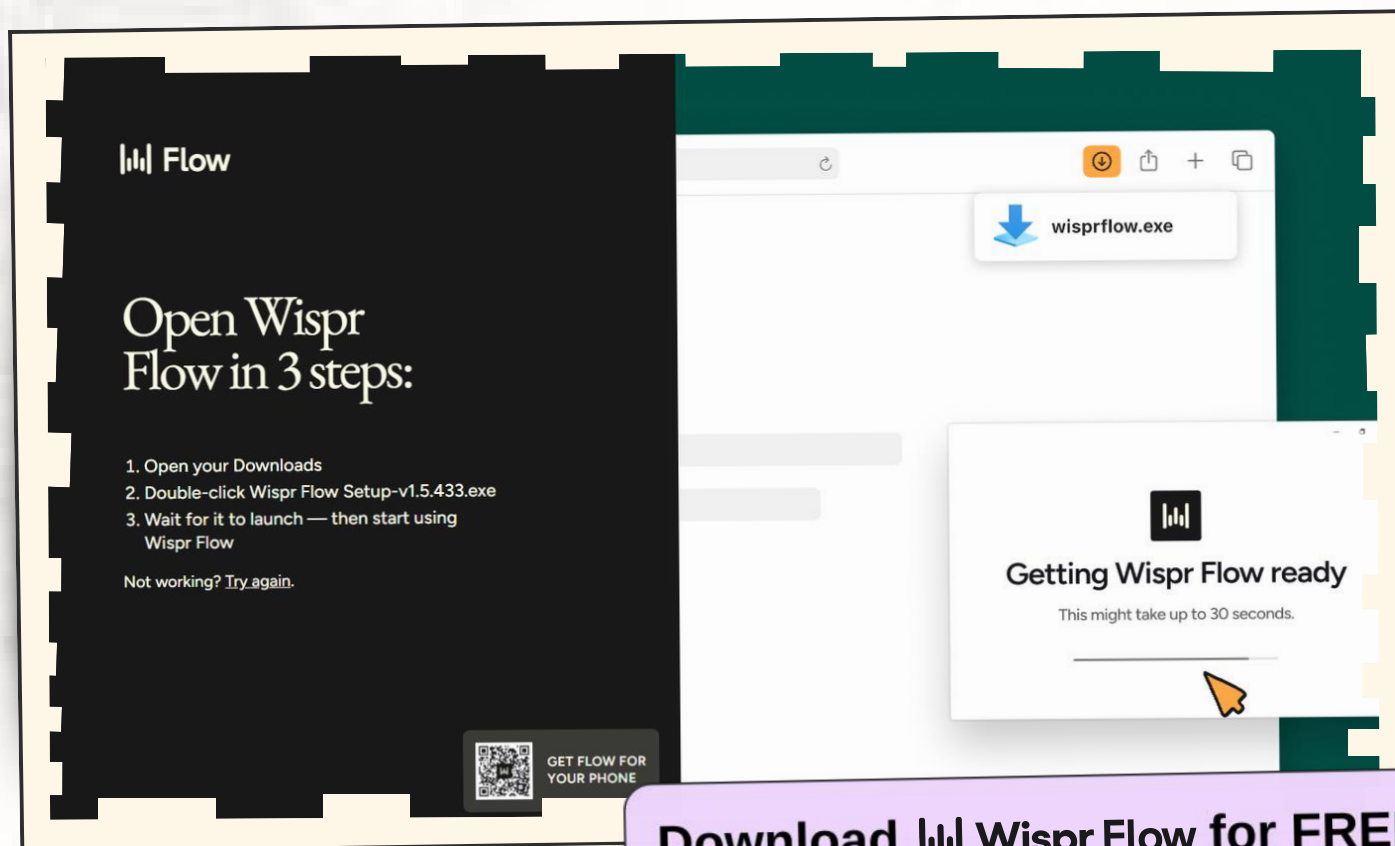
Speaking **exposes it immediately**,

- Complete the setup (Hotkey/style) to start using it next step



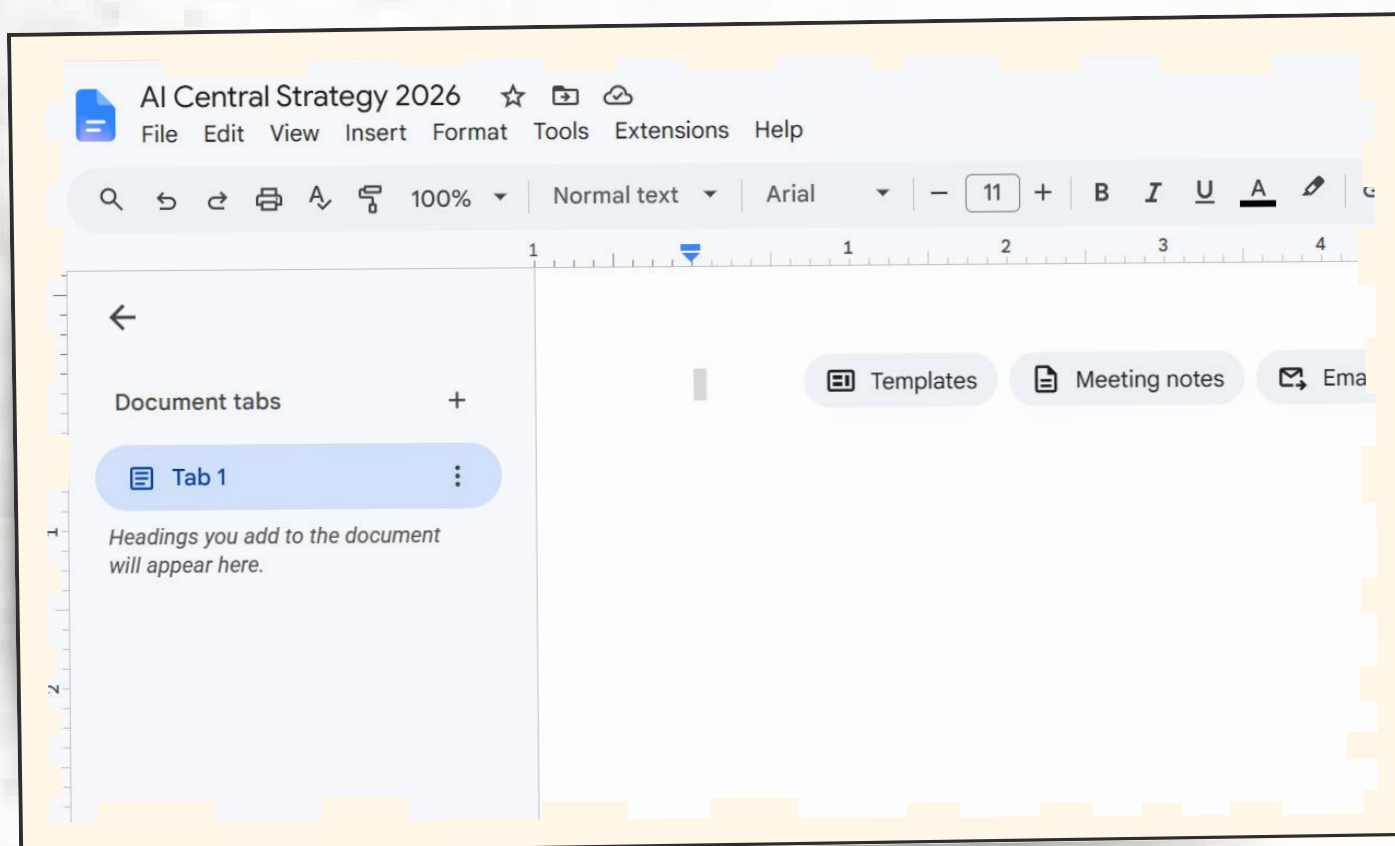

Open a blank doc

- Strategy memo, board update, decision rationale
- Any document that needs clear thinking



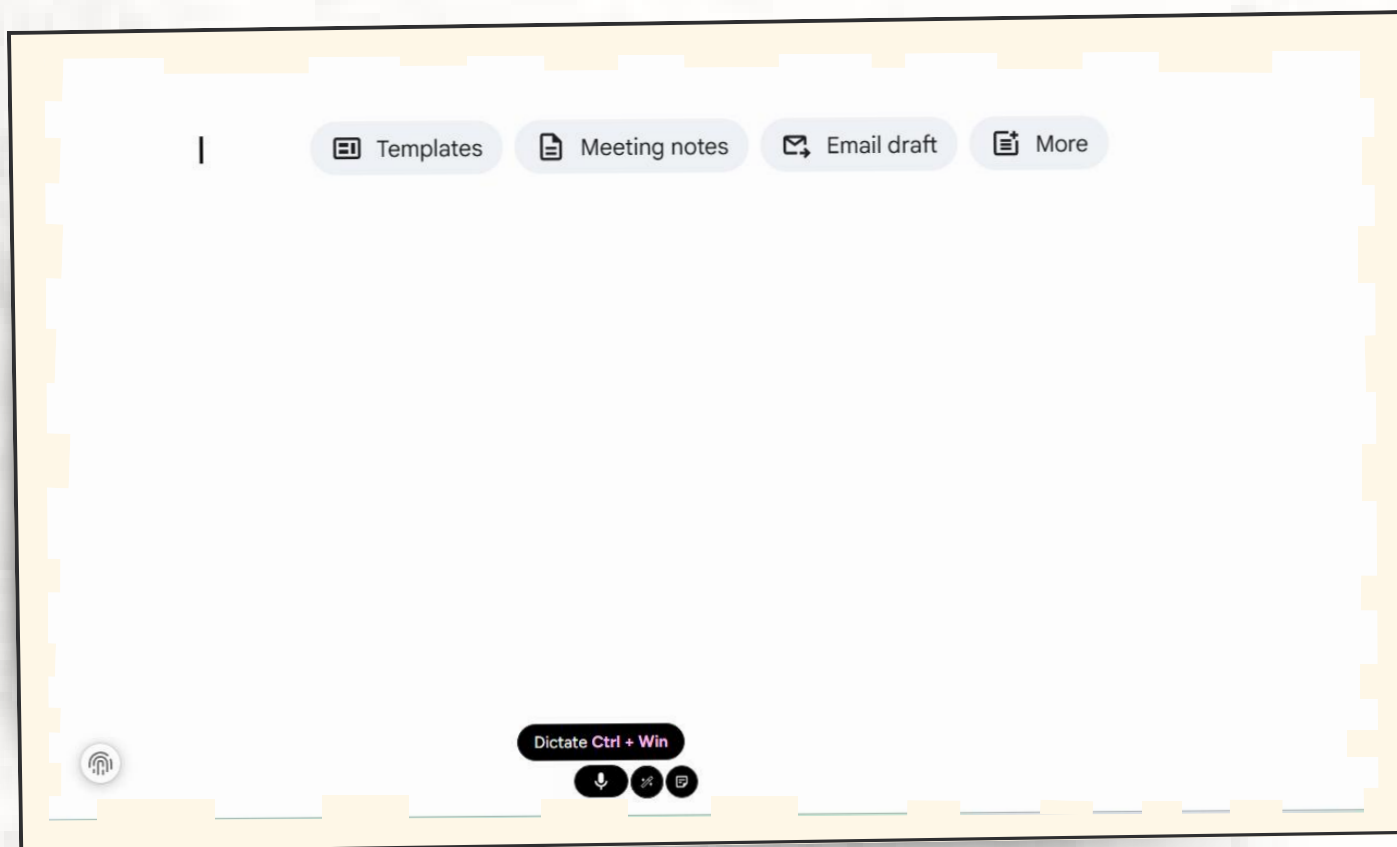
No outline, no structure, just a blank page





Press your hotkey and speak

- Speak like you're explaining it to a colleague
- Wispr Flow captures it all, 150+ WPM, no typing





The messy first draft appears

- Full paragraphs, complete thoughts, raw logic
- It will be real, that's the point



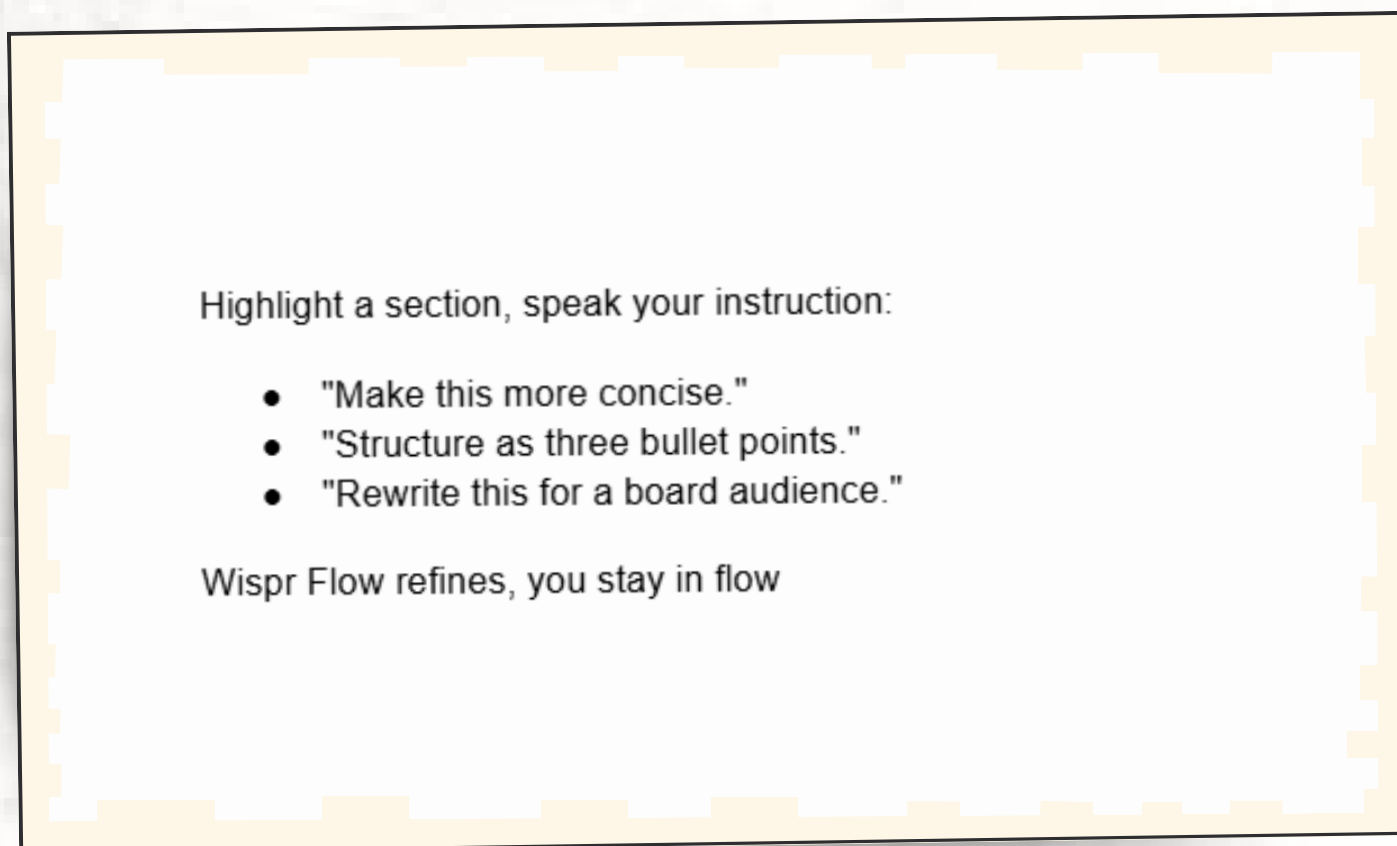
Wispr Flow removes the communication limit





Use the command mode to tighten

- Highlight a section, speak your instruction:
 - "Make this more concise."
 - "Structure as three bullet points."
 - "Rewrite this for a board audience."



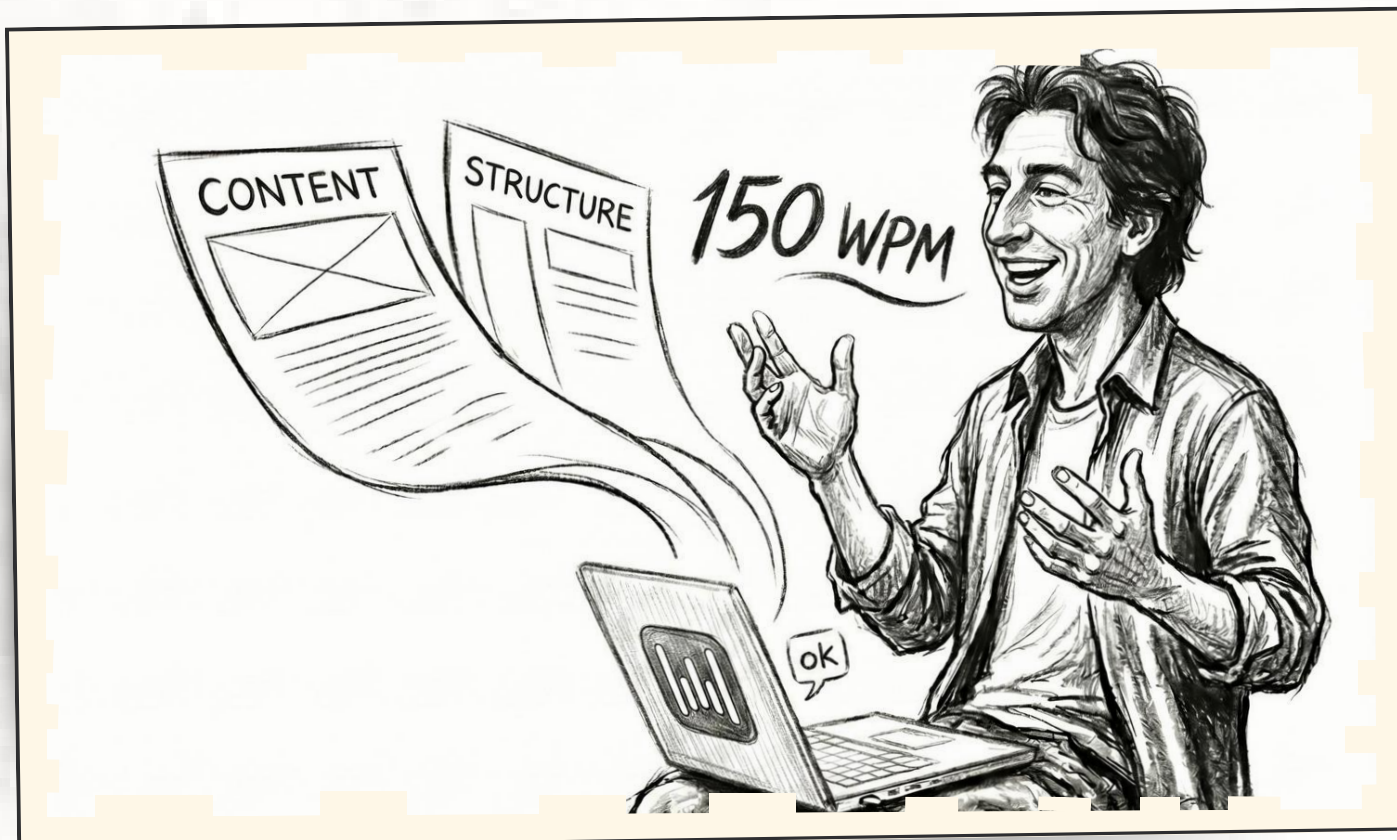
Wispr Flow refines, you stay in flow

- Wispr Flow keeps up at 150+ WPM





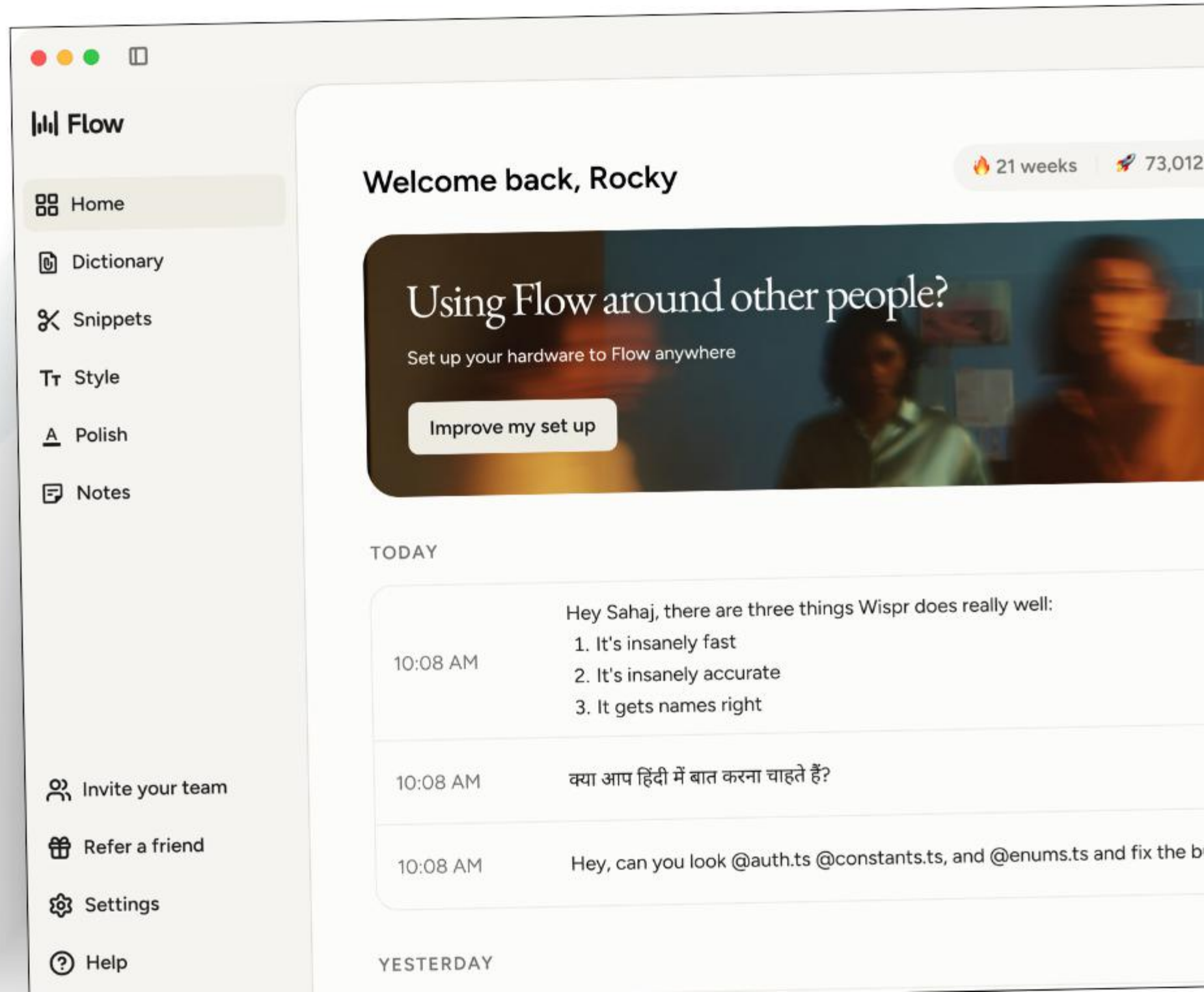
The compounding edge (from a real power user):

- When input speed doubles, iteration speed doubles
