The Gift of Sustainability

Meet Alicia



Uganda – At just 17, Alicia's world was turned upside down. Born in Goma in the Democratic Republic of Congo, she once enjoyed the warmth of a close-knit family and the comfort of home. But everything changed when violent conflict erupted.

As rebels swept through the region, fear and chaos consumed the community. Schools shut down, streets emptied, and families disappeared. Alicia lost her father and two siblings to the violence, and her only focus became survival.

With help from a rescue team, Alicia, her sister, and her mother escaped to Uganda, arriving as refugees with nothing but grief and uncertainty. Settling in one of Kampala's most overlooked slums, they faced a daily struggle to survive.

Through a small local church, Alicia heard about our *Elevate* program—a training initiative offering digital skills, mentorship, and community for young people with nowhere else to turn. She enrolled in the Graphics and Computer Studies course, and for the first time in years, she began to dream again.

Though the transition was difficult, Alicia threw herself into her studies. She not only developed her technical skills but also grew in confidence and leadership. Her resilience and determination quickly stood out, and soon other students began looking to her as a role model.

She discovered that her voice carried influence, and that she could inspire others who were walking through the same struggles she had faced.

By age 20, Alicia was invited to become the Lead Hub Manager at era92 Elevate's new training center in Katanga. She accepted with humility and a passion to give back.

"Many of my friends never had the chance to dream—they died before they could. I now dream of taking a program like this back to Congo."

Today, Alicia is more than a survivor—she's a mentor, a leader, and a source of hope for dozens of young people. Her story is a powerful reminder that even in the darkest places, transformation is possible when opportunity meets determination.

Every year, Impact Nations trains thousands of young men and women just like Alicia, providing them with the skills that they need to overcome crippling poverty. YOU can be a part of their story. You can help someone gain marketable skills and start a career.

Rescue Two Generations

Meet Claire



Uganda – At just 14 years old, Claire's life was shattered by abuse that left her pregnant and uncertain of her future. While her friends continued their studies and prepared for adulthood, Claire faced a very different reality—becoming a mother far too soon.

Because she was so young, Claire's pregnancy carried serious risks. When authorities determined her home was unsafe, she was brought to the Princess Shelter, where she could receive medical care and prepare for the birth of her baby boy, Patrick. By God's grace—and with the help of our team—both mother and child survived.

At the shelter, Claire found safety and community. She made new friends and excelled in tailoring classes, graduating as one of the most hardworking students in her class. For the first time in years, Claire began to dream again.

Because of friends like you, the Princess Shelter is more than a refuge—it is a place of healing and restoration. Every day, young mothers receive medical care, practical training, and the assurance that they are not alone.

Today, Claire and her son Patrick live with her aunt, who was overjoyed to welcome them home. Claire is working at a retail store, saving toward her dream of opening her own tailoring business. She is proud to provide for her son and is filled with hope for the future.

Claire and Patrick's survival is a powerful reminder that timely medical care can mean the difference between despair and a future filled with hope.

Today, their laughter is a testimony to God's grace and the power of timely rescue.

The Gift of Hope

Meet Kirta



India – Kirta married young, hoping for a peaceful home. But soon after the wedding, her husband's drinking turned violent, and their house became a place of fear. Her only comfort was her son, who clung to her as she tried to shield him from the anger.

With no income or support, Kirta often went without food so her son could eat. She sold her last possessions—an old bangle, a spare pot—just to survive. One stormy evening, her husband erupted in rage and threw them out with nothing but the clothes on their backs.

Soaked in the rain, Kirta sat under a tree all night holding her crying son. She felt utterly alone—no family, no shelter, no way forward. But when her son whispered, “Ma, I’m hungry,” something shifted. She made a silent promise: *I will not give up. I will fight—for him.*

Days later, Kirta discovered our sewing center for women seeking a new beginning. She waited outside all night for it to open. When the instructor welcomed her with kindness, it was the first gentle word she had heard in years.

Though sewing was difficult at first, the encouragement of her trainers and peers restored her confidence.

A year later, with support from the center, Kirta opened her own tailoring shop. She began with one machine; today she has steady customers and a reliable income. Her son is in school, and they share meals each night—not in fear, but in peace.





Every year, our partners in India and Nepal help women like Kirta find hope. In our shelters, women discover their worth and rebuild their lives through discipleship and skills training. YOU can help make that possible.

Change a Destiny

Meet Pratima



Nepal – Pratima's childhood was marked by poverty and violence. When her parents separated, she was passed between relatives, never experiencing the security of a loving home.

As a young woman, longing for stability, she moved in with a man who promised affection. Instead, he forced her into the dark world of dance bars, where she was exploited night after night.

The years of abuse left Pratima deeply wounded—physically, emotionally, and spiritually. She was even forced to endure repeated abortions, each one a painful reminder of the control others had over her life.

One evening, after a severe beating, Pratima was found near the club by a local NGO and taken to the hospital. Recognizing her need for long-term care, they contacted our team, and she was welcomed into the House of Hope.

At first, Pratima carried deep anger and trauma. But with patience and compassion, she began receiving counseling, medical care, and life-skills training. In the shelter's kitchen, she discovered a love for cooking, while housekeeping classes gave her a renewed sense of dignity.

Most importantly, Pratima encountered the love of Christ. She gave her life to Jesus, was baptized, and now leans on Him as she continues her journey of restoration.

Today, Pratima is employed as a housekeeper with a reputable company, earning a fair wage and building a hopeful future. She has also been reunited with her mother, and together they are carefully rebuilding their relationship.

What was once a story of pain is now becoming a testimony of healing, dignity, and hope.



Every year we rescue women like Pratima from a life of forced prostitution, drug addiction, and terrifying violence. Meanwhile, we are training local leaders to stand up for justice and break the cycle of dehumanizing abuse. YOU can help.

The Gift of Freedom

Meet Angela



Malawi - In the border towns of Malawi, traffickers often look for vulnerable children to exploit. But thanks to your support, a team of twenty trained men and women works tirelessly to identify and stop them before it's too late.

Angela's story shows just how critical this work is. She was only thirteen, though looked much younger, when a woman promised her steady work as a housekeeper. Angela believed she could earn enough to help her four younger siblings—so she eagerly accepted the job offer.

That promise was a lie. Instead of finding honest work, Angela was drawn into a hidden world of exploitation. For months, she was held under control, her future slipping further away as traffickers planned to send her across the border into larger operations.

Then came the moment of rescue. One afternoon, while Angela was being transported, our team spotted her.

Recognizing the signs, they called the authorities and launched into action, chasing down the traffickers on their motorbikes. It was a race against time—if she crossed the border, she would likely disappear forever.

By God's grace, the team caught them in time. Angela was pulled from danger and brought to our safe house, where she received care, protection, and compassion. In time, Angela was joyfully reunited with her family, safe at last.

For the first time in years, Angela could rest without fear, surrounded by people who believed her life was worth fighting for.

Because of the Impact Nations family, children like Angela are spared from a lifetime of exploitation. Together, we are turning despair into hope, and fear into freedom.

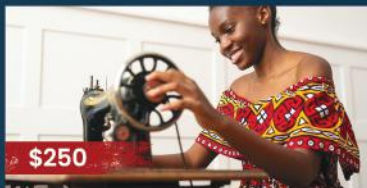

Meet Ireen



Gaza – When five-year-old Ireen's parents bought her a small backpack and filled it with notebooks and pencils, they were full of anticipation for her very first day of kindergarten. Like children everywhere, she couldn't wait to learn, play, and make new friends. But that day never came.

War soon reached their neighborhood. With destruction and danger closing in, her parents had no choice but to flee. They quickly stuffed a change of clothes into that same backpack and began a desperate journey across their once-beautiful country, leaving everything else behind.

When our team met Ireen and her family, they were living in an overcrowded tent city in an already bombed-out region of southern Gaza. Hunger was constant, and the little girl had no toys, no books, and no space to simply be a child.

Yet even in the middle of that hopelessness, Ireen's creativity shone through. When our partners handed her family a food package with a box of macaroni inside, Ireen saw more than nourishment—she saw an opportunity for fun.

Stringing a few pieces of the pasta together, Ireen proudly wore them as a necklace—the kind of treasure every child longs for. In that moment, surrounded by rubble and loss, joy broke through.

In addition to the food, our partners spent time praying over Ireen's family, reminding them that God sees them and cares for them.

Ireen's story is just one among thousands. With your help, Impact Nations has delivered more than 1.2 million meals in Gaza alone. Each package represents more than calories—it represents dignity, hope, and the reminder that even in the darkest places, love is stronger than fear.

Rescue a Slave

Meet Arman



India – Before he was even a teenager, Arman carried burdens far heavier than bricks. Working long shifts in a kiln to help feed his family, he believed their suffering was his fault.

"If I were a better son," he thought, "maybe my father wouldn't drink. Maybe my mother wouldn't cry." By 13, Arman knew only the dust and heat of the kiln, never the inside of a classroom.

When our partners first met him at the brick factory, Arman was defensive. *"What's the point?" he asked. "I don't belong in school. I need to earn."*

But they didn't give up. Through repeated visits, they brought his family groceries, listened to their story, and offered steady encouragement.

One day, without warning, Arman showed up at the learning center. *"Can I just sit at the back and listen?"* he asked quietly. That question changed everything.

He enrolled in school the following week. At first, the adjustment was difficult—he was older than his classmates and far behind. But Arman's determination was unwavering.

He stayed late for tutoring, studied hard, and soon began helping other children with their studies.

Now in Class 6, Arman is not only catching up—he's leading. The first in his family to ever attend school, he dreams of becoming a social worker to help other children who feel forgotten, just as he once did.

The boy who once believed he was worthless is now inspiring others.

"I don't feel guilty anymore," he says. "My life matters. I matter. And now I know I can change my family's story—not by carrying their pain, but by creating something better."

In Northern India, children as young as five are trapped in brick factories, working long hours for little or no pay. Impact Nations is rescuing thousands of children and enrolling them in school. YOU can help a child trade bricks for books and reclaim their future.

Seeds of Change

Harvesting Hope

Malawi – This year, severe weather devastated farmers across Malawi, leaving families and entire communities without enough food to last through the year.

The shortage was felt everywhere—even inside the prison system. Hunger was weakening entire communities, leaving people hopeless and afraid.

With limited funding, prisons can go months without government food allocations. Our partners stepped in to meet the immediate hunger crisis with meal distributions, while also launching a sustainable solution: Thrive garden training.

Inmates are now learning how to grow their own food on prison land. Crops that once seemed impossible are taking root, providing nourishment that will last long after the food distributions end. As one officer explained: *"Since receiving this food, our inmates are healthier than other inmates in other prisons."*

Prison chaplain Precious Daniel Maniwa has seen the change firsthand. *"The food has brought happiness to the face of everyone here,"* he said. *"It has tremendously improved their health and given them more energy. We are deeply grateful."*

The impact has reached beyond the prison walls. Our teams have already delivered more than a million meals throughout the region, while also providing seeds and garden tools for families.

One recipient, 86-year-old Geoffrey, is a widower raising three children and two grandchildren. The meals he received carried them through the farming off-season, restoring both their health and their hope.

Thanks to your generosity, families and even prisoners in Malawi are experiencing dignity, strength, and a brighter future. What began as emergency food relief is now becoming a foundation for long-term food security.

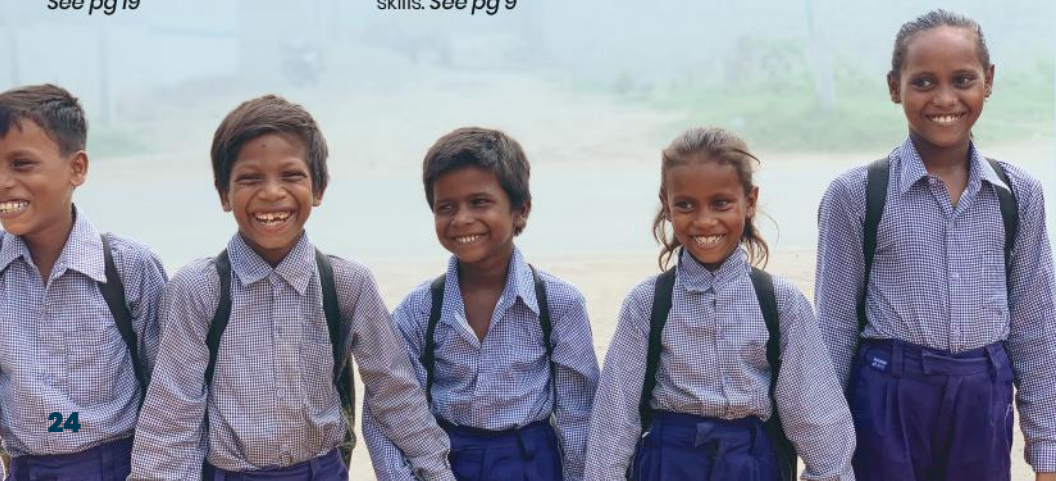
