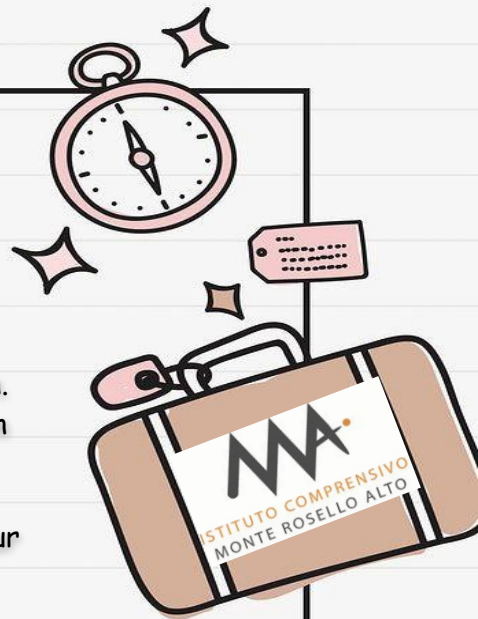


7th November (by Valeria)

Then we went to the Museum. Very very beautiful and interesting activity.

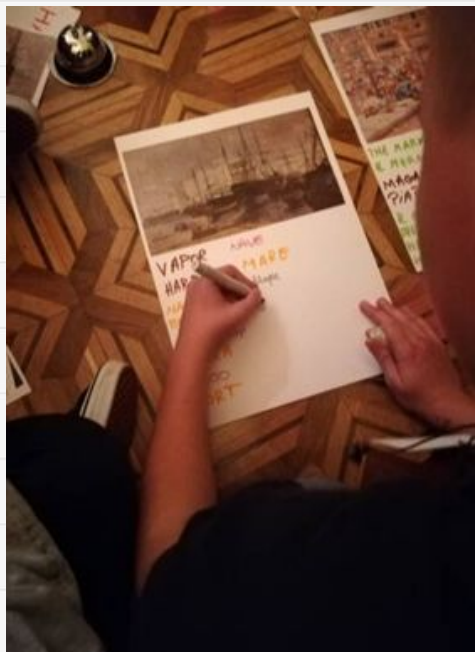

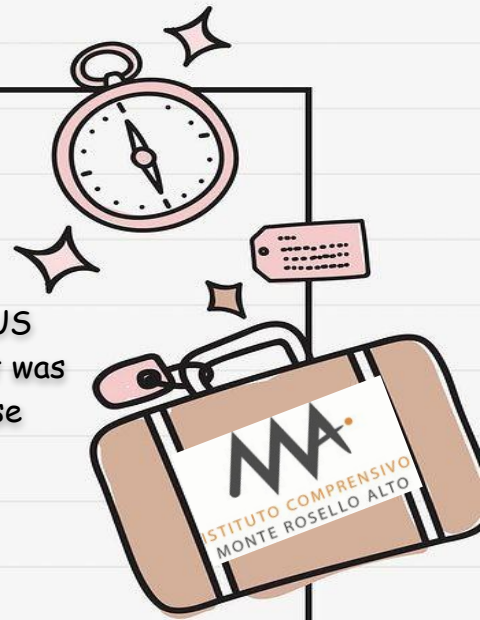
Then we had lunch. In the afternoon we worked together with our partners performing Ebru Turkish art of marbling and doing handicraft souvenirs and magnets

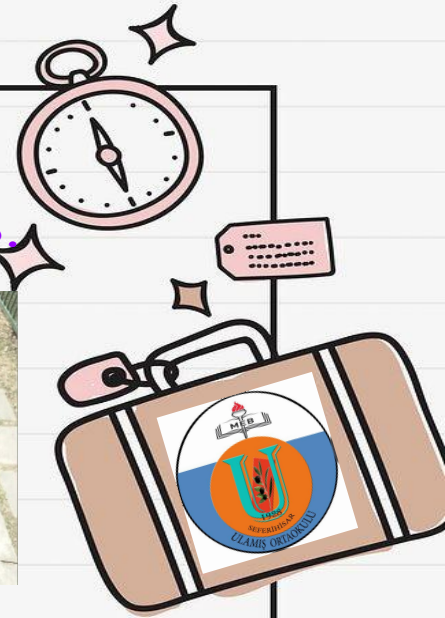

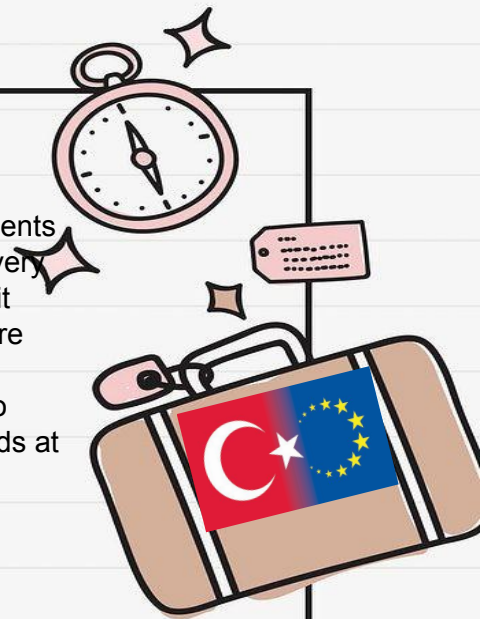
2nd Day in Bulgaria

(By the way, while visiting the school, we entered the computer class and I met a Turkish girl there.

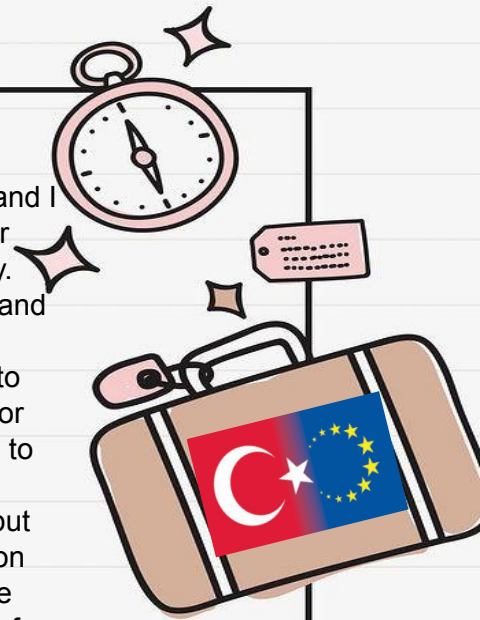
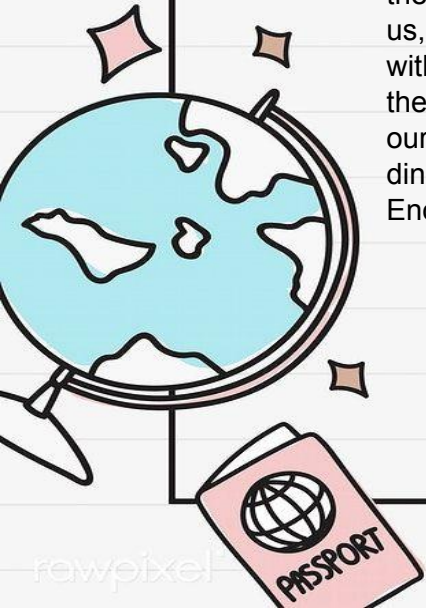

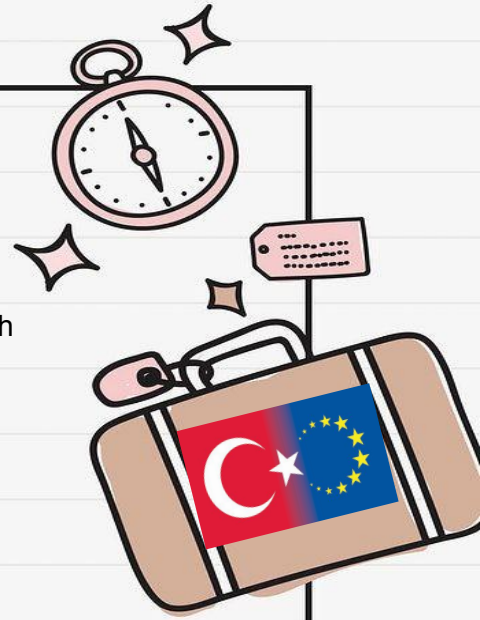


6th Day in Bulgaria

Today is our last day here. At first we did not speak, but then we sang both Turkish and Italian songs together. We had a lot of fun.

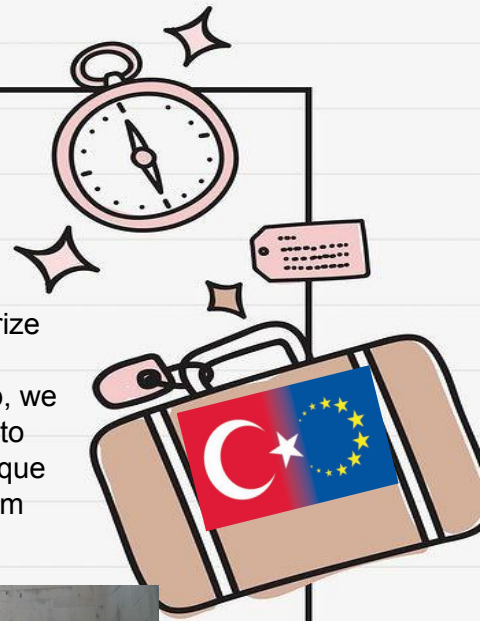

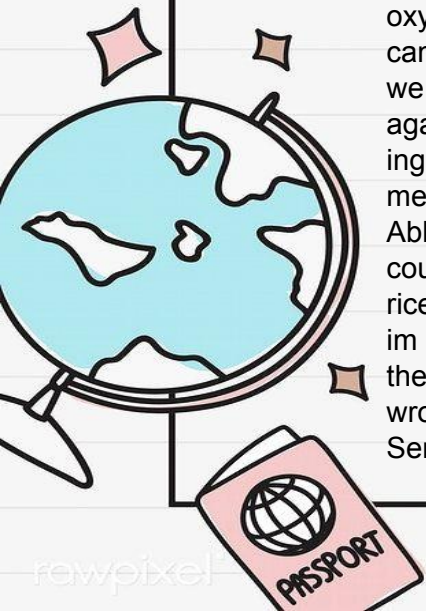
Meeting in Bulgaria-Diaries by Beren T.

We started our journey at 01:30 in the evening. Of course I ... spent it. As we went to Bulgaria via Çanakkale, we got on the ferry. There were children on the ferry that I could not figure out where they were from. After exhausting my courage, I went on my way. I said 'can I take photos with you? They accepted. Of course, I took this opportunity without missing. Then they pulled with us too. Then when we arrived we were very excited. This way we crossed the border. Security at the Bulgarian border stepped on my shoes and said 'sorry'. And I said 'grade problem'. When Nihat Teacher said she speaks Turkish, I got strange. I dream of coming to Sofia. It must be because I was sleeping. We quickly settled there, went out to eat. We asked a lot of people on the way where we would go. However, my favorite Bahar Teacher speaks English, your brother says, "Are you Turkish?" If he hadn't asked, we quickly found the rojdan hotel in our long search for a hotel after eating the meals. We went to their room because he was sick in sight. We took medicine from the Spring Teacher and lowered his fever. We drank Hawin's coffees when he was good the eye - he made coffee in the room- Then we came to our room and went to sleep.



2nd Day in Sofia

We got up at eight in the morning. After we had our breakfast, we went to tour the Muzeiko. At the entrance to the Mukiba there was a large machine with a combination of many machines. Usually things related to science. When we got out, we examined the experiments that were there. For example, there was a machine that separates oxygen and hydrogen in the water. We got out of there, we came to a place that we can call a science room. There we examined the effects of the sun ... and hand cream against UV rays. We did experiments by mixing the ingredients of yogurt 1 and yogurt 2. The part that made me the most happy was that I translated the table while Aba was explaining the experiment. I was so happy that I could translate. It was not very good, rice was meat and rice in the middle of the broth ... and there was fruit juice. im knocked on the door. Teodor tried to take our brother to the subway, but he only worked because we got on the wrong subway about four times. It was like a joke. Seriously, we did not take the subway for 1-2 days.



3rd Day in Sofia

We visited their schools. Then we went to the mall called MALL OF SOFIA. I have no idea, but I think it was the biggest shopping center. Then we turned the pieces into plates - Money given by Bahar teacher - Then we started to tour. After visiting the whole store, we returned to the stores we chose. Lastly, I bought chocolate from Billa where the food and beverages were sold at the cheapest price. I was running that when I saw the shop, I informed the girls and I can say that we stopped and dived into the shop. The place we went to dinner was the restaurant in a different place where we went before. In the evening, all the teams sang and danced. Shortly we had a lot of fun and made new friends. When we got back to the hotel, I had already promised the girls, we packed my suitcase and went to the Beren's room. While waiting for the eye, Bruno giggled. I hugged and took a photo together. We talked until four o'clock - four for Bulgaria - but then we fell asleep in the bed where İrem and me slept.



4th Day in Sofia

We got up early and went to breakfast. Today? Today we went to the cultural capital of Ploudiv two thousand nineteen. We got on the bus with all groups. I think we all slept the way. The guide told the Spring teacher. I would like to translate like a spring teacher. According to the program flow, when we went to the ancient theater ... I learned that the summers that he still use are also coming to the theater. Staying with us for a while. There was a place called the old ... house. It was a little behind ... and I couldn't hear it because there was a lot of noise. First there was the Roman Stadium. It was covered for a period and then it was dug up again. We also went shopping with Bahar and Tuğba teachers. We bought toşbiş with İrem and Ceren. Later, we went to another place called Eskişehir; we went to churches. When our trip was over, we got on the bus and went back to Sofia. they told us.



5th Day in Sofia

In the evening, we combined the beds with Hawin and slept. We woke up in the morning with Hawin's waking efforts. I said okay and left the room

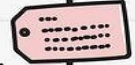
Though we left the gym as we entered the gym. Then what happened already happened.

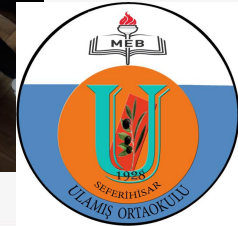

3rd Day in Poland

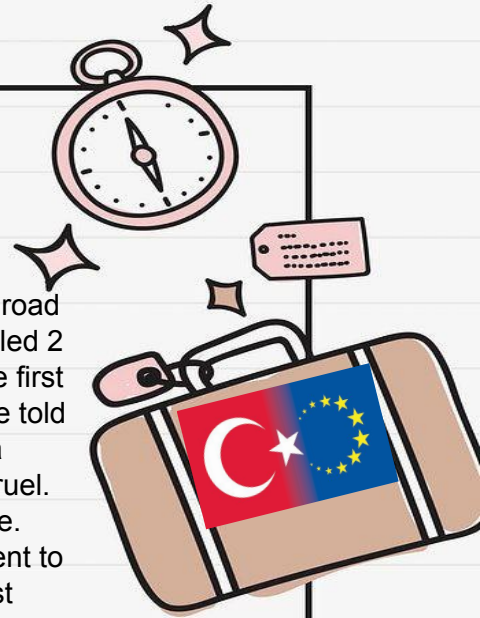

The guide told us about that period. They fit 80 people in a wagon where 4 horses will fit. It was very cruel. 55 thousand Turkish people died at this time. After the guide explained everything, we went to the second camp, it was bigger than the first one. There were railways. Here, men and women were employed separately. They put the ashes of the people who were killed and burned at that time into a haze. After completing this tour, wander through a few stores. We got on the bus and returned to the hotel.



5th Day in Poland

Today is my second day at school. We did a few activities at the gym today. One of them was to send vibrations in waves. We made comments on emojis. We have danced the halay of the Bulgarians. It was very similar to our aunt. We went out and played on the football field. There was no winner with all the groups for some reason. Then we took a photo of it. We had dinner at school, and then we chatted with the wictor, Tozef, Ola, the kasprsla, Racsonne and Antez, whom I met there. It had been a very nice conversation. 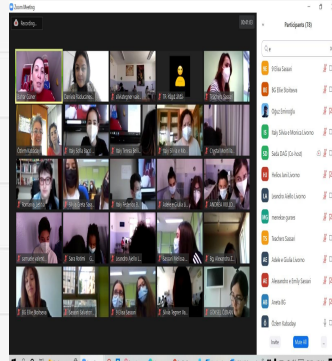
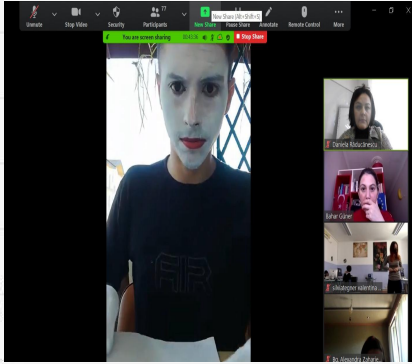
6th Day in Poland

And we understood that our English had improved a lot and we had a lot of fun.



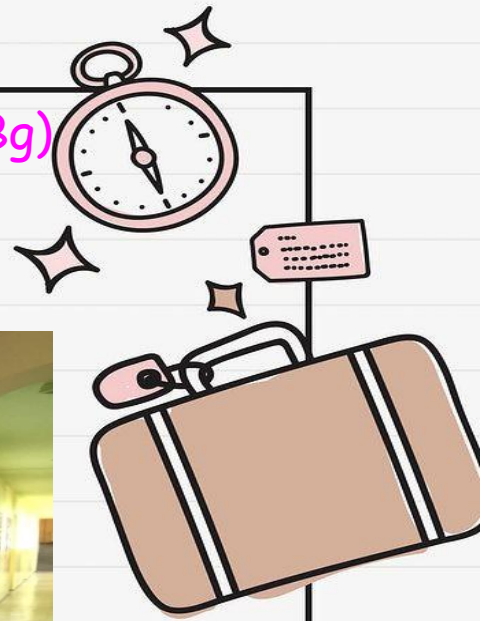

At the end of the meeting students from Livorno, Italy talked about themselves presenting photos of themselves at present and in the future.



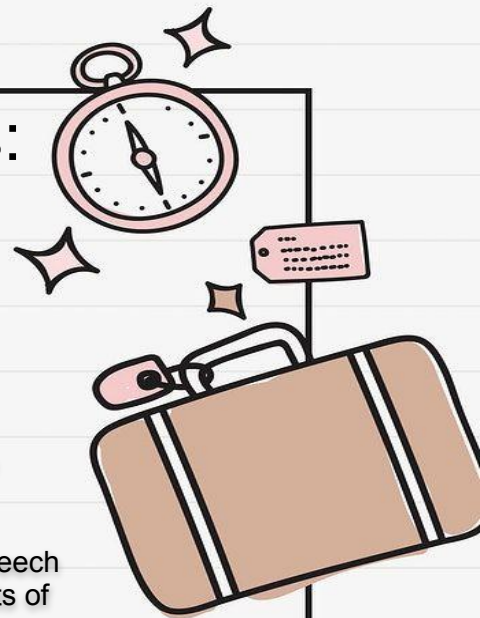

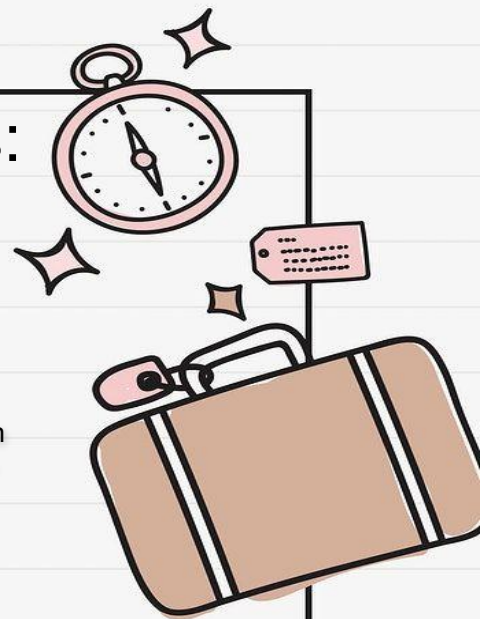

The fifth day

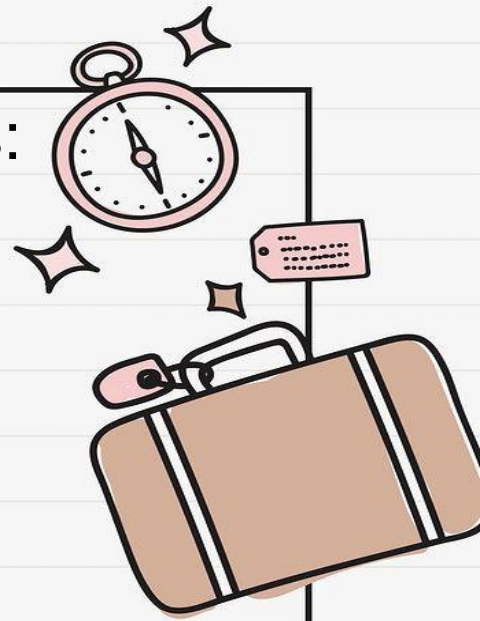

The discussion about May celebrations and learning about pottery workshop as a way of working with students with special needs was the last activity of the day.

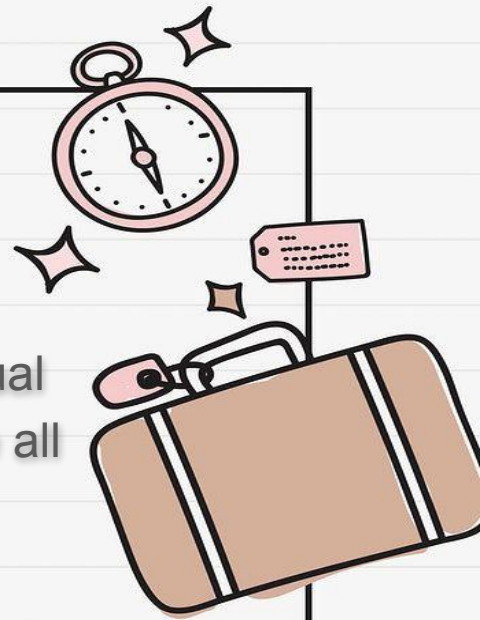

It was difficult at first to communicate with them, but then I discovered commonalities with students in Bulgaria and I communicated using an application on the phone.



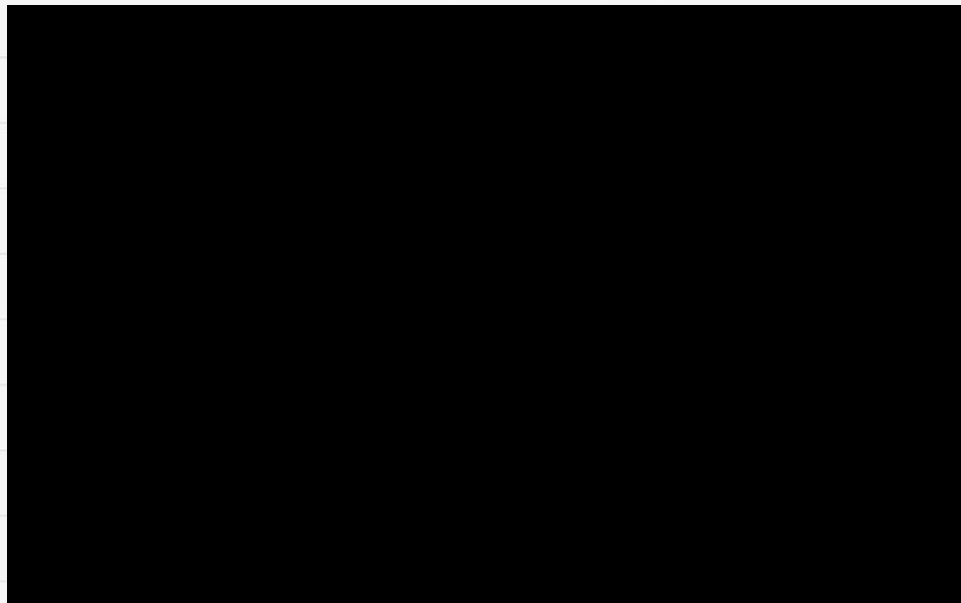

EMI:

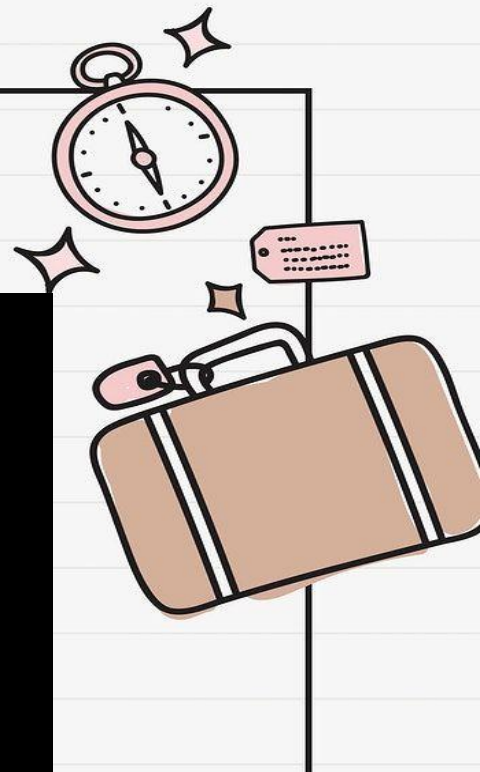

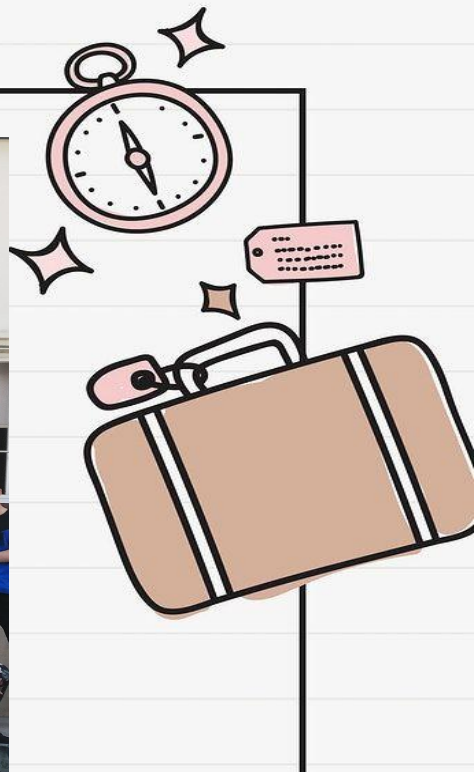

But there are also exceptional types of food, such as *baclava*. I ate a lot of *baclava*. :))))



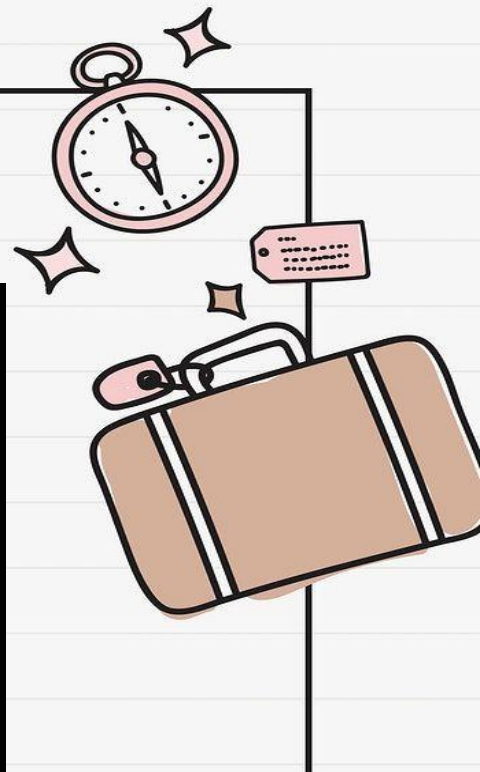

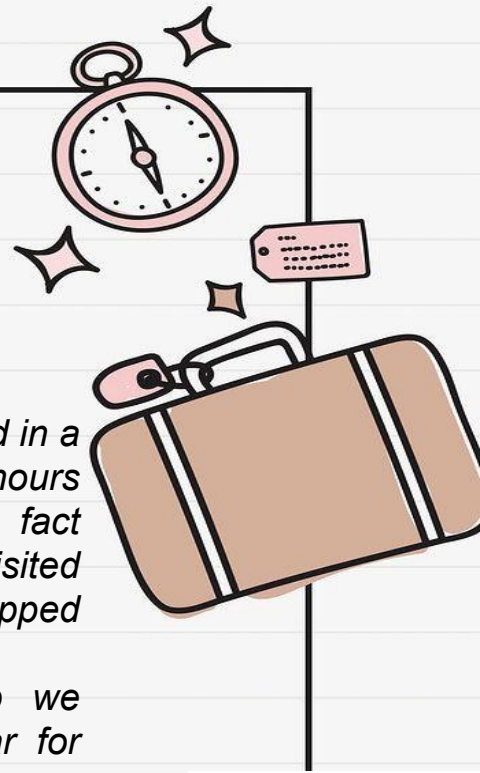

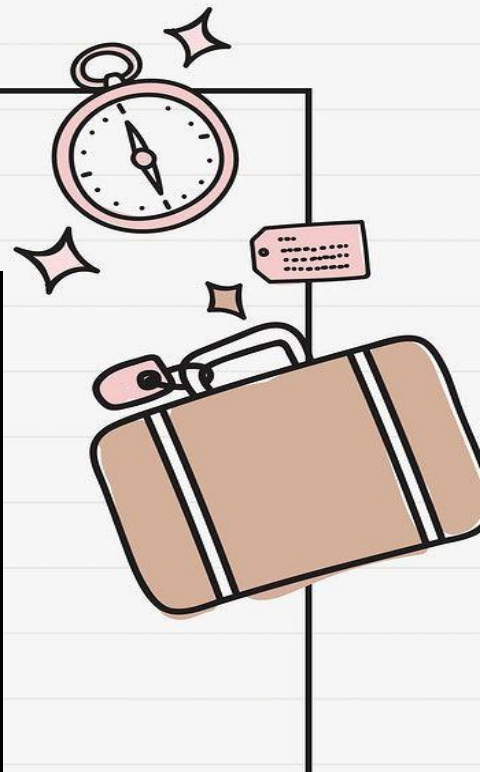
ECATERINA:

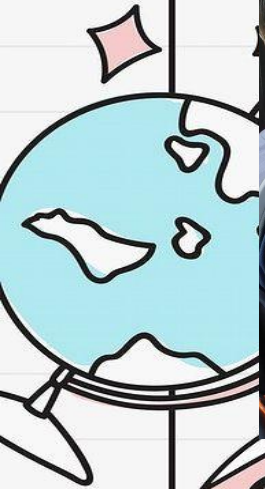

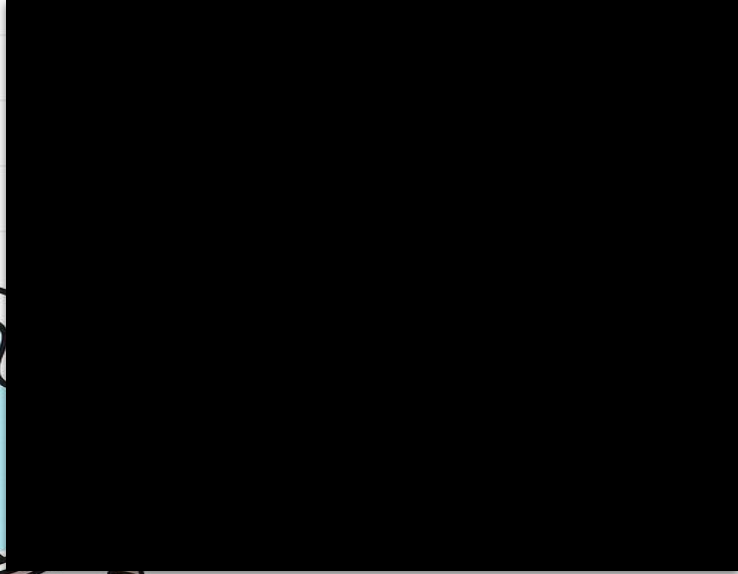
EDUARD:
