Vowel Digraphs are two vowels that when placed together generate one sound, e.g. -ee in street. W and Y can act as vowels in vowel digraphs.

Vowel Trigraphs are one vowel and two consonants that when placed together create one sound, e.g. -igh in high.

Diphthongs are two vowels that when placed together create a sound that starts as one vowel sound and ends as another sound, e.g. -oi in coin.
