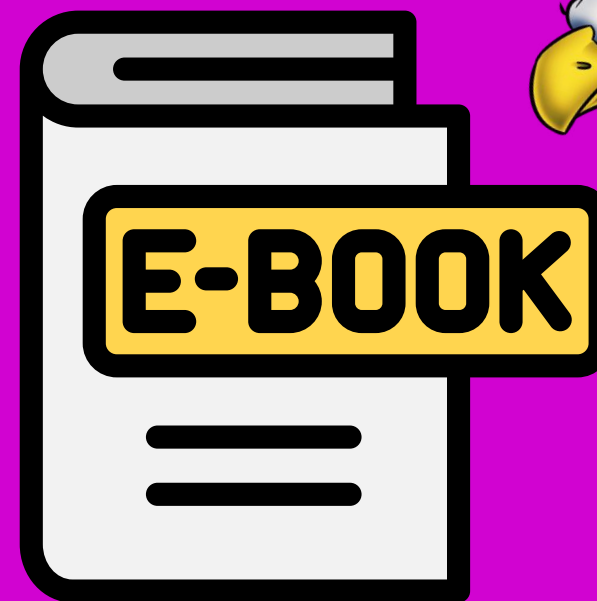
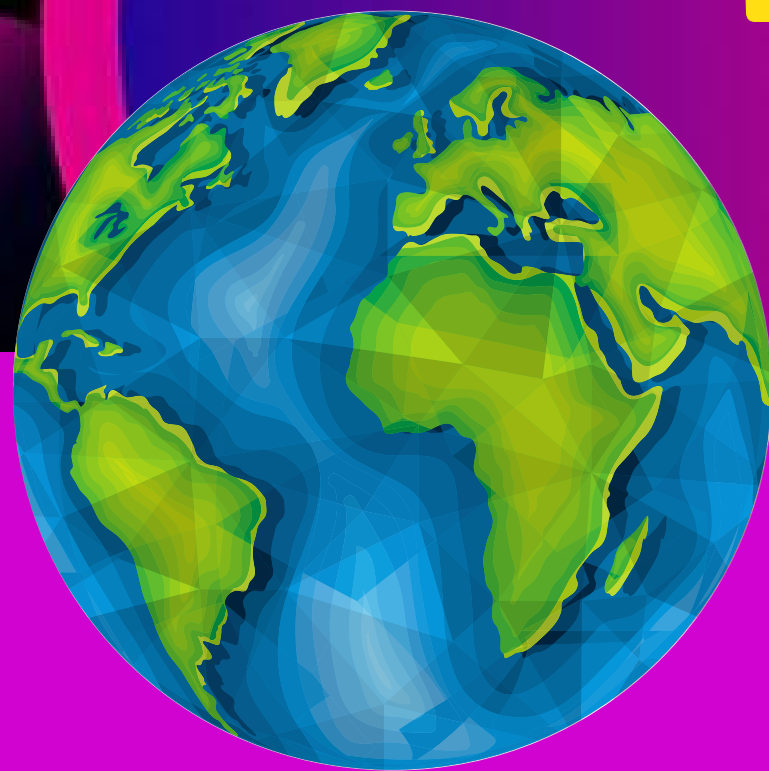

How about you? Do you want to try it? Great!



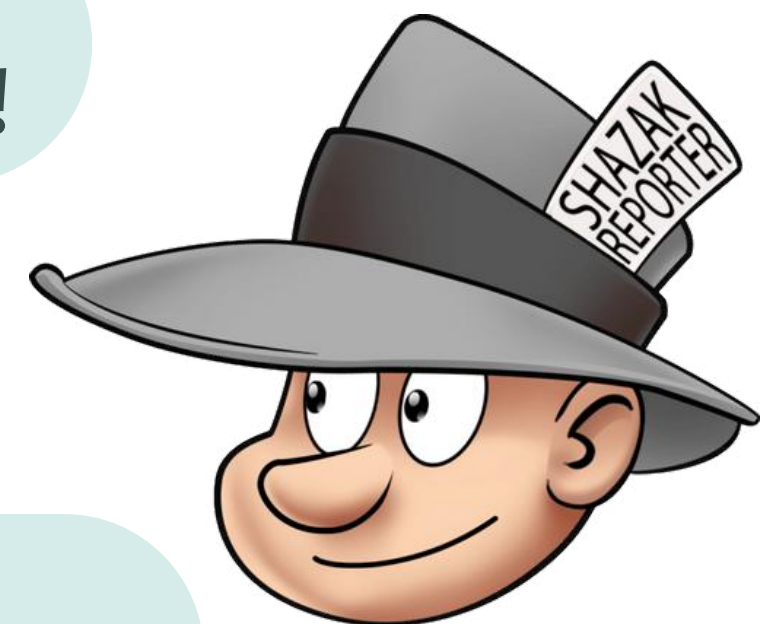
Let's start with two words today, Ha'azinu HaShamayim is what we will say.

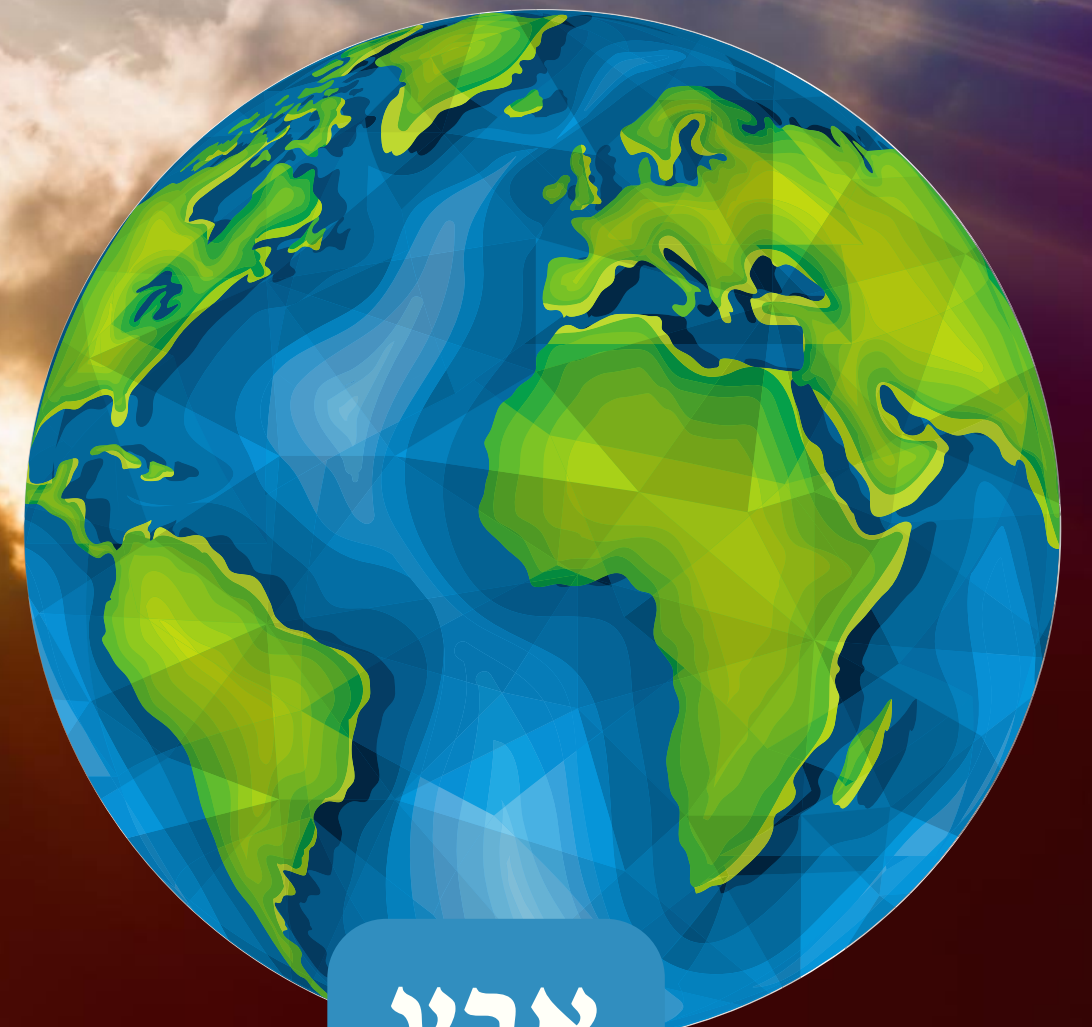
The Heaven and Earth Song

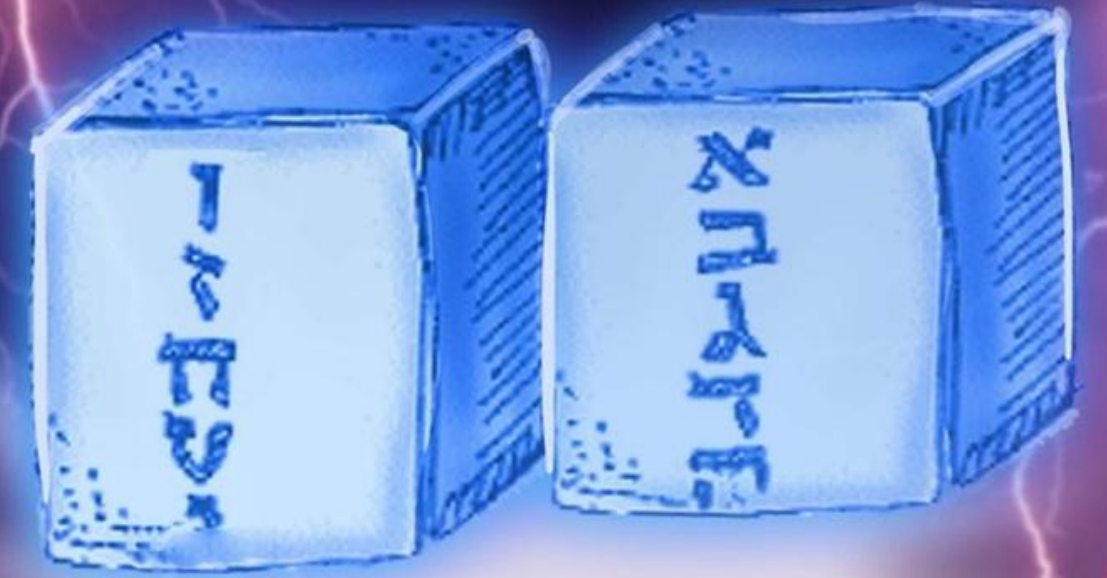

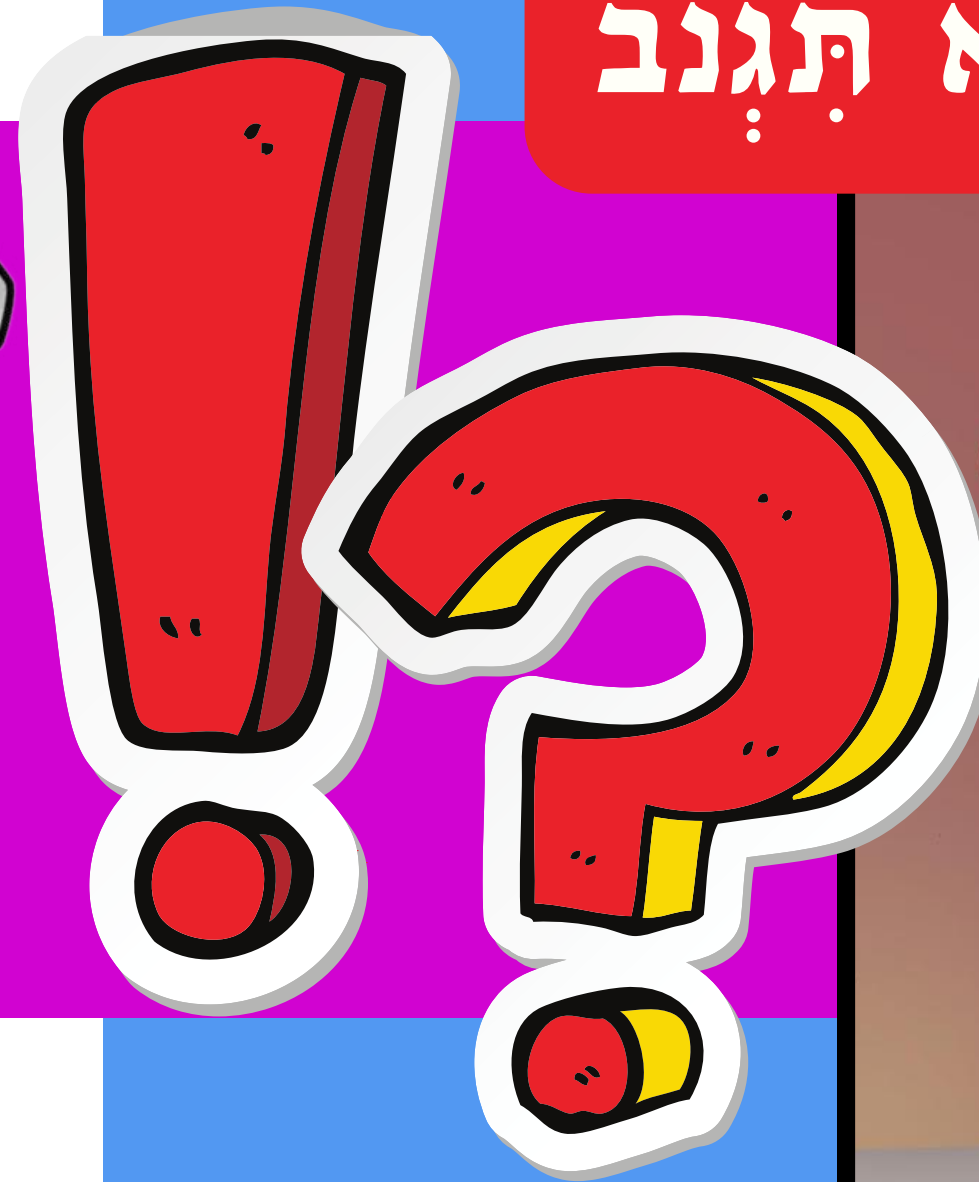
**“Hmmm, maybe yes, maybe no.

“Do you want My Torah?”

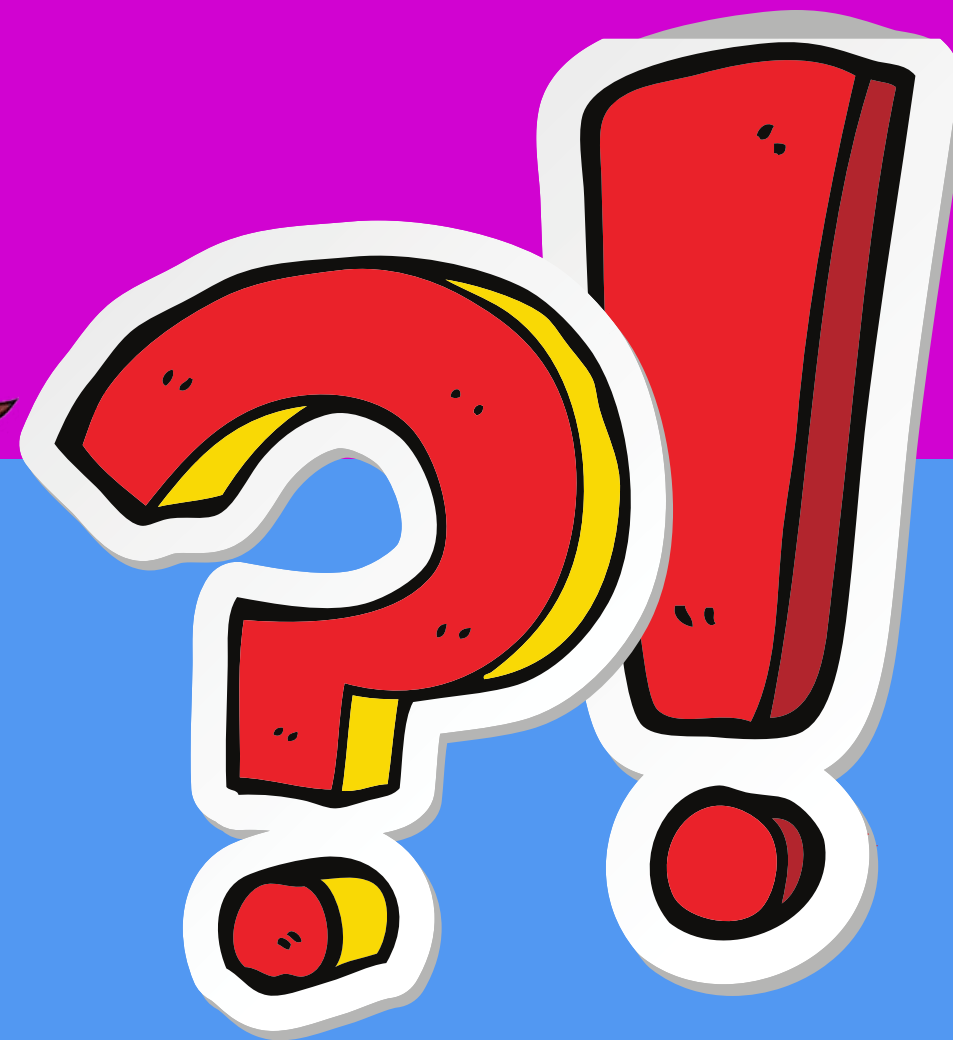
“Maybe yes, maybe no. After all, how do you expect us to accept the Torah if we don't know what it says?”

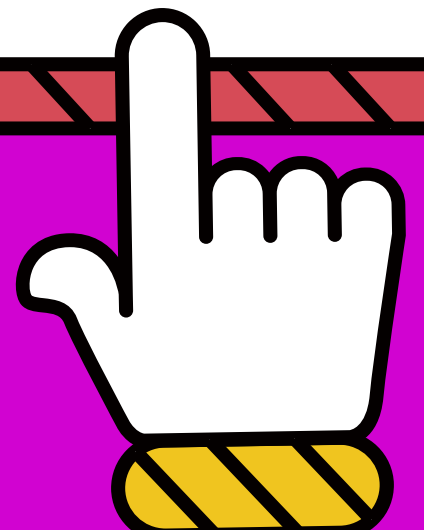
