Day By Day Itinerary

Day 1 • Wednesday • January 20th

Depart this morning from Columbus & fly to Kona, arriving this afternoon. Check-in to the idyllic Westin Hapuna Beach Resort for a 6-night stay and enjoy a delicious Welcome Dinner.

Day 2 • Thursday • January 21st

Following a leisurely morning, join us for a Welcome Wellness Seminar, hosted by Coach Carrie. Here, she will provide insight on what to expect from this week's retreat, as well as local knowledge & suggestions on how to make the most of your stay in paradise! After, the remainder of the day is yours to enjoy as you please.

Day 3 • Friday • January 22nd

Mid-morning, we'll set out to Kailua-Kona. Not too long ago, Kailua-Kona was a sleepy fishing village. Now, because of its central location & great weather, it has transformed into a lively town that is the activity capital of the Big Island. Spend time exploring at your own pace - Visit the shops, walk the pier, & grab lunch! Later this afternoon, partake in your first of two inspiring opportunities with Kona Kids. Established by Carrie McCoy, following her own volunteering experience over a decade ago, Kona Kids aims to foster learning experiences and developmental resources for children of all ages through education, exercise, & leadership development.

Return to the hotel & refresh for tonight's island luau at a neighboring hotel.

Day 4 • Saturday • January 23rd

Today, embark on a day tour of the Waimea region of the island. Known as paniolo (Hawaiian cowboy) country, this historic area full of rolling, green pastures is still home to cattle, cowboys & ranches. Every Saturday, Waimea Town Market at Parker School is home to over 50 vendors who offer a wide variety of terrific produce, food and other unique items. Spend time perusing the stalls and chatting with local vendors, try a new dish or purchase a unique souvenir (or two) from a regional artist. A delicious group lunch is included before continuing to Honokaa, located on the northeast coast of the island. This charming small town is the gateway to the dramatic scenery of the Waipi'o Valley, which you will see first-hand from the Waipi'o Valley Lookout. The sacred Waipi'o Valley was the boyhood home of King Kamehameha I. This fertile valley is about one mile across, over five-miles deep, & surrounded by cliffs up to 2000-feet high. Visit a local fruit farm & sample some of their tropical offerings before returning to the hotel early this evening.

Day 5 • Sunday • January 24th

Depart this morning for a full-day tour of the southern & central regions of the Island of Hawai'i, including Volcanoes National Park. The island of Hawai'i is the youngest & largest of the Hawaiian Islands – All of the other Hawaiian Islands can easily fit within its periphery. With active volcanoes & all but four of the world's climate zones represented in its diverse terrains, Hawai'i Island provides inspiration at every turn – in the deep blue ocean and sandy beaches, at cultural & historical sites or while hiking its lush valleys & rainforests. Sights & stops on our tour may include: Punalu'u Black Sand Beach, Volcanoes National Park, Big Island Candies, Downtown Hilo and Banyan Drive, Liliuokalani Gardens, Rainbow Falls, & Mauna Kea Scenic Viewpoint. Lunch is included with today's tour, as well. We will return to the hotel early this evening.

Day 6 • Monday • January 25th

Enjoy a morning at leisure to explore the resort. *Alternatively, join us for a morning Whale Watching Cruise. Humpback whales make their annual journey to Hawaii between the months of November & April, and the Big Island is one of the best islands to see them. Scientists estimate that a whopping ⅔ of the entire North Pacific humpback whale population return to Hawai'i to breed, calve & nurse their young every year. Along with Humpbacks, you can find over a dozen other species of aquatic wildlife year-round, including: pilot whales, sperm whales, whale sharks, beaked whales, false killer whales, Hawaiian spinner dolphins, bottle-nosed dolphins, mantas, green-sea turtles, and flying fish. Transportation to & from the marina is also included. PLEASE NOTE: Wildlife sightings are NOT guaranteed. \$159/person.*

This afternoon is your second volunteering experience with Kona Kids! Your efforts, whether big or small, can have an everlasting effect on the island's children, families & communities.

Day 7 • Tuesday • January 26th

Following check-out, enjoy lunch at your leisure at the hotel before departing. This afternoon, visit a local Kona Coffee farm for a tour & sampling. The Kona coffee industry traces back to 1828 when missionary Reverend Samuel Ruggles introduced coffee to the Kona district on the Big Island of Hawaii. Initially, coffee was grown alongside other crops like sugar and pineapple, but the Kona region's volcanic soil & climate proved ideal for coffee cultivation. Over time, Kona coffee gained recognition for its quality, and many small, family-owned farms emerged, many of which were established by immigrant workers. After, enjoy a group farewell dinner at a local Kona restaurant before continuing to the Kona airport for our overnight flight back to the mainland.

Day 8 • Wednesday • January 27th

Following our overnight flight, arrive early this morning in our connecting city. Continue on our final flight back to Columbus, arriving this afternoon.
