Today, we stepped into the world of zookeepers and experienced a side of the zoo that most visitors never see. Now, we learnt a lot of new knowledge on being responsible, patient, and caring for animals and their homes every single day.

CLEANING DEER POOP IN THE DEER ENCLOSURE



We got our tools and got to work! Cleaning up deer poop might not be the most glamorous job, but it's essential for keeping the enclosure clean, safe, and healthy for the deer. It taught us how important hygiene is in animal care and how even the smallest tasks make a big difference.



SWEEPING LEAVES FROM THE TAPIR ENCLOSURE

Next, we swept leaves and debris from the tapir enclosure. It helps keep the space clean, prevents slips, and allows the tapirs to move around comfortably. We learned how much regular maintenance goes into making sure animals have the best environment possible.

The overlooked significance of plants

Introduction

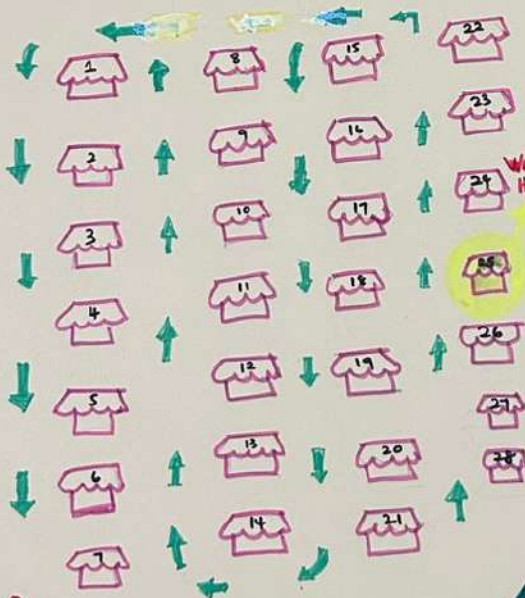

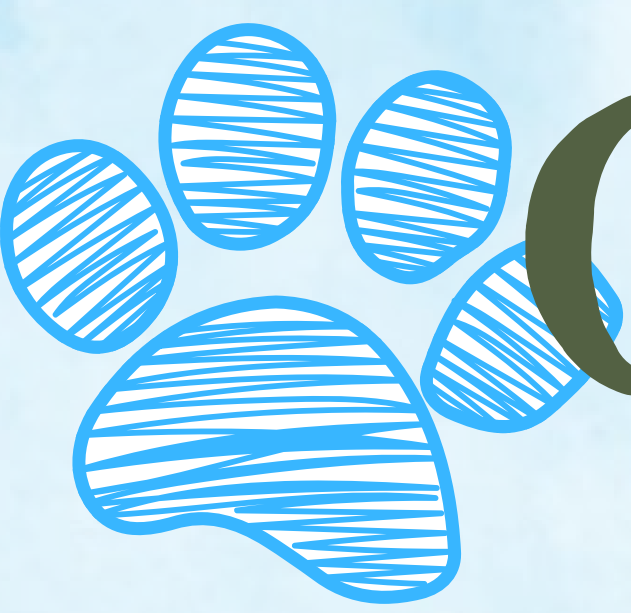

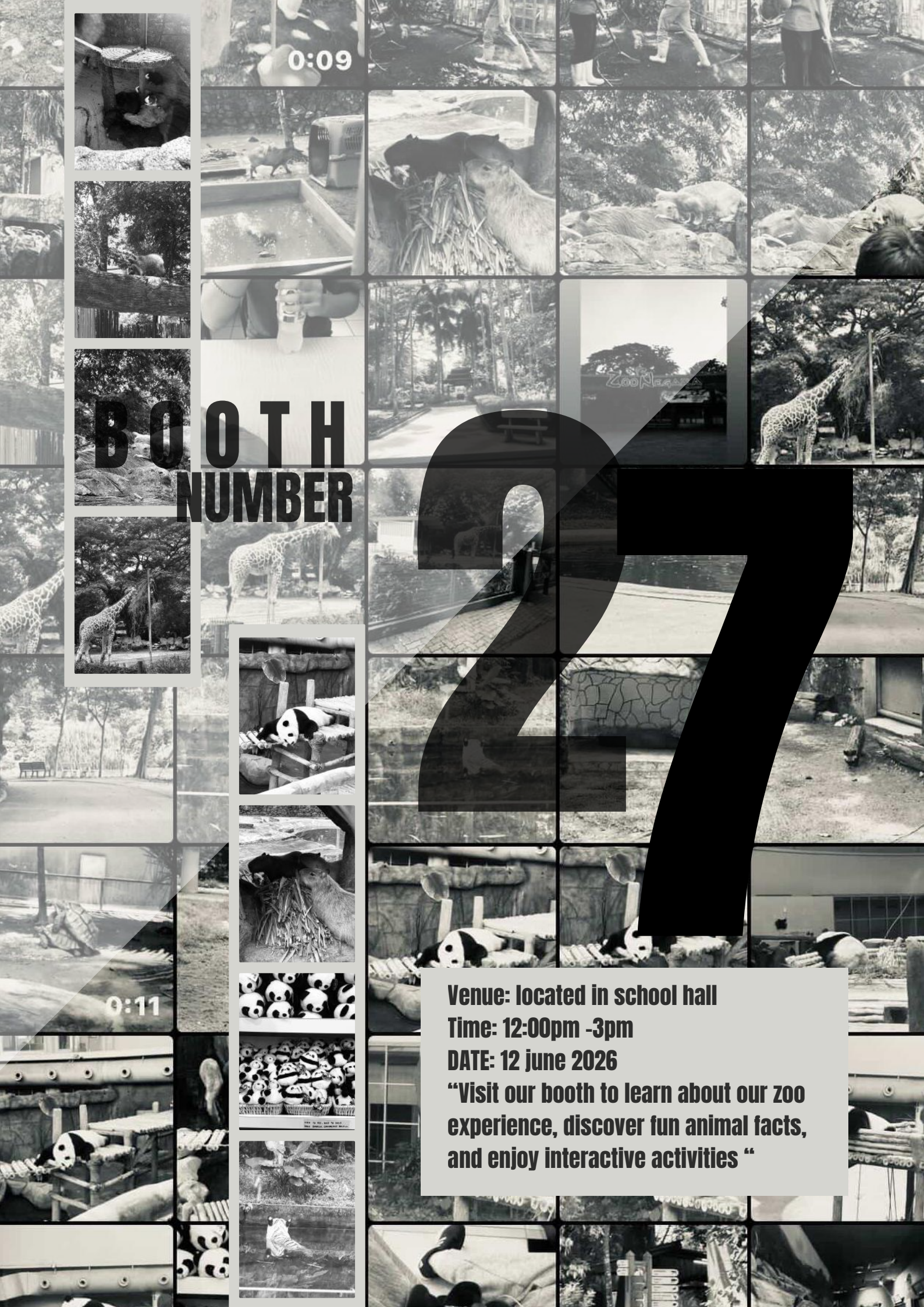
