This year brought rapid growth internationally, especially in Africa. A major highlight was the launch of **Philip Centre North**, a brand-new training hub in remote northern Ghana that equips and sends believers to reach their own people.

We also celebrate the expansion of **Heart Bible for the Nations**, **Digital Evangelism**, and the

mobilization of Arab and African missionaries by our friends at **Streams of Living Water**.

NOT WITHOUT CHALLENGES

Not everything went as planned. One setback was the delay in fully launching **ReachPeople** — an exciting new media platform designed to gather and share powerful resources that inform, inspire, and equip everyday believers to better advance the gospel. Stay tuned in 2026!

EXCITING PLANS

Moving forward, we're doubling down on empowering young adults like never before.

- I've launched a **young men's discipleship group** to help raise up new leaders.
- We're preparing for our largest **summer internship program** yet, with up to 50 young adults using their gifts to support global media and prayer projects.
- Our summer focus will be on the **Middle East and North Africa**, including new virtual prayer tours, music, and resources to guide prayer for the Muslim world.

MY GREATEST BURDEN

What keeps me up at night is how to raise up more workers to meet the growing needs of this mission. We pray that God would help us mobilize more laborers, especially from the next generation — in OneWay and throughout the world — to seize the vast opportunities to reach more people for Christ.

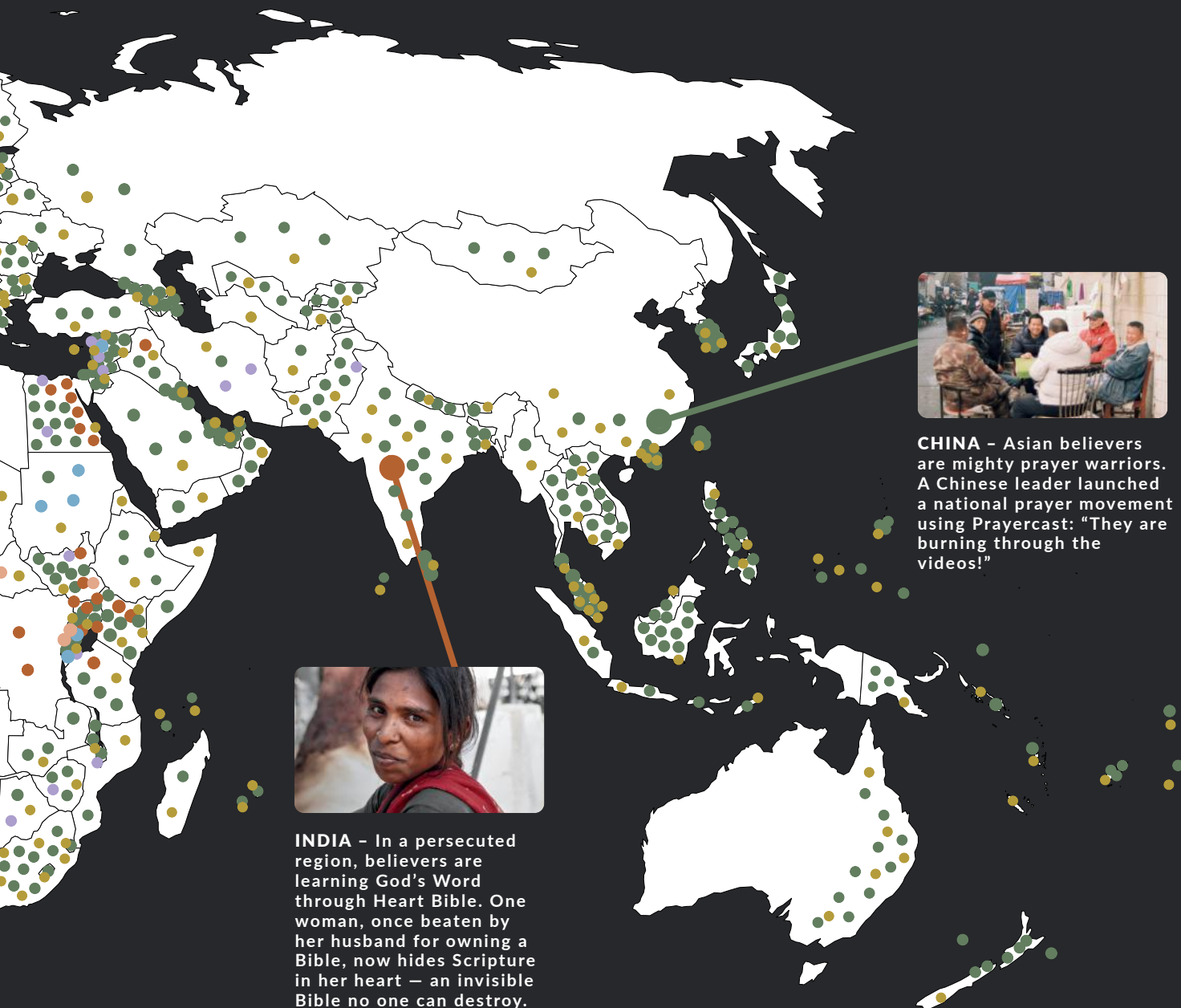

She came for an internship but God gave her a calling

When **Val Feyen** joined OneWay as a 2024 summer intern, little did she know how much God would redirect her path.

At the time, she was studying music therapy, unsure how her gifts might fit into God's global mission. But the OneWay team saw something in her — **a passion for people and a servant's heart.**

Through mentorship, hands-on ministry, and opportunities to lead, Val began to see gifts she didn't know she had. "The summer was incredibly edifying," Val said. "It was powerful to see how He could use me."

Ministry hadn't been on Val's radar, but as she returned to college, **her heart burned with a new sense of purpose.** She changed her major, graduated early, and rejoined the OneWay team in May 2025.

Today, Val heads up OneWay's internship program and helps facilitate our partnership

with **prayer and worship movements across the Greater Middle East and North Africa.**

Val is thrilled to be using her gifts to empower others to know God and make Him known — both near and far.

YOUNG ADULTS SHARE THE WORD UNDER PRESSURE IN EGYPT

Egyptian young people become walking Bibles and equipped evangelists

In Egypt, a dynamic group of believers are stepping up with boldness and passion. Through Heart Bible for the Nations, Egyptians are learning to **internalize and retell Scripture in their own words** — accurately, naturally, and confidently.

In a nation with tight restrictions, Heart Bible is a true blessing. When God's Word is hidden in their hearts, it can never be taken away. Believers aren't just reading the Bible. They are learning it, living it, and passing it on.

They encourage each other:

“It may be illegal to give a Bible to people here, but no one can stop us from telling Bible stories!”

In Egypt and 21 other nations worldwide, Heart Bible is planting Scripture in young hearts, and bold, equipped evangelists are emerging.



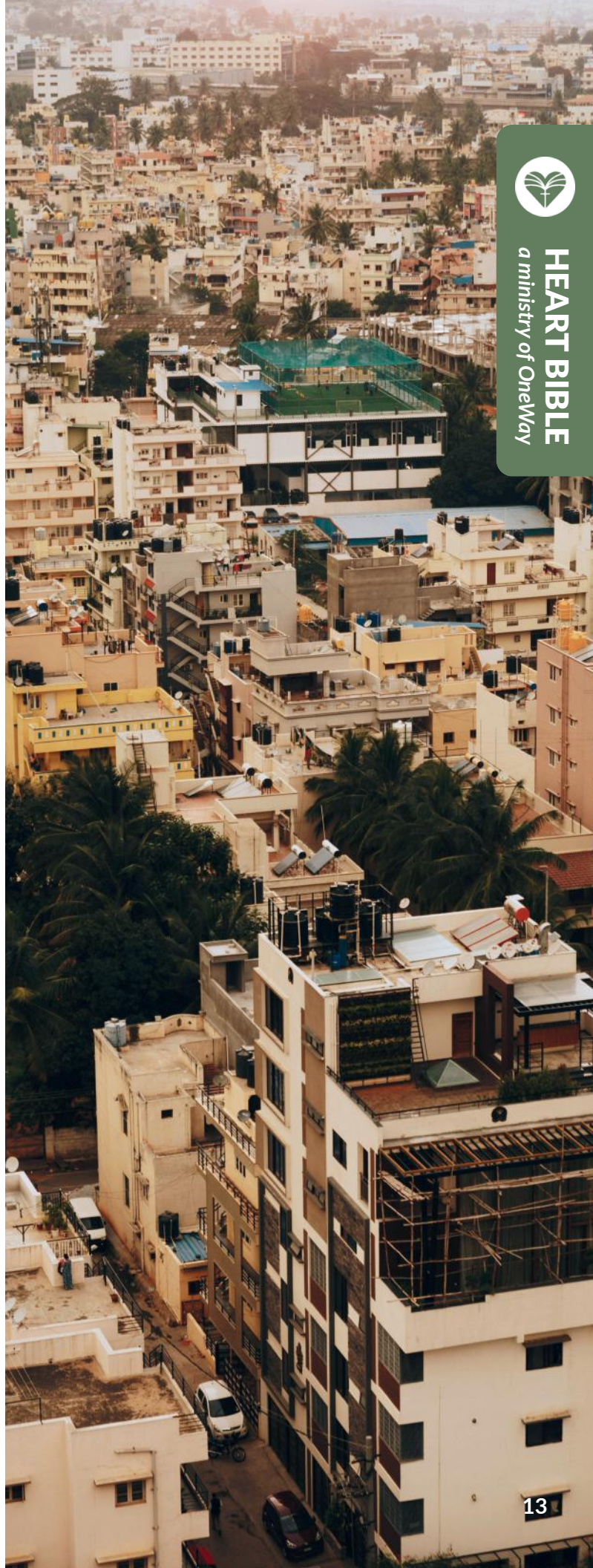

61,000 HEAR THE GOSPEL THROUGH SEVEN YOUNG MEN IN GHANA

Making a massive impact at a minimal expense

In the remote, hard-to-reach corners of northern Ghana, the gospel is arriving — on two wheels.

Seven young men, known as **the Jesus Film Riders**, travel by motorcycle to unreached communities. Through the JESUS Film and audio Bibles, they introduce people to Christ and disciple new believers with God's Word in their heart language.

Crossing rivers and braving the dark, they press on with unstoppable energy. Each rider reaches around **12,000 people** annually. At a cost of \$8,400 per rider, that's just **70 cents** to help one person hear the gospel.

MOBILIZING YOUNG ADULTS IN THE ARAB WORLD

*How God is calling young people to reach
spiritually dry lands*

Our partner ministry, **Streams of Living Water**, hosted their 2025 Mobilization Conference, inspiring more than 600 adults, youth, and children to **spread God's light to the nations**. Throughout the weekend, powerful teachers and testimonies stirred hearts deeply.

In response, **over 100 participants came forward, committing to go wherever God calls them**. So many Egyptians asked to join our upcoming Impact School training that they may need to launch a fourth school next year!

Here's what one participant shared:

"I realized that the Great Commission is the true treasure of life — and sharing the Good News is our greatest joy. My life before the conference is not the same as after; the change is real."

20 YEARS OF MULTIPLYING MISSIONARIES IN AFRICA

A rising generation empowered to reach



A native of Botswana, **Tshepang Basupi** had no idea that millions worldwide were living and dying without ever hearing the Gospel.

Following a friend's advice, he attended OneWay Africa's **Livingstone School of Missions (LSM)** in 2009, where his eyes were opened to the urgent need for more workers.

Though he had planned a career in politics, a pivotal moment during his training changed everything: he said yes to God's call — wherever that might lead.

Today, Tshepang serves as **Executive Director for Africa Inland Mission's Southern Africa region**, overseeing more than 130 missionaries. Churches have been planted, missionaries trained, and African believers mobilized to reach their own communities.

By God's grace, Tshepang's story is one of many. In 2025, the Livingstone School of Missions **celebrated 20 years of training more than 300 students from 26 African nations**. Praise God for the tens of thousands reached through these graduates, now serving on six continents.

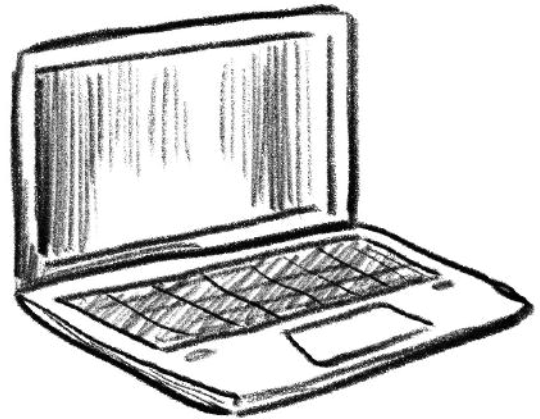

PRAYER VIDEOS SPARK HEART FOR THE MIDDLE EAST

How Prayercast helped one woman move from fear to compassion

When Maria Z. first watched a Prayercast video, she knew almost nothing about the Middle East.

"I was Googling where Tunisia even was," Maria laughs. "I didn't feel called to the region at all. Honestly, I was wary of the people after 9/11."

But after joining a prayer group that used **Prayercast videos** to guide them in prayer for various nations, **everything began to change**. Week by week, the faces and stories in those videos started to stir her heart.

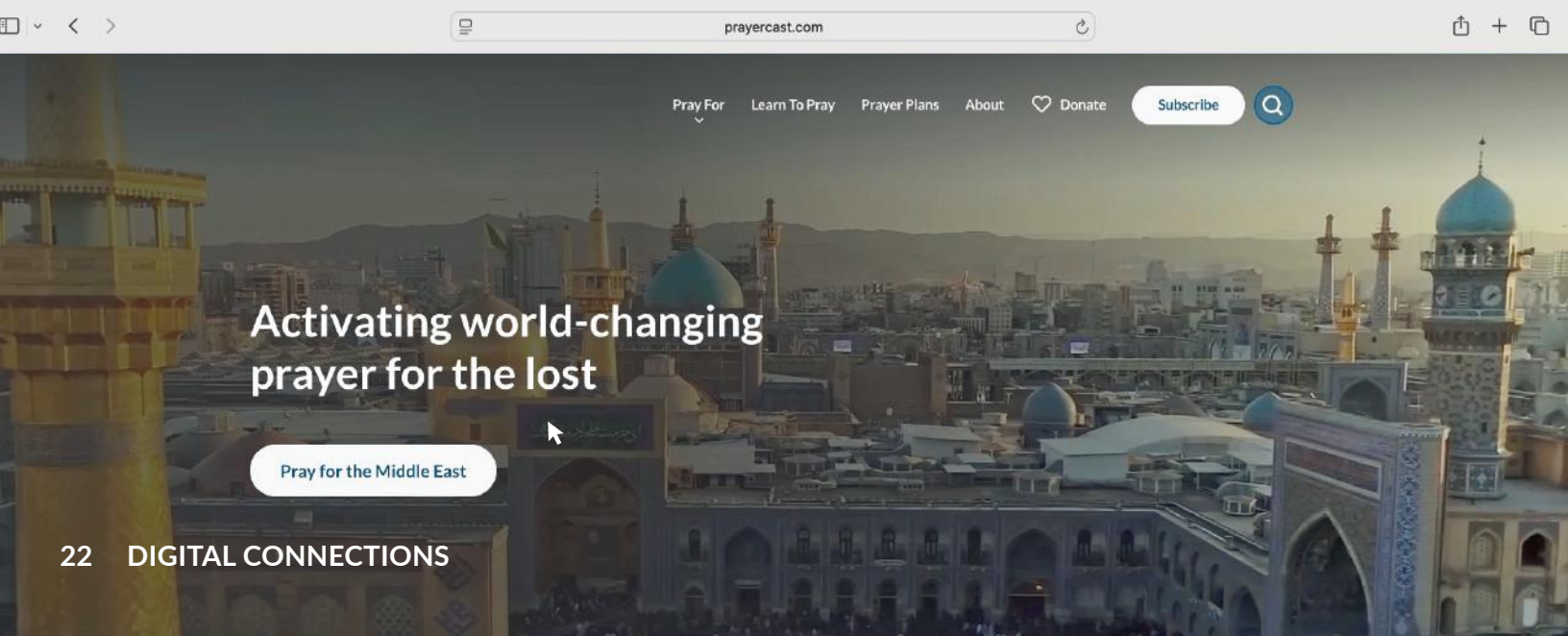


Seeing women fully veiled and hearing the voices of people crying out for prayer slowly replaced indifference with compassion.

Today, Maria equips ministries across the greater Middle East and says Prayercast was the tool God used to spark the fire in her heart.





RADIO STORY HELPS BUILD THE CHURCH IN UKRAINE

*How one story ignites gospel partnership
and healing among Ukraine's veterans*

When **Mission Network News** shared a story about a U.S. ministry helping veterans find biblical freedom and restoration, no one expected it to echo across the world.

Soon after it was published, that echo traveled across continents, landing in the hands of a group of **young Ukrainian chaplains** newly formed to serve their nation's war veterans. They had passion but little experience. Through the story, they discovered the U.S. ministry's work and reached out for connection.

What followed was an unexpected partnership. The American team began training and resourcing these Ukrainian chaplains to **walk with veterans through trauma and loss**, introducing them to the healing power of Christ.

"I never imagined my strategy for helping war veterans would reach the other side of the world."

Today, Ukrainian soldiers are not only finding care and community, they're also encountering the hope of the gospel. This collaboration is still unfolding, but its potential is immense: to bring Christ's healing to as many as **5-6 million Ukrainian veterans**, both amid the war and in the years to come.

What began as a single news report has become part of God's greater story — an echo of His restoration, resounding across nations so that more may know the One who heals.

ONLINE EVANGELISM REACHES WHERE VOICES ARE RESTRICTED

*How God is using technology to
accelerate the spread of the good news*

In parts of the world where sharing the gospel can be dangerous, God is using digital tools to reach people who might never otherwise meet someone to guide them in following Jesus. This year, OneWay's digital evangelist trained two Pakistani believers to share the gospel online. Before long, they began sending photos — of baptisms.

One of those new believers was a former religious teacher God had been preparing long before any digital connection. While reading the Quran, he noticed it pointed to the Bible for guidance. His curiosity led him to Scripture, where he was moved by the love and sacrifice of Jesus.

When doctors feared for his unborn child, he prayed to Jesus — and his baby was born healthy. That's when he saw our Facebook ad.

Alongside evangelism, Bible translation, and relief efforts, OneWay helps fuel movements of prayer and worship in and for this critical region. Through media and partnership we help mobilize prayer, boost the indigenous church, and amplify voices often overlooked as we help advance the gospel where it's least resourced and most resisted.

As local believers rise up with songs, stories, and prayer from the heart of the region, powerful weapons of hope are breaking through the darkness.

RAISED UP FROM THE UNREACHED

Former Muslim dreams of becoming a Jesus Film Rider to reach his own people



Abraham was a Muslim from a remote village in northern Ghana who had never heard the name of Jesus — until the day a **Jesus Film Rider** arrived in his community.

As Abraham watched the story of Jesus unfold on the screen, he was deeply moved.

“What really touched me was the beatings and the crucifixion... Someone really suffered all this for me to live freely.”

That night, Abraham gave his life to Christ. But his story didn't end there. As he grew in faith, he became **burdened for his own people**.

Today, he is enrolled in OneWay Africa's **Livingstone School of Missions**, hoping one day to serve as a Jesus Film Rider. The same model that brought the gospel to his village is now multiplying through him.

FROM OUTCASTS TO AMBASSADORS

A Pygmy couple discover Jesus and are preparing to share Him with their people

Deep in the heart of the jungles of Central Africa live a remote tribe called the Pygmies.

Small in stature and simple in lifestyle, they are considered **insignificant outcasts** in the eyes of other tribes. They live far from other villages, have no education, and **feel they are cursed by God** and therefore live without Him.

Our partner ministry, Streams of Living Water, has a mission school located in Central Africa, and two of its leaders decided to visit one of the Pygmy villages. **During the visit, they shared the gospel and explained that God loved them enough to send Jesus, whom they had never heard of before, to die for them.**

One couple accepted the Lord and made the courageous decision to enroll in Streams' **Tyrannus Missionary School.**

During their schooling, they courageously went on evangelistic outreaches to people that had long rejected them. **Once they graduate, they plan to return to their own village to share the gospel and disciple new believers.**





VENEZUELANS BOLDLY REACHING THEIR NEIGHBORS

Venezuelan students lead the charge to reach their communities

You don't want to face off in a Bible competition with students from a mountain-nestled church in Venezuela. These teens know the Word. They completed OneWay's **Heart Bible for the Nations** evangelism training, which helps believers internalize Bible stories so they can retell them effortlessly and accurately in their own words.

For youth like Milagro, learning, sharing, and teaching God's Word has become second nature. Now, **when their church organizes door-to-door evangelism, Milagro and her friends are always first to volunteer** — so eager that leaders sometimes struggle to get adults to keep up.

“Through the stories, we can connect with people and build a bridge to share the message of salvation.”

God's Word has become the language of their hearts, turning them into walking Bibles as they fearlessly carry the Kingdom forward!

A LAUNCHPAD FOR AFRICAN MISSIONS

Empowering Africans to reach Africa

Last year, **Philip Centre North** existed only as a dream. OneWay Africa Director Ray Mensah envisioned it after hearing the story of a Komba believer who walked twelve miles to share the gospel with his own community. Inspired, Ray imagined a training center that could equip local believers to reach their own people — and beyond.

The vision began to take shape when the Kombas in northern Ghana saw students from OneWay Africa's **Livingstone School of Missions** evangelize a nearby village, resulting in hundreds coming to Christ. Moved by what they saw, **the tribe donated 20 acres of land** so local believers could be trained for similar outreach.

Today, these believers are among Ghana's most passionate evangelists, exemplifying the heart of the center: **local believers reaching their own communities** and carrying the gospel farther than ever before.

Thanks to generous partners, **Philip Centre North** has come to life. Construction is still underway, yet the site is already buzzing: **600 disciple-makers have gathered for training, and 17 students attend monthly classes**. Even in its early stages, the center is equipping African believers to step into the harvest and share the gospel with those around them.

As the ministry of OneWay Africa grows, so does its influence. **Director Ray Mensah was recently elected Chairman and President of the African Missions Association**, a network uniting and mobilizing mission leaders across the continent.

Through this new center and expanding leadership, God is using **African believers** to advance His work and bring the gospel to the ends of the earth.



Dreams really do come true in God's Kingdom. What was just blueprints and drawings last year became a reality in 2025 as the first phase of construction on Philip Centre North was completed. Strategically located in the heart of the unreached, local believers are already being trained and sent to reach their own people and beyond.

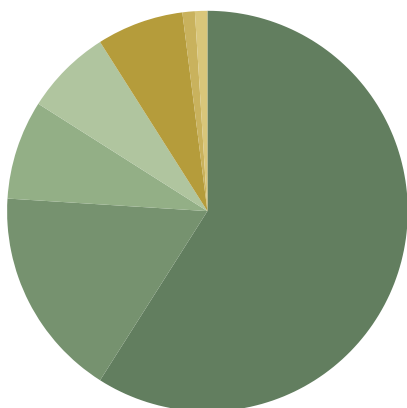

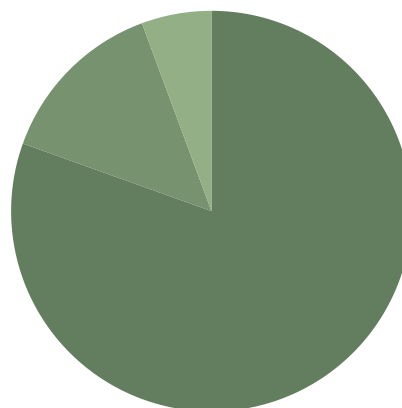
