before we’re done!”**

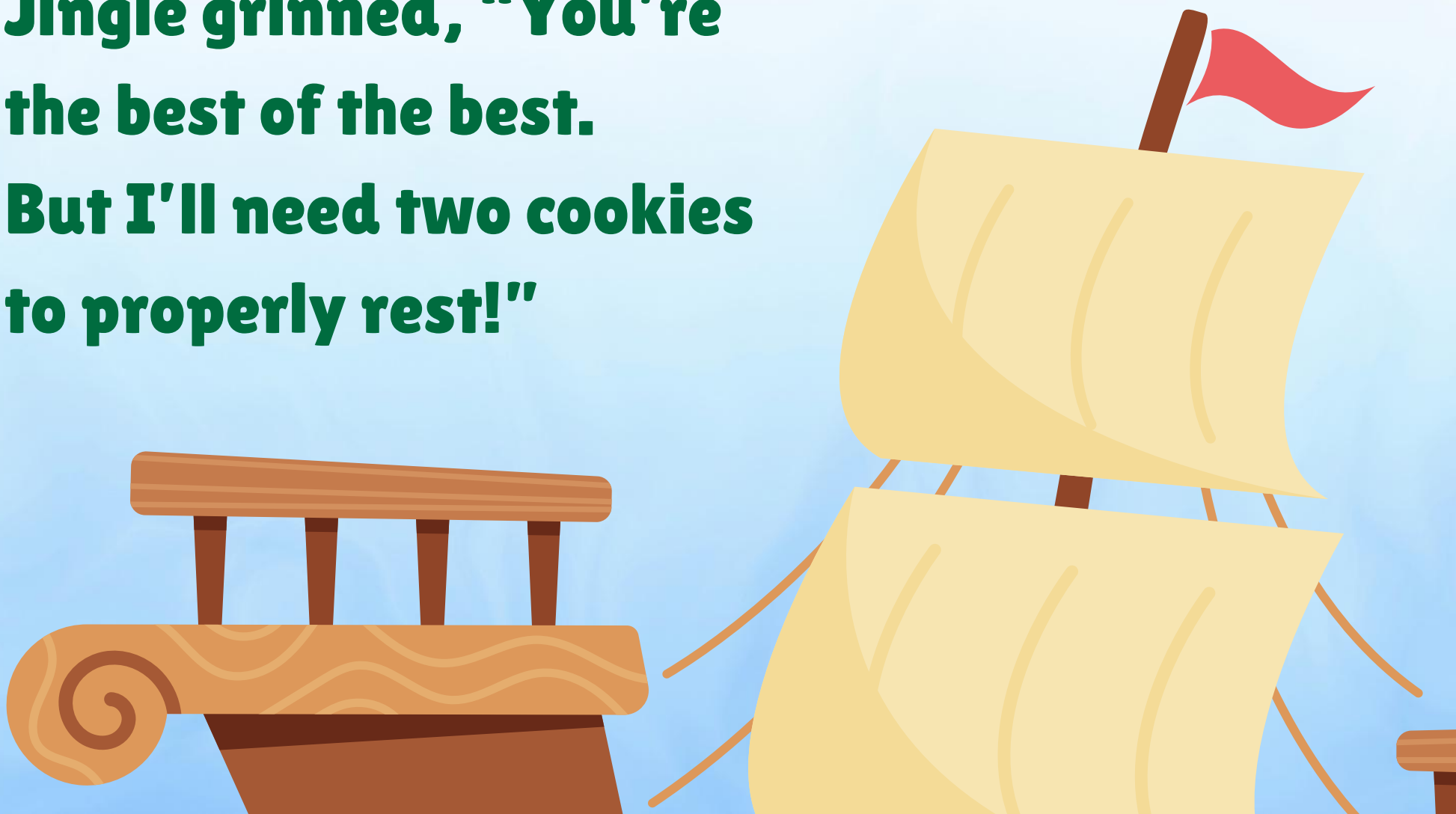


When the gifts were all gone and the night grew still,
