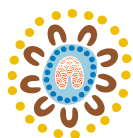

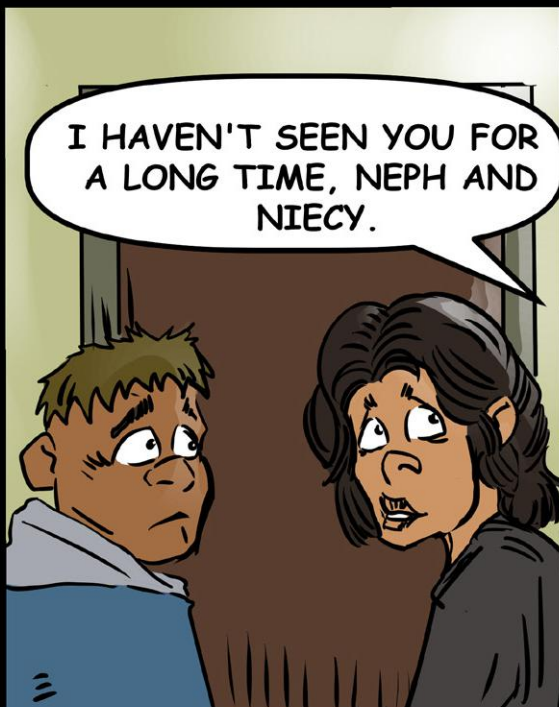

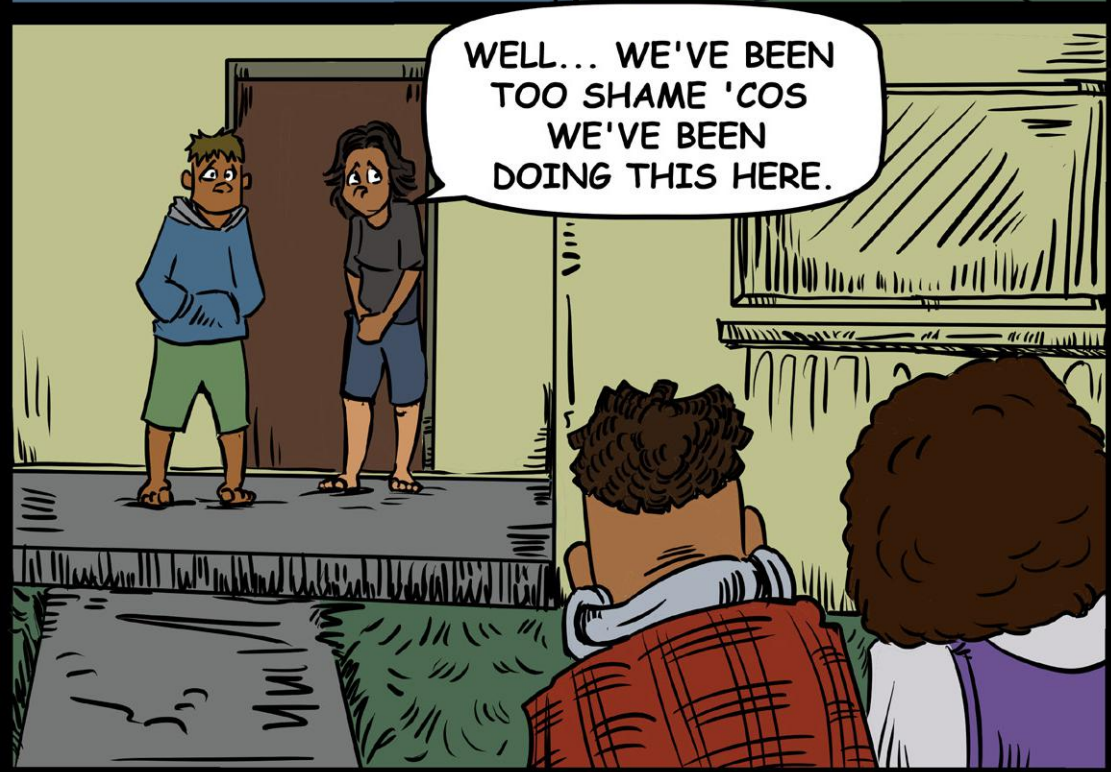

# hepatitiswa

HepatitisWA provides a Needle and Syringe Program (NSP) that distributes clean injecting equipment and harm reduction information and resources to those in the community who choose to inject drugs.

Services are located at:

- 1 fixed site in Northbridge.

The WAAC Needle and Syringe Exchange Program (NSEP) provides services to people who inject drugs across Perth via one-to-one exchange or for low cost.

Services are located at:

- 2 fixed sites in West Perth and Fremantle.
- 7 mobile van sites in Rockingham, Mirrabooka, Joondalup, Belmont, Midland, Armadale, and Gosnells.
- Via postal service.

Peer Based Harm Reduction WA operates a Needle and Syringe Exchange Program where you can get freshies, yarn about safer using, and see the nurse whenever you need testing or treatment. You can exchange used equipment for new equipment, or get enough free freshies to help you stay safe.

Services are located at:

- 2 fixed sites in Perth and Bunbury.
- 3 mobile van sites in Busselton, Manjimup, and Margaret River.
- Via discreet, free outreach (home-delivery) service anywhere in the Perth metro area or South West region.
- Via free statewide postal service anywhere in WA.

The Derbarl Yerrigan Needle and Syringe Program (NSP) provides sterile equipment, safe disposal containers, and education to promote safer injecting practices.
