KONA: CIRCLE ISLAND EXPERIENCE

DEPARTS: KONA / FLIGHT TIME: 2 HOURS

You flew all the way to Hawai'i; you should see it all on the only complete helicopter tour around Hawai'i island. The Island of Hawai'i really is a "Big Island." Paradise's Circle Island Experience is the only helicopter tour in Hawai'i that ventures south to encompass the entire perimeter, and we do it in just two hours!

Starting from the Kona International Airport at the island's western-most tip, your pilot takes you past the Kona coffee district and the slopes of Mauna Loa to the southernmost town in the United States. You'll be amazed when viewing one of only four green sand beaches in the world! Next, your pilot will take you to view the world's most active volcano, and continue towards Pu'u 'Ō'ō vent. After over 35 years of activity, discover what Kīlauea Volcano has left in the wake of its recent eruptive episode. Witness otherworldly landscapes like the incredible eight-mile river of frozen lava from Ahu'ailā'au to the Pacific Ocean, the newest black sand beaches on earth, and enormous craters created by these historic events.

Then, turn to the east, the island's lush windward side and Hilo town. Notice how water now flows where lava once did, gushing out of sheer cliffs through lava tubes, creating hundreds of waterfalls and nourishing the rich vegetation. The grandeur of the Kohala valleys and waterfalls of the north are sure to catch your breath, as are the white sand beaches on your return to Kona.

Enjoy a true Hawai'i experience on Paradise Helicopters' premier air adventure. Explore all five volcanoes, hidden white and black sand beaches, lush waterfalls cascading down 2,500-foot valley walls, breathtaking coastlines and 11 different climate zones. Hawai'i is the largest of the islands, and due to activity at Kīlauea and Mauna Loa, it's still growing. Upon departure from the Kona Airport, you will fly over the world-famous Kona coffee district and the slopes of Hualālai and Mauna Loa. Learn about the unique history, geology, and culture of Hawai'i Island through a two-way communication system that lets you ask the questions and get to know your pilot.

See Kīlauea, the world's most active volcano, and hunt out any current lava flows. After over 35 years of activity, discover what has been left in the wake of the recent historic eruptive episode. Witness otherworldly landscapes like the incredible 8-mile river of frozen lava from Ahu'ailā'au to the Pacific Ocean, the newest black sand beaches on earth, and enormous craters created by these recent events! In winter, you may see snow atop Mauna Loa and Mauna Kea.

Then, you will head toward east Hawai'i's lush rainforests and the incomparable Kohala valleys. The views here are so spectacular that even our pilots, who see them on a daily basis, often say this area is their favorite hidden gem to share with visitors and guests. Rounding out your trip, you'll enjoy a birds-eye view of iconic beaches, including Hāpuna Beach and Kua Bay, consistently voted as some of the best beaches in the world.

KONA: KOHALA COAST & WATERFALLS

Fly with Paradise to the Kohala valleys to hover amidst the breathtaking 2,500-foot waterfalls and sheer cliff faces. En route, you will witness frozen lava flows on the Kona and Kohala coasts from the 1801 Hualālai eruption and the 1859 Mauna Loa eruption, which traveled over 31 miles before reaching the coastline. Dotting the shoreline along the way, you can pick out pristine white and black sand beaches - including Mahai'ula, Kiholo, Anaeho'omalu, and Hāpuna – to visit during your stay! Upon arriving at the lush landscape of Kohala, your pilot will not only show you its rugged coastline, home to dramatic valleys but will also educate you about this region's significance in Hawaiian history as the birthplace of Hawai'i's most famous ali'i (nobility), Kamehameha the Great. Departing from the Kona International Airport, this 60-minute tour is a great choice for guests wanting to see the beauty of Kohala, without sacrificing beach time for drive time.

KONA: KOHALA COAST WATERFALLS + EXCLUSIVE LANDING

Fly with Paradise to the Kohala valleys to hover amidst the breathtaking 2500' waterfalls and sheer cliff faces. Dotting the shoreline along the way, you can pick out one of the few pristine white or black sand beaches including Mahai'ula, Kiholo, Anaeho'omalu and Hāpuna – to visit during your stay. Upon arriving at the lush landscape of Kohala, your pilot will not only show you its rugged coastline, home to forested valleys, but will also educate you about this region's significance in Hawaiian history as the birthplace of Hawai'i's famous ali'i (nobility), Kamehameha the Great.

Mid-flight your aircraft will touch down at a remote location deep in the Kohala mountains to explore and enjoy a moderate half mile pilot-led hike through a waiwi (guava) forest. The meandering trail immerses you in the flora and fauna of Kohala and surprises you with a dramatic coastline vista, offering views of the Mokupuku island formations and waves crashing along the rugged north shore of Hawai'i Island. All the while you will learn about the culture and diverse natural habitat of this serene location that most people never see. After your refreshing hike, take to the air again, to view the drastic landscape change from windward to leeward, and the world-famous white and black sand beaches and resorts en route back to Kona.

KONA: VOLCANO KOHALA LANDING

DEPARTS: KONA / FLIGHT TIME: 1.75 HOURS GROUND TOUR: 1 HOUR

See the breathtaking beauty of Hawai'i Island, plus enjoy a very special landing in the Kohala area on the Volcano Kohala Landing air adventure. After departing from the Kona International Airport, you will overfly the world-famous Kona coffee district and skirt three of Hawai'i's towering volcanoes: Hualālai, Mauna Kea and Mauna Loa. Explore the area surrounding Hawai'i Volcanoes National Park to hunt out any current lava activity and see historic flows frozen in time. Then, turn your attention north to Hilo town and the lush rainforests of East Hawai'i. Notice how the windward side of the island is transformed by the water caught by the mountains.

Then, unlike any other air adventure on the Big Island, Paradise will take you deep into Kohala. Walk the same fertile valleys that King Kamehameha the Great did as a child. Learn about the culture and the diverse natural habitat. Normally only accessible by hours of hiking, you are treated to the untouched purity of this serene location. After exploring on the ground, take to the air again to view the drastic landscape change from windward to leeward, and world-famous white sand beaches and resorts en route back to Kona.

HILO: LAVA & RAINFORESTS ADVENTURE

The Lava & Rainforests Adventure showcases Hawai'i's story and its inextricable link to the elements. You will fly over Kīlauea, one of the most active volcanoes on earth and search out any activity at Halema'uma'u crater, Ahu'ailā'au, or Pu'u 'Ō'ō vent. The windward side catches enough rain to make Hilo the wettest city in the United States! All this water fills tunnels that once flowed with lava, creating incredible rivers, pools and waterfalls all over east Hawai'i. View Hilo's lush rainforests, Mauna Loa's vistas and the plunging Wai'ānuenue (Rainbow Falls), so named for the rainbows you can see in the mist when the early morning sunshine hits the water.

WAIMEA: DOORS-OFF KOHALA VALLEYS & WATERFALLS

There is no better way to experience and learn about the geography, history and incomparable lush beauty of Kohala, birthplace of King Kamehameha, than our doors-off tour.

This region is named after the Kohala volcano, which last erupted around 120,000 years ago, birthing the first landmass to make up Hawai'i Island. Kohala volcano shaped the region's rugged coastline and plunging valleys, and the volcano's lava tubes now flow with water to dapple the region with the many waterfalls you'll fly past.

The Doors-Off Kohala Valleys & Waterfall with Remote Hike flight is the only doors-off helicopter tour that takes you deep into the heart of the Kohala valleys. There is no better way to experience and learn about the geography, history and incomparable lush beauty of Kohala, birthplace of King Kamehameha, than our doors-off tour. Once you are in these valleys, your camera will be the only thing between you and the towering 2500-foot waterfalls and sheer cliff faces – talk about epic social media posts!

Your aircraft will touch down at a remote location deep in Kohala Mountains to explore and enjoy a moderate half mile pilot-led hike through a waiwi (guava) forest. The meandering trail immerses you in the flora and fauna of Kohala and surprises you with a dramatic coastline vista, offering views of the Mokupuku island formations and waves crashing along the rugged north shore of Hawai'i Island. All the while you will learn about the culture and diverse natural habitat of this untouched location that most people never see. After your refreshing hike, take to the air again, and enjoy views of the rolling hills of Kohala as you make your way back to Waimea.



KAPOLEI: DOORS-OFF O'AHU CIRCLE ISLAND EXPERIENCE

See incredible aerial views starting with a taste of history over Pearl Harbor, the WWII Arizona Memorial, and Battleship Missouri. Next, soar above the bustling Honolulu Harbor, beautiful Waikīkī, and iconic Leahi (Diamond Head Crater). Heading further east, you'll fly over Koko Head Crater and Hanauma Bay before Sandy Beach and Makapu'u Lighthouse. Heading north, you will come across the fantastic coral formations of Kāne'ohe Bay, Mokoli'i (Chinaman's Hat) and take a peek into "Jurassic Park" or, as it has been known locally for hundreds of years, Ka'a'awa Valley. The thousand-foot cascade of Kaliuwa'a (Sacred Falls) is sure to stun you, and is accessible only by air. Then you'll see the Polynesian Cultural Center, Turtle Bay Resort, and worldfamous surfing spots of the North Shore - Sunset, Pipeline, Waimea Bay and more. As you round Ka'ena Point, you get a glimpse of the serene Wai'anae Coast, a hidden gem of the island. Uncrowded and glorious white sand beaches - Yokohama Bay, Mākaha, and Pōka'i - lace the coast. Historic Mākaha Valley comes into view as you are a few minutes away from arriving back to Kalaeloa.



LĀNAI: MOLOKA'I SEA CLIFFS

Explore the islands of Lāna'i and Moloka'i with Paradise Helicopters. There is no time to waste getting to the north side of Moloka'i, where millennia of exposure to the natural elements of wind, wave, and rain have sculpted the tallest sea cliffs in the world. They are sure to take your breath away as you explore amidst the sheer waterfalls and drop offs decorated by lush tropical forests. After viewing the national historical town of Kalaupapa, the journey continues to Lāna'i. Kānepu'u Preserve - rare native dryland forest, Keahiakawelo (the "Garden of the Gods"), and long sandy beaches complete the adventure.

LĀNA'I: MAUI NUI

DEPARTS: LĀNA'I / FLIGHT TIME: 1 HOUR 45 MINUTES

Over one million years ago, Maui Nui ("Greater Maui") was a single island forty percent larger than present day Hawai'i Island. Over time, natural forces drew Maui Nui lower into the Pacific, and its saddles fell below sea-level to form separate islands.

Discover all five of the major islands that comprise Maui Nui. First, head east past Kaho'olawe, with its unique history as a bombing range for the US Army during WWII, to the southern flank of east Maui. View the slopes of Haleakalā and the road to Hāna without spending hours in a rental car. Make your way past the world-famous surf break, Pe'ahi (Jaws), and cross the Pailolo channel to Moloka'i.





DOORS-OFF GUIDELINES

If you will be enjoying a Doors-Off flight with us:

- Please bring a jacket as the cabin will be cool and very windy.
- If you wish to take photos during the flight, your camera or phone must have a strap and be secured to you.
- No hats or other loose accessories such as scarves are permitted on the flight.
- We will ask you to empty your pockets before your flight to remove anything that could potentially become airborne, including camera lenses or personal items.
- · Closed-toe shoes are required and may not have open backs
- Prescription glasses and sunglasses may be worn on doors-off flights as your 2-way communication headset will pin them securely to your head. If they are not worn, we will ask you to leave them behind.
- If you have longer hair, we recommend tying it back.
- No tablets or selfie sticks are allowed.



IMPORTANT DETAILS, UPGRADES & FEES

CO-PILOT

The Co-Pilot seat describes the seat positioned directly beside the helicopter pilot's seat. Take advantage of cockpit views through the wind shield and two windows. This seat is referred to as Seat 1 and is only available on non-private tours. This upgrade will guarantee you the co-pilot seat and will be subject to weight and balance restrictions.

WINDOW SEAT

A window seat is any seat directly next to a window. In the MD 500 aircraft, window seats are the two seats in the rear of the aircraft. For an additional charge, you may purchase a window seat. Guaranteed window seating is included in the capacity surcharge for passengers over 265 lbs. This purchase is subject to weight and balance restrictions and is available only on non-private tours. At our Turtle Bay location, window seats are only available at the time of check-in.

EXTRA SEAT

Guests weighing 270 lbs. and above at check-in will be charged for an extra seat at a reduced rate for weight and balance purposes. The rate of the extra seat is determined by the specific tour that they are booked on, this is calculated by adding an additional discounted seat to the one that has already been purchased. All guests weighing 270 lbs and above will be guaranteed a window seat.

Accurate weights at the time of booking are essential to ensure the comfort and safety of all guests. If a passenger is unable to fly due to an inaccurate weight provided at the time of booking, no refund will be made. Maintaining proper weight and balance in the aircraft is necessary to provide our guests with a safe, smooth and comfortable air adventure.
