## Digraph Fun

- Digraphs with ng can be in the middle and end of a word.
- Here are some words with ng digraphs: finger, king, and lung.
- With digraphs, there are fewer sounds than letters. For example, bang has four letters but only three sounds /b/ /a/ /ng/. The ng is the digraph.

**Decodable Words** can be sounded out based on the letter-sound relationships.

**High-Frequency Words** are the most commonly used words. Your reader will begin to recognize them.
