







Meeting in Sofia, Bulgaria March 17th - 23th 2019


Sunday 17th




We arrived in Sofia in the afternoon. We were a bit sleepy \bigcirc but very excited \bigcirc for the new adventure.


We took a bus and we arrived very late at night

We were really tired but happy to meet our partners.



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

There were children on the ferry that I could not figure out where they were from. After exhausting my courage, I went on my way. I said 'can I take photos with you? They accepted. Of course, I took this opportunity without missing. Then they pulled with us too. Then when we arrived we were very excited. This way we crossed the border. Security at the Bulgarian border stepped on my shoes and said 'sorry'. And I said 'grade problem'. When Nihat Teacher said she speaks Turkish, I got strange. I dream of coming to Sofia. The place we went to dinner was the restaurant in a different place where we went before. In the evening, all the teams sang and danced. Shortly we had a lot of fun and made new friends. When we got back to the hotel, I had already promised the girls, we packed my suitcase and went to the Beren's room. While waiting for the eye, Bruno giggled. I hugged and took a photo together. We talked until four o'clock - four for Bulgaria - but then we fell asleep in the bed where Irem and me slept.

We got up early today to go to Krukov. The road was long. I came to Krukova asleep. I traveled 2 camps and we had to wear headphones the first time because it was too crowded. The guide told us about that period. They fit 80 people in a wagon where 4 horses will fit. It was very cruel. 55 thousand Turkish people died at this time. After the guide explained everything, we went to the second camp, it was bigger than the first one. There were railways. Here, men and women were employed separately. They put the ashes of the people who were killed and burned at that time into a haze. After completing this tour, wander through a few stores. We got on the bus and returned to the hotel.

Today is my second day at school. We did a few activities at the gym today. One of them was to send vibrations in waves. We made comments on emojis. We have danced the halay of the Bulgarians. It was very similar to our aunt. We went out and played on the football field. There was no winner with all the groups for some reason. Then we took a photo of it. We had dinner at school, and then we chatted with the wictor, Tozef, Ola, the kasprsla, Racsonne and Antez, whom I met there. It had been a very nice conversation. We returned to the hotel after dinner and slept early because tomorrow we will go to warsava. I wonder what will happen tomorrow.

ONLINE MEETING in ROMANIA 5-11 May 2021

The meeting was organised and run online by Liceum Tehnoliogic Special in Iasi.

Over 100 participants (teachers and students) from Poland, Italy, Bulgaria, Romania and Turkey took part in the event.



The first day

The students and teachers could meet new people thanks to the ice breaker at the beginning of the meeting. Everyone could say what colour they would like to be and why. It was a good opportunity to learn something about the participants. ******

Later, Theodor Sirbuletu- a Romanian teacher- gave a speech about "The ability to work under pressure". He talked about stress and how to deal with it and also how important inclusion is.

Romanian students presented a sign language. They translated a song "We are the children" by Michael Jackson into an American and Romanian sign language. Next they shared the song with everyone to give them a chance to practise the sign language for Friday.

Thanks to Bahar- a teacher from Turky- we could all meet a blind English teacher from Turkey who told us about her life and difficulties she had to overcome in her life when the illness affected her.

Romanian students prepared a presentation about Count Dracula and thanks to that we could enjoy a virtual journey in Romanian mountains and her beautiful castles.

"The ducks and the hunters" was a game that was played and recorded by Romanian students to show the participants how to spend time outside and to share the Romanian games.

The meeting began with online game- a quiz about friendship. All the participants could learn what real friendship means.

Dana Raducanescu- a Romanian teacher gave a very informative speech titled: "Drama Techniques at Schools". She presented positive aspects of using drama techniques during different classes. We could watch Romanian students performing different drama techniques on the videos they prepared for the meeting. The audience could check if they were able to understand the scenes presented by mime artist and musicians.

Finally the students from Poland, Bulgaria, Romania, Turkey and Sassari, Italy presented their photos depicting them now and in the future. They also introduced themselves in English.

Today we could learn about the Palace of Culture in lasi and its history thanks to a virtual trip organised by the Romanian teacher Monica. ******

All the participants learned how to sign a song by Michael Jackson "We are the children". Romanian students presented the sign language which was then repeated by the watching audience. Everyone had a lot of fun and in the end was able to use the international sign language to translate the chorus of the song.

In the second part of the meeting the Romanian teachers presented videos of the lessons: about the optimism and pessimism, individual lesson, experimental theatre lesson-to show students how to hear the wind, see the sun (students were imitating the sounds using gestures. Thanks to those videos we could learn what the techniques of teaching children with special needs are.

The fourth day

On Monday we could work together on creating messages for the next generation, which we could later translate into Braille alphabet after a short workshop-video on how the letters are encoded into Braille. A common document was created with different messages created by students and teachers.

Later students from different schools presented short films about the school life. Those were different film productions showing students' creativity but it appeared that we share the same problems during teaching and learning at our schools.

Presenting traditional recipes from partner countries was the last activity of the day. Students prepared Power Point Presentations as well as short videos presenting traditional dishes from their countries and regions. Students turned out to be really talented not ony in cooking but also in playing traditional instruments.

The fifth day

The last day of the Romanian meeting brought us more nice opportunities to learn about the people participating in the meeting. Students could talk a bit about their national heroes and created a common mind map with all the heroes from their countries. ----

Later students and teachers talked about International Labour Day and how it is celebrated in the project countries. It occurred that 1st May is a day off in all of the project countries and the presentations were a great history lesson for all the students.

The discussion about May celebrations and learning about pottery workshop as a way of working with students with special needs was the last activity of the day.



On the first day we could all take part in a virtual tour around the school in Sassari and later we all focused on emotions: how to recognise them, talk about them and work with them. Livorno team presented some yoga exercises to relax. It was a great chance to get to know people who joined the meeting. -----

The second day was a workshop on stories. Students worked with bookcreator.com and prepared the stories about the roots of their countries, regions and themselves. Later everyone could listen and read the legends and myths from partner countries. -----

On the third day we started with some ice-breakers. Students were guessing whether the things they told others were true or false. It was a nice game that helped us to feel relaxed and welcomed. Later we learned about Agenda 2030 thanks to the video shared by Graziella and some guizzes which helped the students to check how much they remembered. The students had a great opportunity to compete in a Kahoot game. In the second part of the meeting a Livorno team presented a video showing the methods and exercises for students so that they were able to understand how the students with special needs feel and survive in everyday life. We could see the Italian students helping the people who cannot see or putting on their socks and shoes with one hand only.


