OUR RESORT HISTORY

The Mission district of Mackinac Island has deep roots in hospitality and the concept of bringing people together to learn and grow.

In the early 1820's, Reverend William Ferry, a Protestant missionary, used this area to house and teach Native American children. He also established Mission Church, which was one of the first protestant churches in the Midwest. The southeast end of Mackinac Island thus became known as Mission Point.

During the 1940's, an organization called the Moral Re-Armament (MRA) was looking for a world headquarters and became involved on the island upon the invitation of the Governor of Michigan at the time. The MRA was a multi-national group who promoted the philosophy of love, unselfishness, purity and honesty in a worldwide evangelistic campaign. They settled on Mackinac Island and groundbreaking ceremonies began in 1954.

Construction on what are now called the Main Lodge and Straits Lodge began in the fall of 1955 with fifty-foot trusses of Norway White Pine from nearby Bois Blanc Island supporting the roof and 45 tons of native stone forming the original building. The Main Lobby's rotunda-style architecture remains one of the most distinctive structures on the island to this day—nine majestic trusses converge at the height of 51 feet and resemble a 16-sided teepee. This structure fulfils the prophecy that says:

Someday on the east side of the island a great teepee will be erected. All nations will come there and learn about peace.

A movie production Sound Stage was constructed in 1958 and at the time was the second largest of its type in the world; the MRA used this space to produce movies and short films. In 1966, the MRA relocated their operation to Switzerland and deeded much of the property to an organization known as Mackinac College. This education institute operated for four years, graduated one class and then closed in 1970.

Throughout the 1970's and 80's, the Mission Point property changed hands a few times and during this era, was established as a hotel resort. One of the most notable events at Mission Point occurred in 1979, when Universal Studios leased the Sound Stage mentioned earlier to produce the movie "Somewhere in Time" starring Christopher Reeve and Jayne Seymour. Most of the sets were built and utilized in the Sound Stage and the production team used the Theater for filming. The entire cast and crew were hosted at Mission Point, which was at that time was called the Inn on Mackinac.

In 1987, Detroit businessman John Shufelt purchased the property and gave it the official name of Mission Point Resort, paying homage to our historical location. Through the Shufelts' ownership, Mission Point gained the reputation as the "friendly and casual" hotel and resort option on Mackinac Island.

The current chapter of Mission Point Resort's history book began in 2014, when Dennert and Suzanne Ware purchased the property; they had an immediate plan of multi-million-dollar upgrades while also preserving the important historical nature of the hotel. Since their ownership, Mission Point has added Lakeside Spa & Salon, renovated all 241 guest rooms & suites, refurbished the Conference Center, built the Promenade Deck outdoor pavilion event space and done many more behind-the-scenes improvements to infrastructure, fire safety and overall guest experience. The goal of Mission Point is to provide extraordinary Mackinac Island experiences and with the investments that the Ware family has made, the hotel has seen continued success.








Terms and Conditions | Our Conference Services team will work closely with you to determine the type of systems you will need. All audio visual equipment must be handled through Mission Point's A/V department. Personally owned laptops and projectors are allowed with prior authorization from your Conference Manager. Hotel is not responsible or liable for personal audio visual equipment. Equipment may be cancelled without charge 48 hours prior to installation. No allowances made for equipment that is ordered and delivered but not used. For liability and safety, the hotel requires that all power be supplied by and coordinated through your Conference Manager, and that all equipment requiring a technician must be operated by an approved technician.

All rental prices are per day; no partial day rentals. Includes setup, tear down, and on-site support.

A customary 22% service charge and 6% Michigan sales tax applies to all charges.

BILLING & PAYMENTS

Transparency is important to us throughout every stage of your event planning process. Below you'll find billing and payment information for group events at Mission Point. Should you have any questions, please let your Group Sales Specialist and Conference Services Manager know as they would be happy to discuss.

THERE ARE TWO METHODS OF EVENT PAYMENT AT MISSION POINT: DIRECT BILL OR PRE-PAYMENT.

DIRECT BILL

Mission Point requires credit approval for a group to be billed directly. Should the group have received prior credit approval, hosted and paid for its meeting or event in a timely manner within 2 years of the upcoming meeting, credit approval will be waived unless there is a 30% or more increase in the credit request. If not, the group's Sales Specialist will provide the credit application upon execution of the contract.

The credit application process is done within the year the meeting is to be held. If the meeting is for a future year, the Conference Services Manager will communicate the need to complete the credit application in January of the year the meeting is being held. The credit application must be submitted to Mission Point no later than 45 days prior to the event. Once the completed application is received by Mission Point, the credit approval process typically takes 10 business days. Upon completion of the approval, the Conference Services Manager will notify the group of its credit.

If approved, your group will move forward with Direct Bill; however, should the application be denied, your group will need to pre-pay for the event.

Direct Bill—Approved

If your credit application is approved, you will be directly billed for your event. Working with your Conferences Services Manager, please provide final food and beverage guarantees 21 days in advance of arrival. Your group's final bill will be provided within 5 business days post-event and payment is required within 30 days of the event ending.

The preferred and most efficient method of payment is wire transfer; however, credit cards and checks are accepted. Regardless of type, payment must be received 30 days post event. Should the account not be satisfied within 30 days, it will accrue interest at 1.5% per month (18% per annum). If needed to secure payment, your group has agreed to pay Mission Point all expenses incurred in attempting to collect the balance owed including, but not limited to, all legal expenses and attorney's fees.

Direct Bill—Not Approved

If your credit application is not approved, you will be asked to pre-pay for your event; payments must be made 14 days prior to arrival. Working with your Conferences Services Manager, please provide final food and beverage guarantees 21 days in advance of arrival. Within 1 business day of final guarantees, Mission Point's accounting department will provide the group an invoice based on the master account.

Should payment not be received 14 days prior to arrival, Mission Point does retain the option to terminate the contract and the group will remain liable for amounts outlined in projected Master Bill.

We understand that in some cases during post-event reconciliation, there may be additions or credits to the final account for the group. Final post-event reconciliations and a final invoice will be provided to your group within 5 business days of departure. Any credits will be provided back to your group within 5 business days and any outstanding invoices will be due to Mission Point in 30 business days.

The preferred and most efficient method of payment is wire transfer; however, credit cards and checks are accepted. Regardless of type, payment must be received 30 days post event. Should the account not be satisfied within 30 days, it will accrue interest at 1.5% per month (18% per annum). If needed to secure payment, your group has agreed to pay Mission Point all expenses incurred in attempting to collect the balance owed including, but not limited to, all legal expenses and attorney's fees.

PRE-PAYMENT FOR EVENT

Your group also has the option to pre-pay for the event, without having to go through the credit application process. Payment of your projected master account is required 14 days prior to arrival. Working with its Mission Point conferences services manager, the group will provide final Working with your Conferences Services Manager, please provide final food and beverage guarantees 21 days in advance of arrival. Within 1 business day of final guarantees, Mission Point's accounting department will provide the group an invoice based on the master account. The preferred and most efficient method of payment is wire transfer; however, credit cards and checks are accepted. Regardless of type, payment must be received 30 days post event.

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FARM-TO-FERRY DINING

Mission Point Resort is home to designed culinary adventures across our 18 acre property with a robust banquet program and unique dining options for group meals. Dining at Mission Point is a farm-to-ferry experience as our culinary team sources a variety of ingredients from local farms and purveyors.

We are often asked, "How does Mission Point get fresh produce?" Our location on an island in the Straits of Mackinac does present some unique logistical challenges in securing regular deliveries of goods and resources to the resort, which must be delivered either by ferry or flight before

a horse-drawn dray delivery. But with a lot of planning and communication between mainland farms, transportation providers and our culinary team, fresh produce, dairy, and other products make their way from farm to ferry and onto guests' plates within a matter of days from being picked.

With options from plated to buffet to grab-and-go, there are choices for any event style as you have the opportunity to enjoy breakfasts and brunches, mid-day breaks, plated dinners, boxed lunches, hors d'oeuvres and more.

We do require a guarantee of the number of persons attending all food and beverage functions at least 21 days prior to your function. If no guarantee is received, MPR will use the number of guests contracted as your guarantee and charges will either reflect the actual number served or the guarantee, whichever is greater. Please contact your Conference Services Manager with any questions on counts, guarantees and menu selections.

PAINTING WITH A VIEW / \$100 PER PERSON

TAXI SHUTTLE SERVICE

Mission Point Resort is located approximately 15 minutes from the ferry docks and guests may walk, bike or take the horse-drawn taxi shuttle to the resort. Run by Mackinac Island Carriage Tours, the shuttle is similar to a taxi service and will take you directly from the ferry dock to Mission Point for a small charge. Please contact your Conference Services Manager for the shuttle schedule.

LUGGAGE PROCESS

When you arrive to the Shepler's Dock on the mainland, your luggage will be tagged for Mission Point Resort and you will receive one claim luggage claim ticket for each piece of luggage you have. Once you reach the island, a Mission Point dockporter will send it to the resort and at check-in, you will give your luggage claim tickets to the bellstand for transportation right to your room.

Upon departure, you will just need to call the bellstand for pickup and they will pick it up from your room. Again, you will receive one luggage claim ticket for each piece of luggage you have. We ask that you call at least 2 hours before your desired ferry departure time.

An important note: once you send your luggage, it can be inaccessible for a bit. Please keep anything you may need, such as medication, in your hand luggage, backpack or pockets.

FERRY SERVICE

Shepler's is the preferred ferry partner at Mission Point Resort and offers daily boats to and from Mackinac Island. Star Line is also available with daily service as well. The boat ride across the Straits of Mackinac is approximately 16 minutes filled with photo opportunities of the Mackinac Bridge, Round Island Lighthouse and Mackinac Island.

ON-ISLAND TRANSPORTATION

It's easier than you think to get to Mackinac Island—just board the ferry and you're on your way. Once on the island, you may take a taxi, ride on the Mackinac Island Carriage Tours shuttle servicing Mission Point, or enjoy the short 15-minute walk.

The Mission Point shuttle is a service offered by Mackinac Island Carriage tours and is a fixed-route shuttle taxi that goes between the ferry docks downtown and Mission Point. This is the easiest way to get to MPR. Please note that the shuttle is not available from 12:30pm–2pm so the team can change horses.

Horse-drawn taxi service is provided by Mackinac Island Carriage tours 24 hours per day during the peak summer season. Something unique about Mackinac Island is that taxis cannot be "hailed" and you must call the taxi dispatch office to schedule your pickup. MACKINAC ISLAND MEDICAL CENTER, POLICE & FIRE DEPARTMENT

Since health issues never take a vacation, the Mackinac Island Medical Center offers 24-hour emergency care for both island residents and visitors. They offer a full range of medical services include emergency room, primary care, x-ray and laboratory.

While cars are banned on Mackinac Island, we do have ambulances, fire trucks and police vehicles. First responders are available 24/7 for any type of emergency and are highly trained. The Fire Station and Police Station are both located on Market Street.

BANKS

There are two banks located on Mackinac Island:

First National Bank of St. Ignace is located on Market Street and **Central Savings Bank** is located on Hoban Street. Both banks have ATMs. There is also an ATM located in the Mission Point Main Lobby.

POST OFFICE

Our post office offers the same services as larger ones although there is no mail delivery on the island—everyone must stop in and pick up the mail from their P.O. Box. The post office is located on Market Street.
